

Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)
July 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The number of passengers using **city transport** decreases 2.3% in July 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The **number of passengers using inter-city transport** decreases 0.6% in the interannual rate.
- **Special and unscheduled transport** registers a 2.8% decrease, as compared with the same month the previous year.

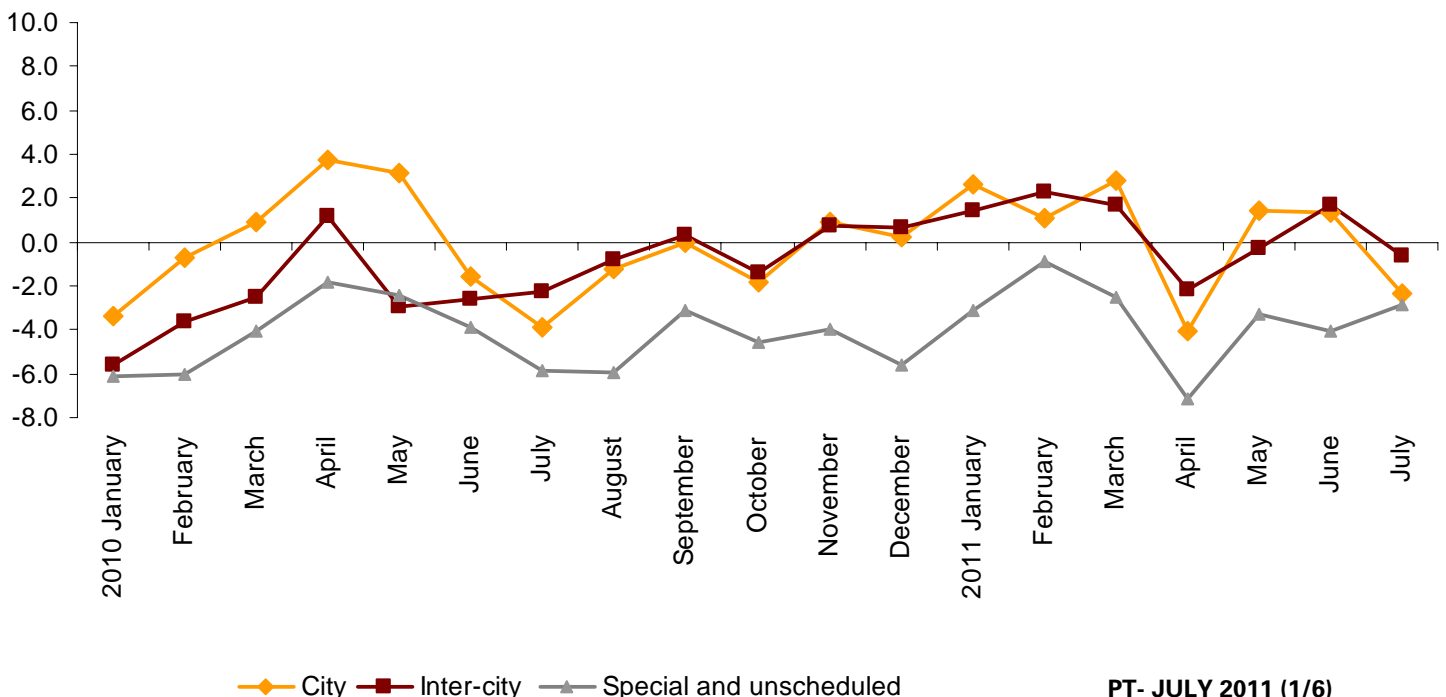
Evolution of passenger transport

More than 359.6 million passengers used public transport in July 2011, that is, 1.8% less than in the same month the previous year.

The average rate of the total passengers did not change for the first seven months in 2011 as compared with the previous year. By type of transport, all types presented positive average rates during this period, except special and unscheduled transport, which registered a decrease of 3.5%.

