The number of passengers using public transport decreases by 0.7% in July, as compared with the same month of the previous year

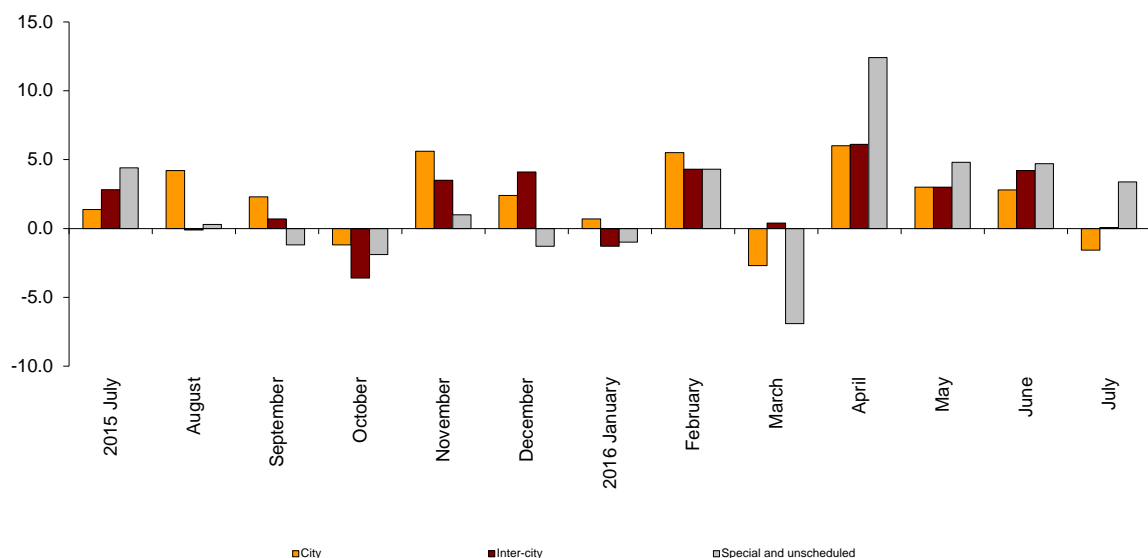
City transport decreases by 1.6% in the annual rate and inter-city transport increases by 0.1%

Passengers transport evolution

More than 350.6 million passengers used public transport in July, 0.7% less than in the same month of 2015.

City transport decreased by 1.6% and inter-city transport increased by 0.1% in the annual rate. Within the last one, maritime transport was the one that recorded the greatest increase, with a 12.8% rate.

Type of transport



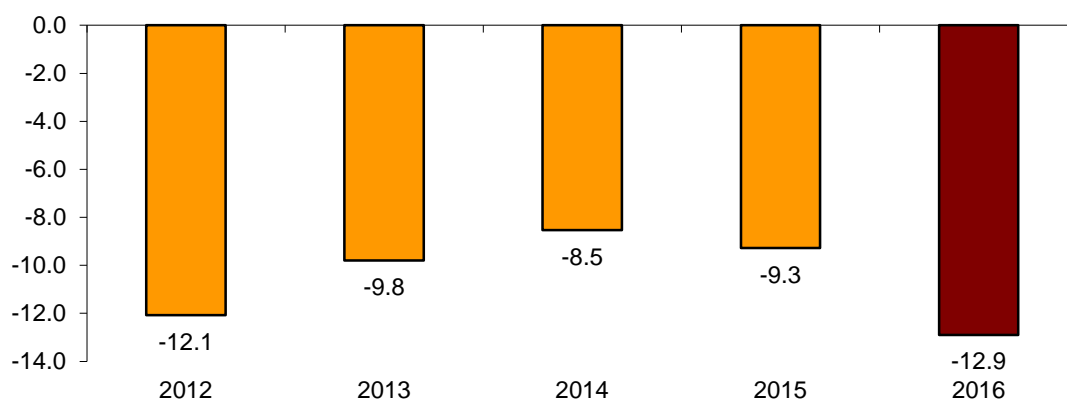

Monthly rate evolution

The variation rate for the number of passengers of public transport in July 2016, as compared with June, was -12.9%. In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, the evolution of the monthly rate of public transport passengers in the last years is shown in the following chart.

