

**Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)**  
June 2011. *Provisional data*

**Main results**

- The number of passengers using **city transport** increases 1.4% in June 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The **number of passengers using inter-city transport** increases 1.6% in the interannual rate.
- **Special and unscheduled transport** registers a 4.0% decrease, as compared with the same month the previous year.

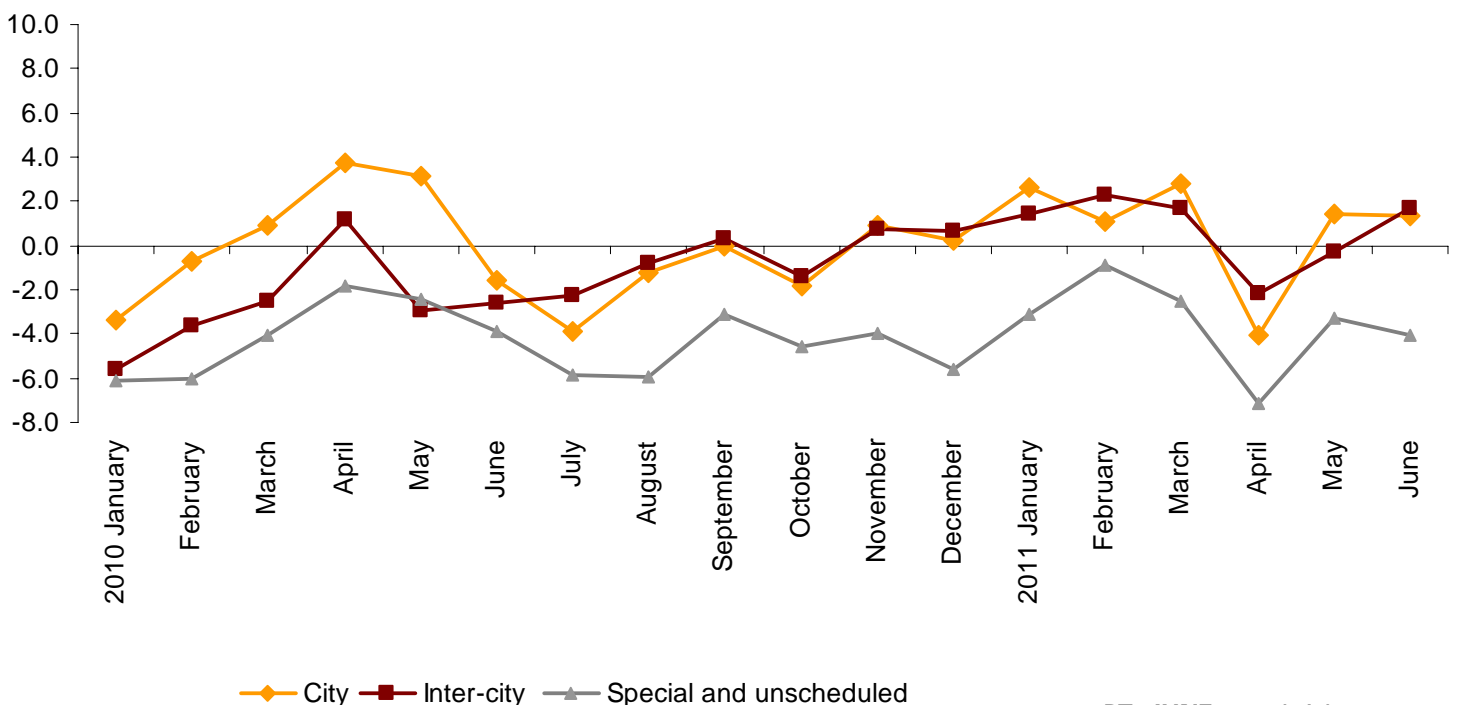
**Evolution of passenger transport**

**More than 415.6 million passengers** used public transport in June 2011, that is, 0.8% more than in the same month the previous year.

The average rate of the total passengers stood at 0.3% for the first six months of the year. By type of transport, all types presented positive average rates during this period, except special and unscheduled transport, which registered a decrease of 3.5%.

