## Nature, characteristics and purpose

The Economically Active Population Survey is an inquiry that is conducted to find out the characteristics of the population in respect of economic activity. The methodology used is that recommended by the International Labour Organization (ILO). To achieve these aims, we are forced to ask for your cooperation.

## Legislation

### Statistical Secrecy

The personal data that may be obtained by the statistics services, both directly from the informants and through administrative sources, shall be the subject of protection and be covered by **statistical secrecy** (art. 13.1 of the Public Statistical Function Law (PSFL) of 9 May 1989). All statistics personnel will be compelled to maintain statistical secrecy (art. 17.1 of PSFL).

### Obligation to supply information

Laws 4/1990 and 13/1996 establish the **obligation to supply the information** that may be requested for the compiling of these Statistics.

The statistics services may ask for data of all natural and legal persons, both Spanish and foreign, resident in Spain (article 10.1 of the PSFL).

All natural and legal persons who supply information, both whether their cooperation is compulsory or voluntary, **must answer truthfully, accurately, fully and within the time limit** the questions duly asked by the statistics services (art. 10.2 of the PSFL). To ensure that these rules are met, the PSFL (art. 48) confers penalizing capacity on the National Institute of Statistics.