(month-on-month variation for July as compared with June)**



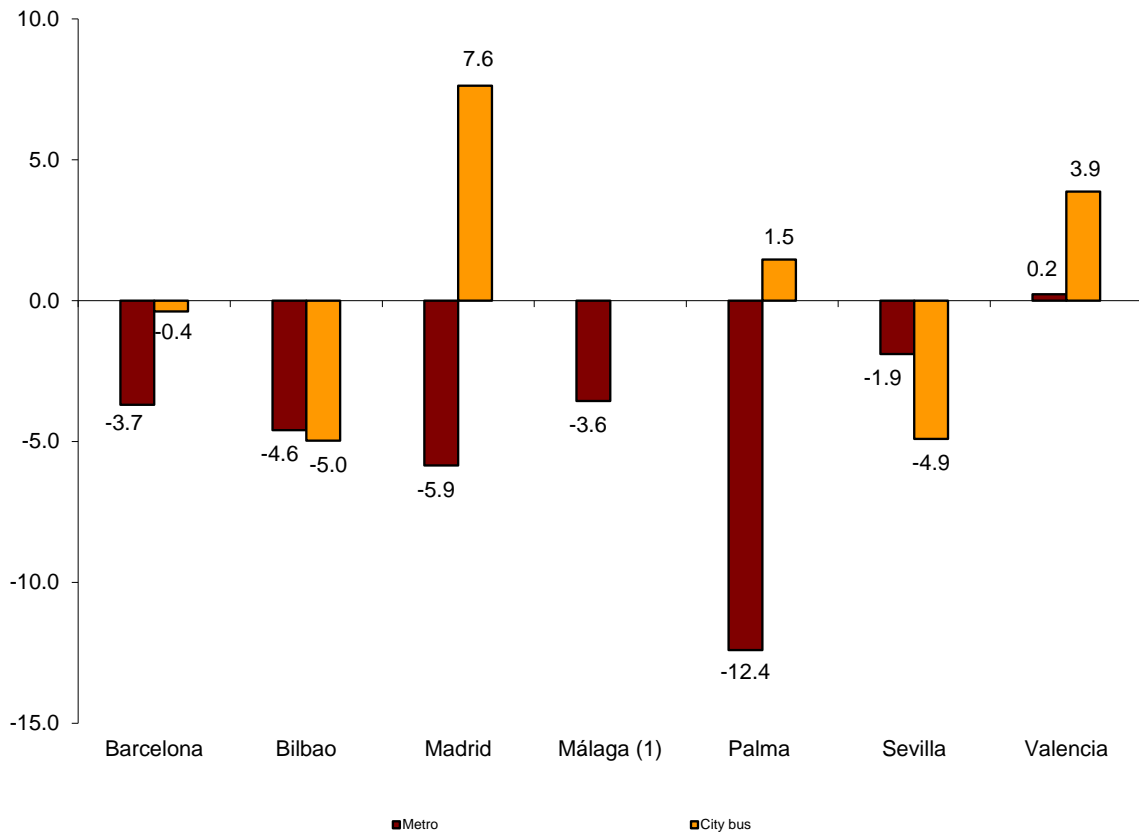
City transport

City transport was used by more than 216.0 million passengers in July, 1.6% less than in the same month of 2015.

Metro transport registered a decrease of 4.6%, with decreases in all cities, except in Valencia (0.2%). Metro transport in Palma registered the greatest decrease (-12.4%).

In turn, bus transport annual rate increased by 0.5%. Among the cities with metro, the greatest increase was registered in Madrid (7.6%), while the greatest decrease was registered in Bilbao (-5.0%).