**City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community**

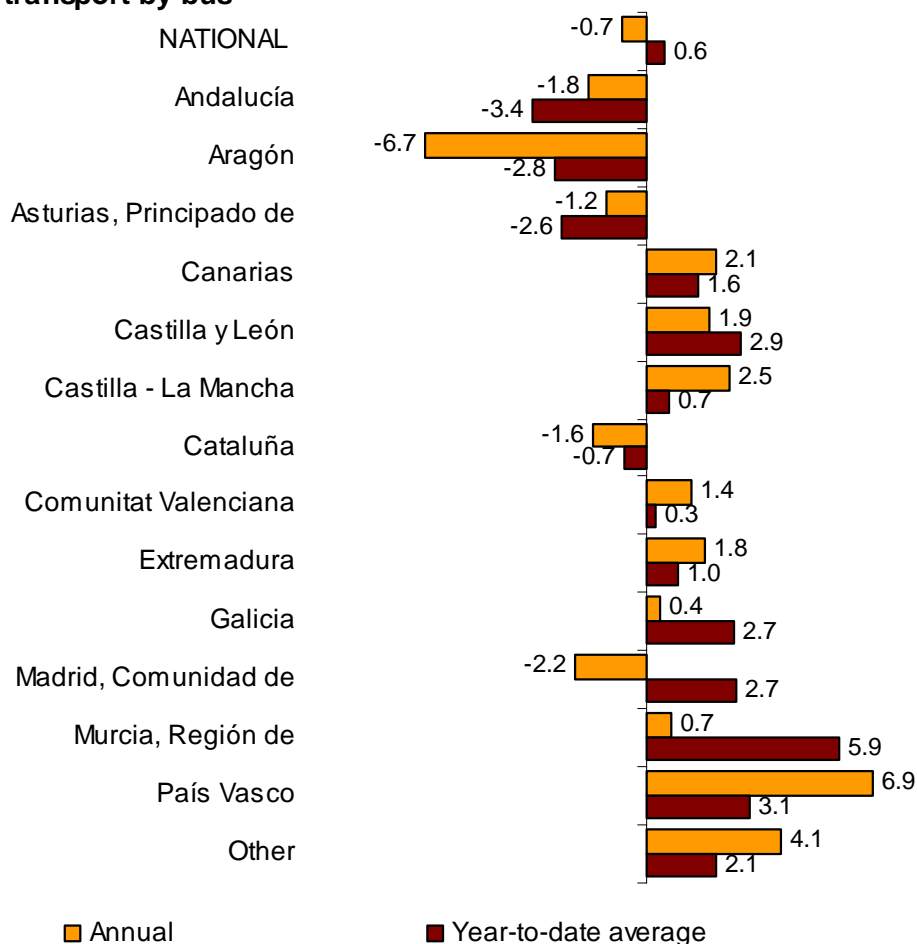
City transport was used by more than 252 million passengers in June, 1.4% more than in the same month the previous year.

Metropolitan transport increased 4.7% in the interannual rate. All of the metropolitans registered increases, except for the Valencia metropolitan (-5.4%). Worth noting among the increases was Sevilla (10.7%).

In turn, city transport by bus decreased 0.7% in the interannual rate, with more than 151 million passengers in June. More than half of the Autonomous Communities presented positive rates. Worth noting was País Vasco (6.9%). In contrast, the highest decrease was registered in Aragón (-6.7%).

**City transport by bus**

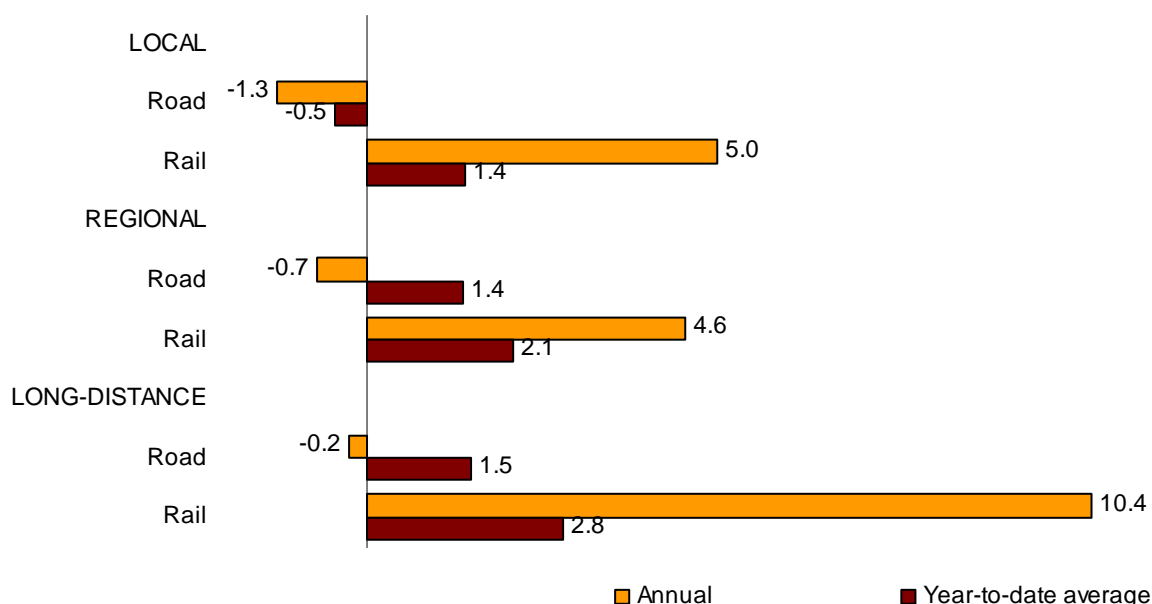


### Inter-city transport

More than 113 million passengers used inter-city transport in June 2011, indicating an interannual increase of 1.6%. **Rail** transport increased 5.2% and the all other types of transport decreased. **Sea** transport decreased 1.5%, **road** (coach) transport decreased 1.1% and **Air** transport decreased 0.2%.

Local transport increased 5.0% in rail transport and decreased 1.3% in passenger transport by bus. Regional transport increased 4.6% in rail transport, and decreased 0.7% in bus transport. Meanwhile, long-distance increased 10.4% in rail transport, and barely changed in road (coach) transport (-0.2%).

### Special and unscheduled transport

Almost 50 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in June, indicating a 4.0% decrease in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 5.2%, standing at more than 31.7 million. Within this, work transport decreased 6.3% and school transport decreased 4.7%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 2.0%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching slightly more than 18 million passengers.