City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

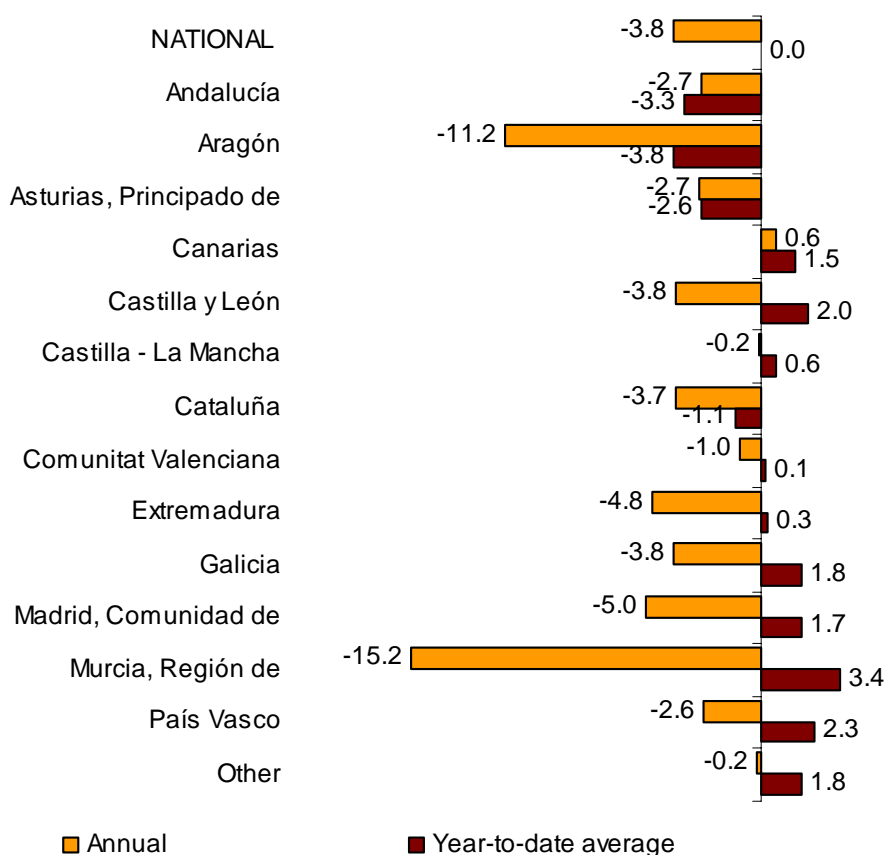
City transport was used by more than 224 million passengers in July, 2.3% less than in the same month the previous year.

Metropolitan transport decreased 0.1% in the interannual rate. The Valencia, Bilbao and Barcelona metropolitans registered interannual decreases of 7.4%, 3.2% y 1.4%, respectively. In turn the Madrid, Sevilla and Palma metropolitans registered increases of 2.1%, 2.0% and 1.0%, respectively.

The city transport by bus decreased 3.8% in the interannual rate, with more than 133 million passengers in July.

All of the Autonomous Communities presented negative rates, except the increases registered in Canarias (0.6%). The highest decrease were registered in Región de Murcia (-15.2%) and Aragón (-11.2%).

Urban transport by road**

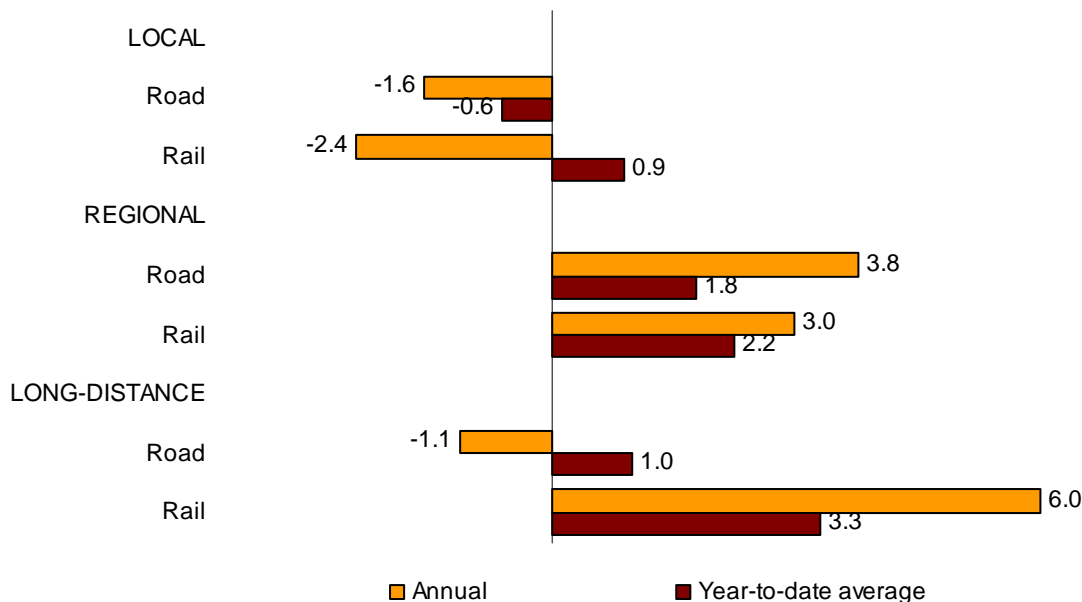


Inter-city transport

More than 110 million passengers used inter-city transport in July 2011, indicating an interannual decrease of 0.6%. **Rail** transport and **Sea** transport decreased 1.7% and 1.3% respectively. In turn, **Air** transport and **road** (coach) transport increased 0.5% and 0.1% respectively.

Local transport decreased 2.4% in rail transport and decreased 1.6% in passenger transport by bus. Regional transport increased 3.8% in bus transport, and 3.0% in rail transport. Meanwhile, long-distance increased 6.0% in rail transport, and decreased in road (coach) transport (-1.1%).

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 25 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in July, indicating a 2.8% decrease in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 6.2%, standing at more than 9 million. Within this, school transport decreased 8.4% and work transport decreased 5.8%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 0.8%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching almost 16 million passengers.
