The number of passengers using public transport decreases 3.9% in June, as compared with the same month of the previous year


The city transport decreases 5.5% in the annual rate and the inter-city transport 1.8%

Passengers transport evolution

More than 384.3 million passengers used public transport in June, 3.9% less than the same month of the previous year.

The city transport decreased 5.5% in the annual rate and the inter-city transport 1.8%. Within this, the most significant drop was that of the air transport, with a rate of - 16.0%.

Type of transport





Monthly rate evolution¹

The variation rate for the number of passengers on public transport in June as compared with May was -7.1%. This monthly rate was the lowest in the last five years.

¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, this section has been added including the performance of the monthly rate for the number of users of public transport in recent years. The month-on-month rates of this type of series may have a seasonal behaviour; therefore it is recommended to evaluate them in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.


City transport

City transport was used by nearly 228.5 million passengers in June, 5.5% less than the same month of the previous year.

Metropolitan transport registered a 7.4% decrease and bus transport drops 4.3%.

According to the data of the cities providing metropolitan transport, all the cities registered a decrease except Palma, with an increase of 1.5%. while bus transport only registered an increase in Sevilla (2.9%).

Interannual rate of city transport passengers in cities with a Metropolitan



All the Autonomous Communities registered decreases in the transport by bus, except for Asturias (6.5%) and Aragón (1.1%).

The Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest decreases are Castilla - La Mancha (-16.7%) and Región de Murcia (-14.6%).

Inter-city transport


More than 110.5 million passengers used inter-city transport in June, indicating a 1.8% decrease as compared with the same month of 2012.

The bus and air transport decreased 2.7% and 16.0%, respectively. In turn, rail transport increased 0.1% as compared with June 2012.

Local distance passengers decreased 0.9% for bus transport and for rail transport. Regional passengers distance decreased 6.7% for bus transport and increased 1.5% for rail transport.

Finally, long-distance passengers decreased 7.5% in bus transport while rail transport increased 20.7%.

Special and unscheduled transport

Over 45.3 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in June, indicating a 0.1% decrease in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased 1.2%, reaching over 29 million users. Within this, school transport decreased 4.3% while work transport increased 8.0%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 1.9%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching more than 16.1 million passengers.
