

Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)
August 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The number of passengers using **city transport** increases 4.5% in August 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The **number of passengers using inter-city transport** increases 1.3% in the interannual rate.
- **Special and unscheduled transport** registers an increase of 1.0%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

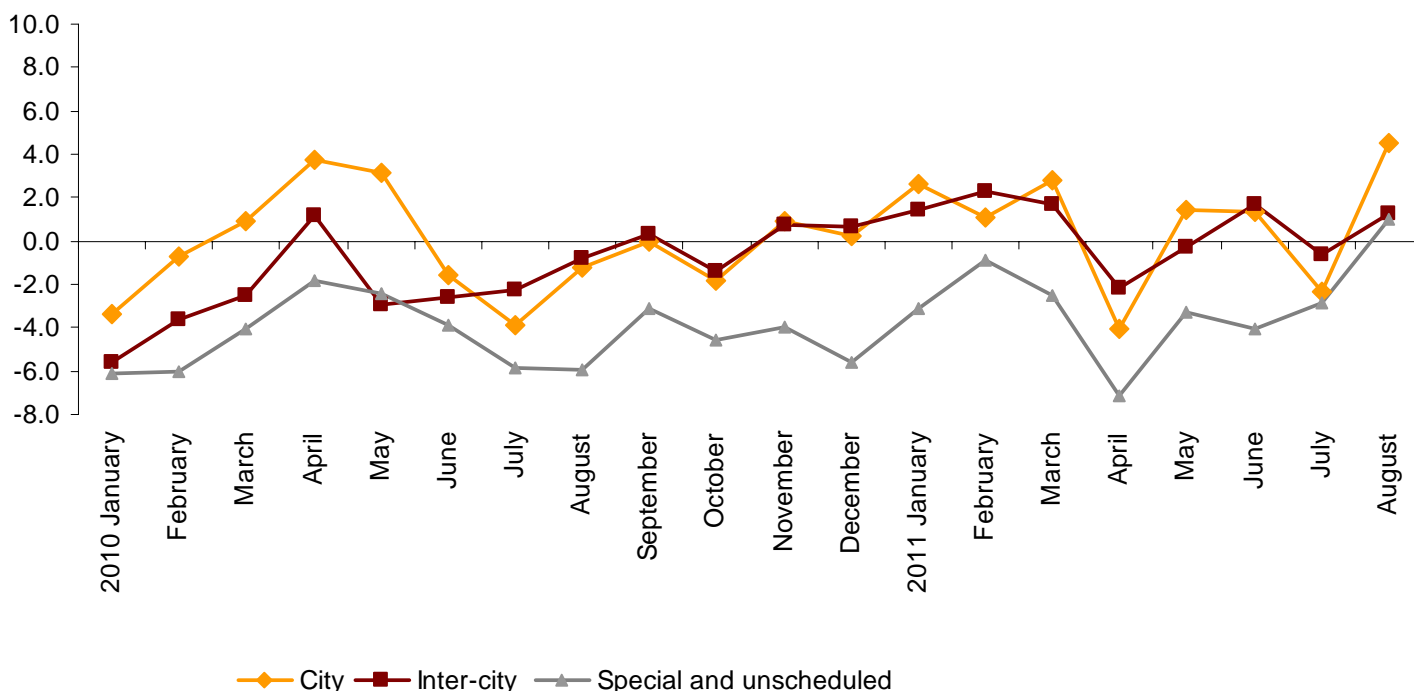
Evolution of passenger transport

More than 294 million passengers used public transport in August 2011, that is, 3.2% more than in the same month the previous year.

The average rate of the total passengers grown 0.5% for the first eight months in 2011 as compared with the previous year. By type of transport, all types presented positive average rates during this period, except special and unscheduled transport, which registered a decrease of 3.2%.

