The number of passengers using public transport increases by 2.6% in June, as compared with the same month of the previous year

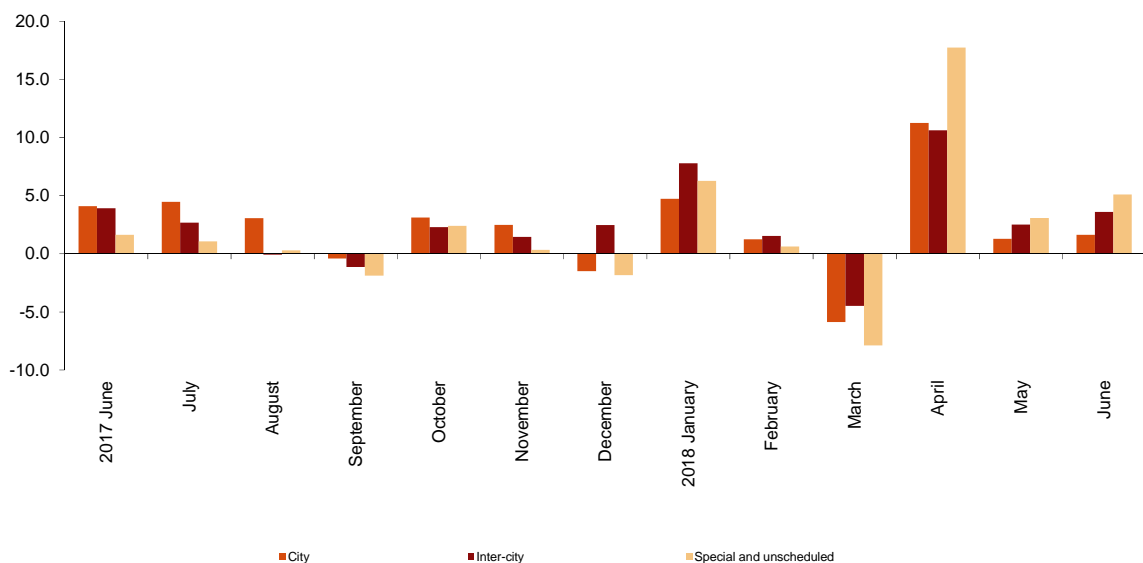
City transport increases by 1.6% in the annual rate and inter-city transport by 3.6%

Evolution of passenger transport

More than 428.6 million passengers used public transport in June, 2.6% more than in the same month of 2017.

City transport increased by 1.6% in the annual rate and inter-city transport did so by 3.6%. Within the latter, it is worth noting the 8.0% increase in air transport.

Type of transport



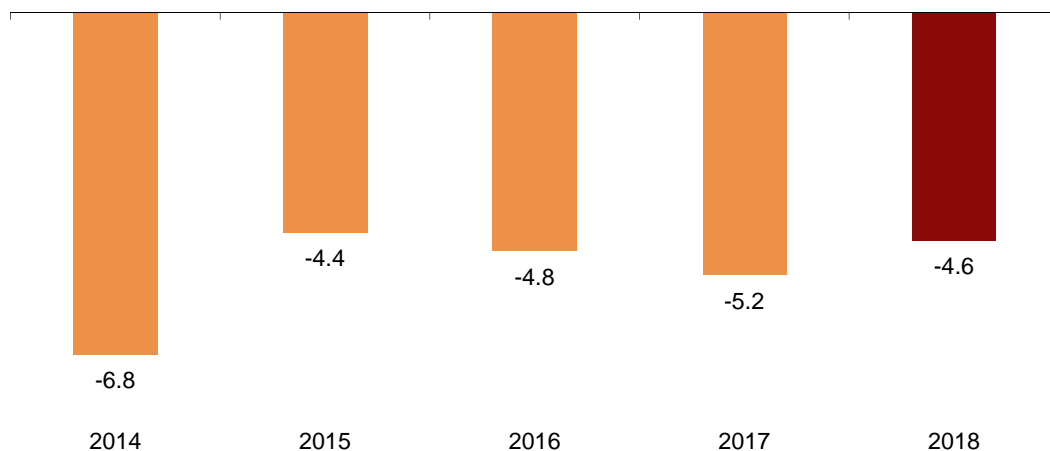

Evolution of the monthly rate

The variation rate of the number of public transport passengers in June as compared with May was -4.6%. In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, the evolution of the monthly rate of public transport passengers in recent years is shown in the following chart.