Annual rate of city transport passengers in major cities with Metro

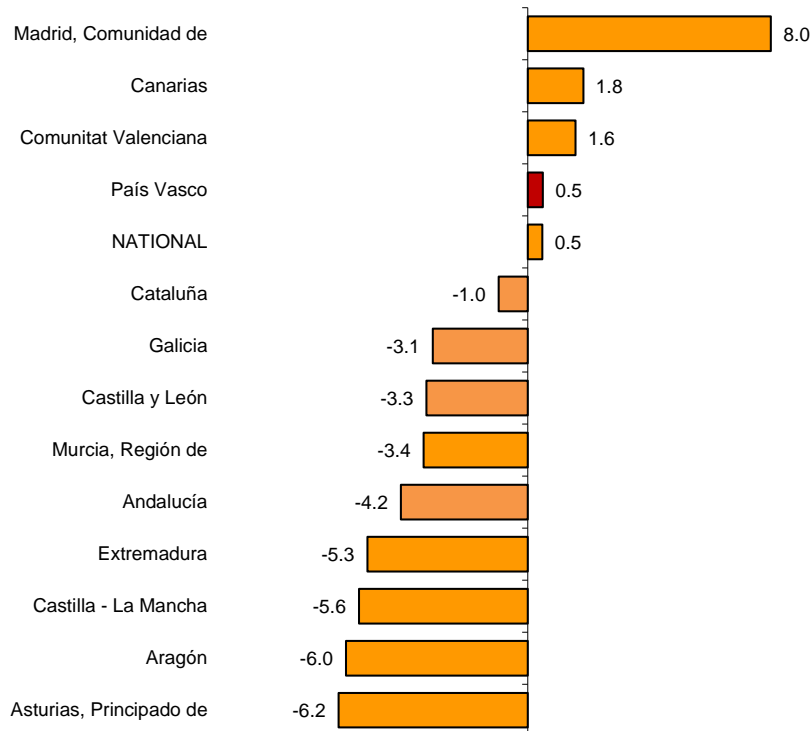

The number of passengers of bus transport registered the greatest increase in Comunidad de Madrid (8.0%), Canarias (1.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (1.6%).

In turn, Principado de Asturias (-6.2%), Aragón (-6.0%) and Castilla-La Mancha (-5.6%) registered the greatest decreases.

Inter-city transport

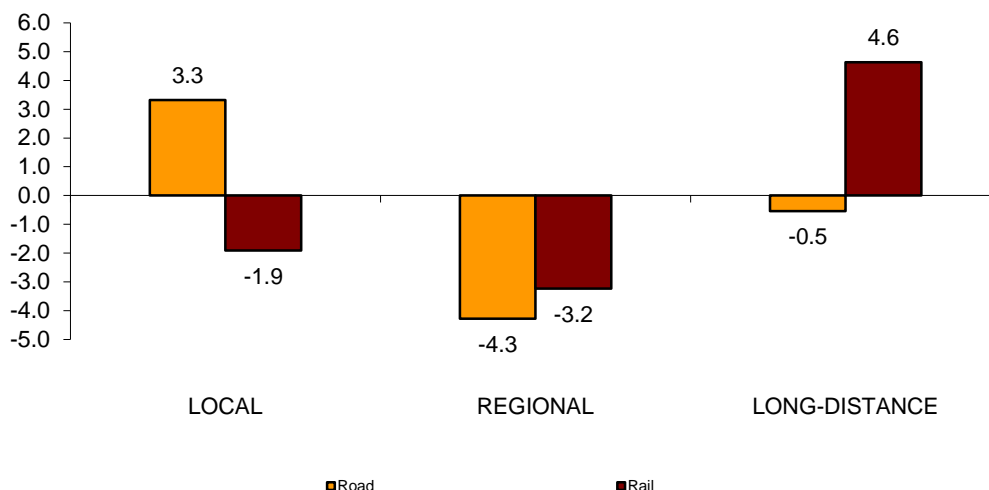
More than 108.8 million passengers used inter-city transport in July, representing a 0.1% increase as compared with the same month of 2015.

Maritime transport increased by 12.8%, air transport increased by 5.3% and bus transport increased by 0.9% while rail transport decreased by 1.6%.

Local distance passengers increased by 3.3% for bus transport and decreased by 1.9% for rail transport. Regional distance passengers decreased by 4.3 for bus transport and decreased by 3.2% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers decreased by 0.5% for bus transport and increased by 4.6% for rail transport. Within the last one, AVE increased by 6.7%.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 25.7 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in July, indicating an increase of 3.4% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased 5.9%, reaching more than 7.6 million users. Within this, school transport increased by 0.3%, and work transport decreased by 6.4%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 7.9%, as compared with the same month of the previous year, reaching more than 18.0 million passengers.