City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

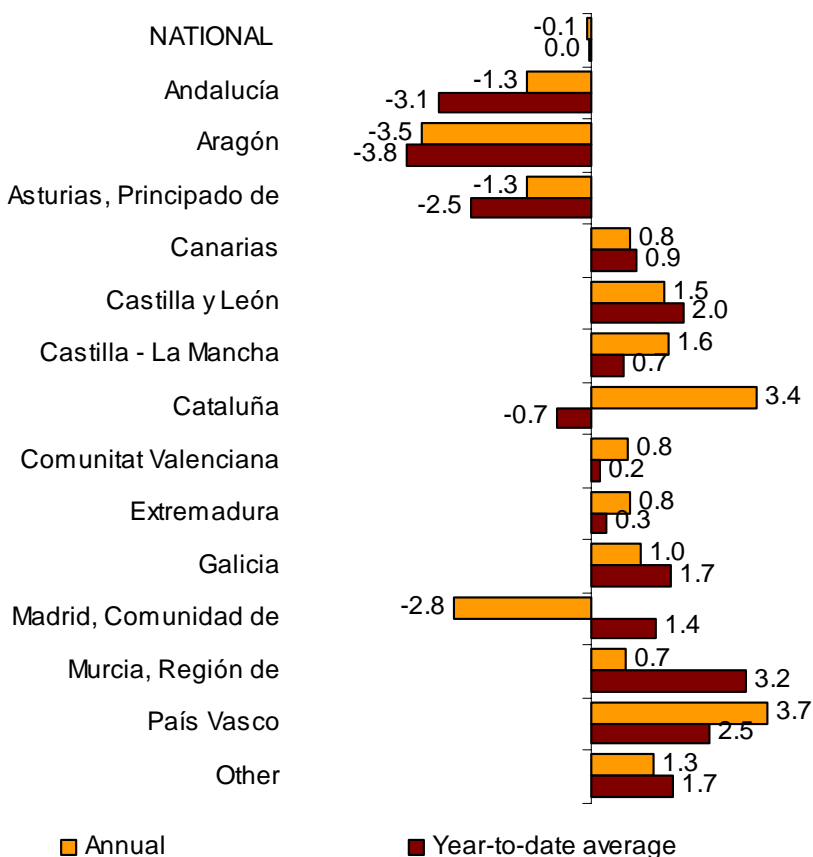
City transport was used by more than 180 million passengers in August, 4.5% more than in the same month the previous year.

Metropolitan transport increased 11.8% in the interannual rate. All of the metropolitans registered increases, except for the Palma metropolitan. Worth noting among the increases was Madrid (18.6%).

The city transport by bus decreased 0.1% in the interannual rate, with more than 105.5 million passengers in August.

By Autonomous Communities, the highest increase were registered in País Vasco (3.7%) and Cataluña (3.4%). The highest decrease were registered in Aragón (-3.5%) and Comunidad de Madrid (-2.8%).

Urban transport by road**



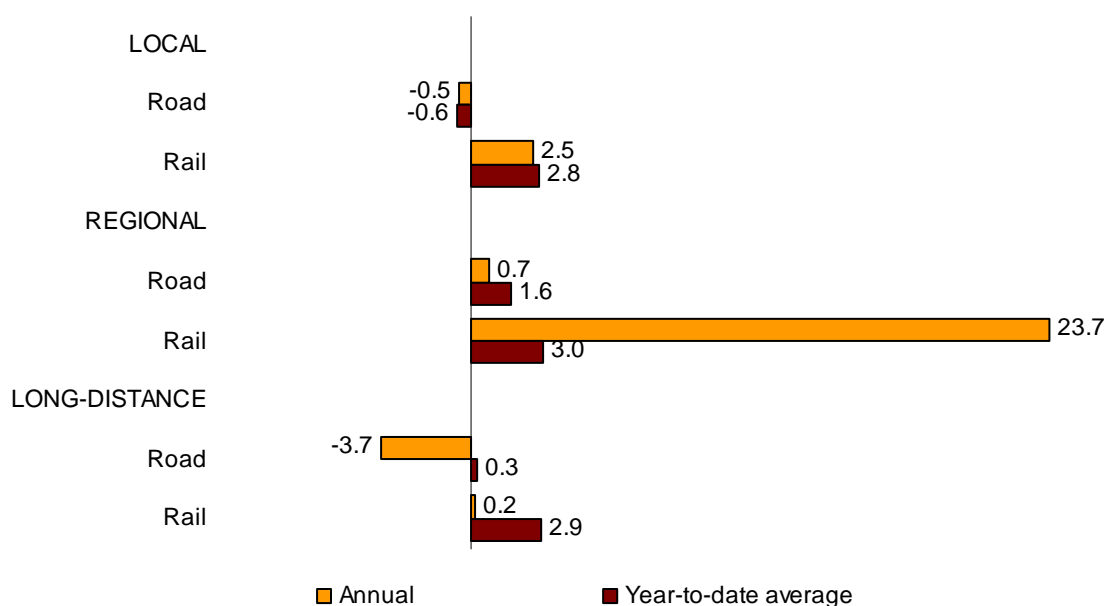
Inter-city transport

Nearly than 94 million passengers used inter-city transport in August 2011, indicating an interannual increase of 1.3%.

Air transport and **road** (coach) transport decreased 0.3% and 0.2% respectively. In turn, **Rail** transport and **Sea** transport increased 3.7% and 0.5% respectively.

Local transport increased 2.5% in rail transport and decreased 0.5% in passenger transport by bus. Regional transport increased 23.7% in rail transport, and 0.7% in bus transport. Meanwhile, long-distance increased 0.2% in rail transport, and decreased 3.7% in road (coach) transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 20 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in August, indicating an increase of 1.0% in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 3.6%, standing at more than 6 million. Within this, school transport decreased 3.1% and work transport decreased 3.6%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 3.1%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching 14 million passengers.