(month-on-month for June as compared with May)**



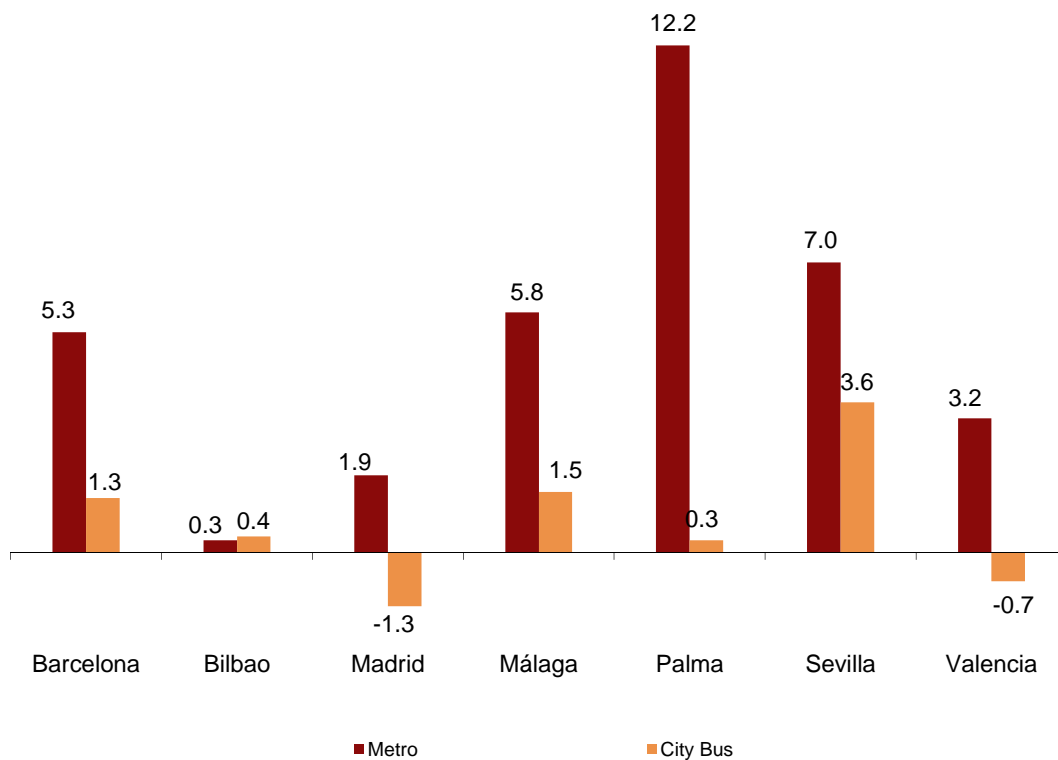
City transport

City transport was used by more than 257.8 million passengers in June, 1.6% more than in the same month of 2017.

Subway transport increased by 3.0% and grew in all the cities. Palma's subway presented the largest increase (12.2%).

Among the cities with subway, the greatest increase in bus transport was registered in Sevilla (3.6%), while the greatest decrease was registered in Madrid (-1.3%).

Annual rate of city transport passengers in major cities with Metro

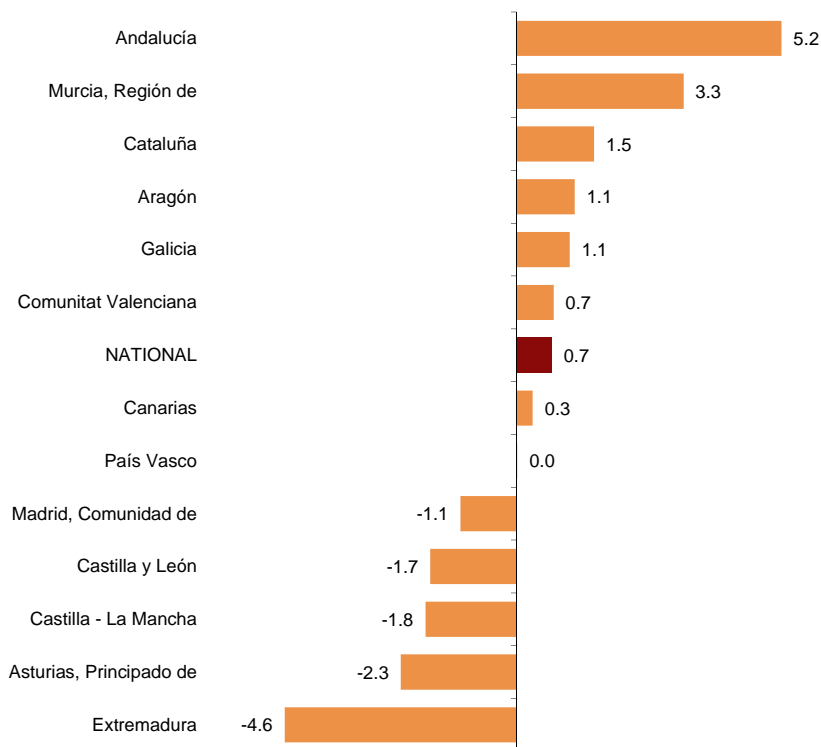


City transport by bus increased by 0.7% in June, as compared with the same month of the previous year.

The number of passengers of bus transport registered the greatest increases in Andalucía (5.2%), Región de Murcia (3.3%) and Cataluña (1.5%).

In turn, the largest decreases were registered in Extremadura (-4.6%), Principado de Asturias (-2.3%) and Castilla–La Mancha (-1.8%).

Inter-city transport

More than 119.6 million passengers used inter-city transport in June, representing a 3.6% increase as compared with the same month of 2017.

By type of transport, air transport increased by 8.0%, maritime transport by 6.4%, rail transport by 5.5%, and bus transport by 1.7%.

Local distance passengers increased by 1.3% for bus transport and by 6.0% for rail transport. Regional distance passengers increased by 3.9% for bus transport and 1.3% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers decreased by 11.6% for bus transport and increased by 1.1% for rail transport. Within the latter, AVE (high speed railway) increased by 1.7%.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 51.1 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in June, indicating an increase of 5.1% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers increased 2.7%, reaching more than 28.0 million users. Within this, school transport increased by 1.4%, and work transport did so by 6.5%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 8.2%, as compared with the same month of 2017, reaching more than 23.1 million passengers.
