Passenger Transport Statistics (PT) August 2017. Provisional data

The number of passengers using public transport increases by 1.8% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year


City transport increases by 3.1% in the annual rate and inter-city transport decreases by 0.1%

Evolution of passenger transport

More than 295.3 million passengers used public transport in August, 1.8% more than in the same month of 2016.

City transport increased by 3.1% in the annual rate and inter-city transport decreased by 0.1% Within this, bus transport decreased by 0.8%.

Annual evolution of passengers transport



Evolution of the monthly rate

The variation rate for the number of passengers of public transport in August, as compared with July, was –18,9%. To contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, the evolution of the monthly rate of public transport passengers in recent years is shown in the following chart.




Evolution of the monthly rate (month-on-month variation for August as compared with July)

City transport

City transport was used by more than 180.8 million passengers in August, 3.1% more than in the same month of 2016.

Metro transport registered an increase of 5.5%. Metro transport in Palma registered the greatest increase (26.1%), while that of Barcelona registered the only decrease (-1.3%).

Among the cities with metro, the greatest increase in bus transport was registered in Barcelona (5.1%), while the only decrease was registered in Palma (-1.8%).

City transport by bus increased 1.6% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year.

The number of passengers of bus transport registered the greatest increases in Región de Murcia (8.7%), Cataluña (3.8%) and Canarias (3.2%).

In turn, decreases were registered in Principado de Asturias and Extremadura (-0,9%) for both cases) and Galicia (-0,5%).


Inter-city transport

More than 93.5 million passengers used inter-city transport in August, representing a 0.1% decrease as compared with the same month of 2016.

By type of transport, air transport increased by 5.2%, maritime transport by 2.0%, rail by 0.3%, while bus transport decreased by 0.8%.

Local distance passengers decreased by 0.9% for bus transport and increased by 0.5% for rail transport. Regional distance passengers decreased by 0.5% for bus transport and 3.4% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers decreased by 1.7% for bus transport and increased by 2.0% for rail transport. Within the latter, AVE (high speed railway) increased by 2.3%.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 21.0 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in August, indicating an increase of 0.3% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased by 11.4%, reaching more than 4.9 million users. Within this, school transport increased by 20.4%, while work transport decreased by 12.0%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 4.6%, as compared with the same month of 2016, reaching more than 16.0 million passengers.
