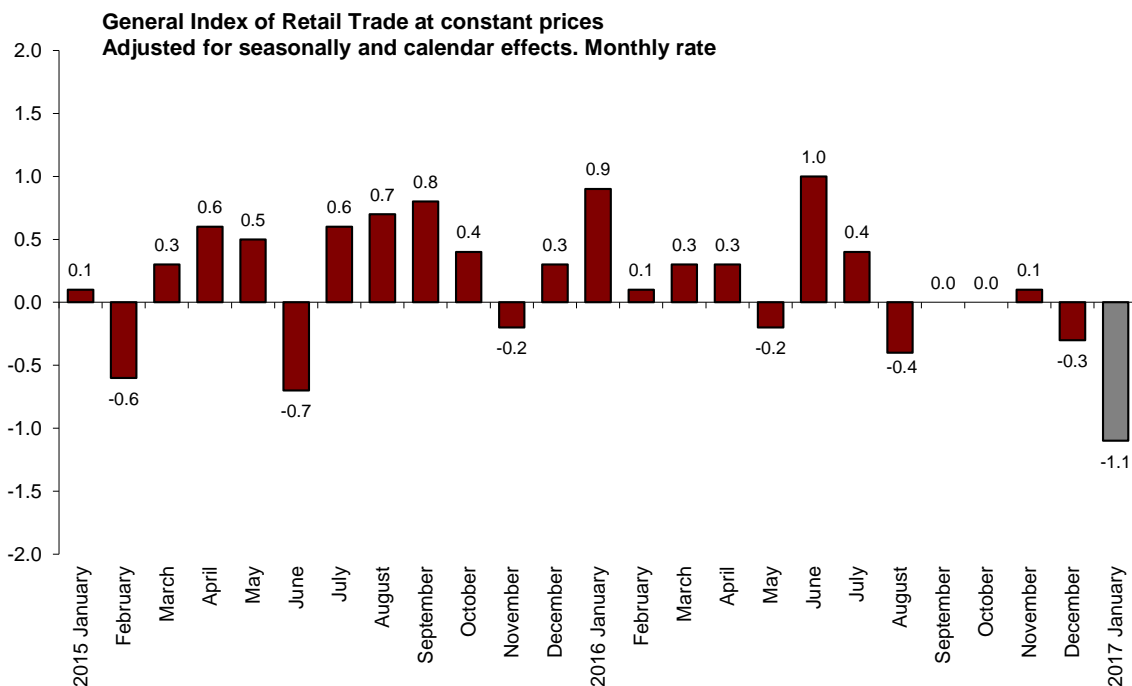
**Retail Trade Indices (RTI). Base 2010**  
January 2017. *Provisional data*

**The monthly variation of the Retail Trade Index at constant prices is -1.1% after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects.**

**The annual rate of the General Retail Trade Index at constant prices stands at 0.1% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at -0.1% in the original series.**

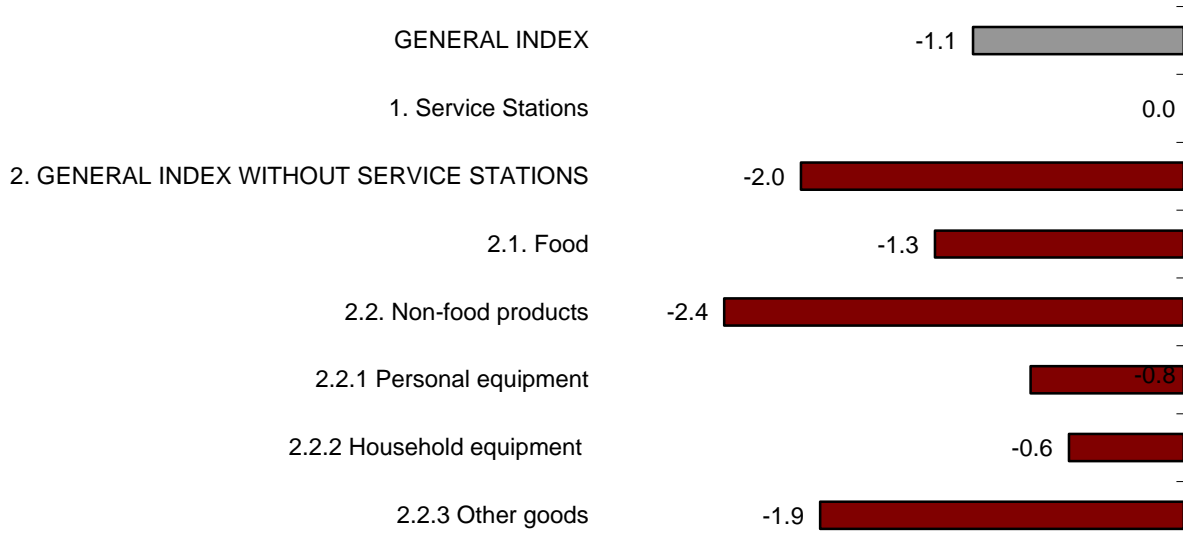
**Monthly evolution of sales in the retail trade**

The monthly variation of the general Retail Trade Index (RTI) at constant prices between the months of January and December, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects is -1,1%. This rate is eight tenths of a point lower than the previous month.



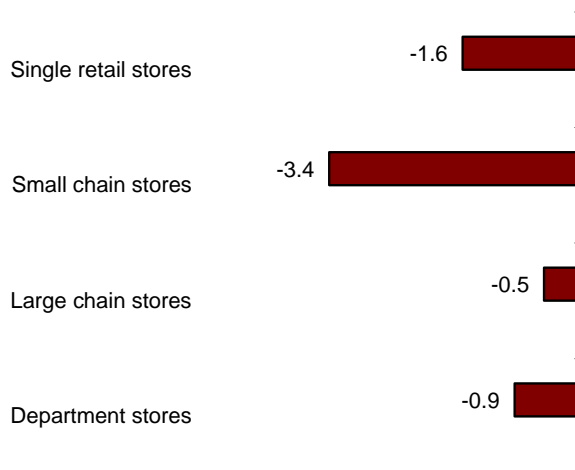
The general index without service stations records a monthly rate of -2.0%. By products, *Food* decreases by 1.3% and *Non-food products* by 2.4%. If the latter is broken down by type of product, *Other goods* has the most negative rate (-1.9%).

All modes of distribution record negative monthly rates, *Small chains* (-3.4%) is the one that decreased the most.

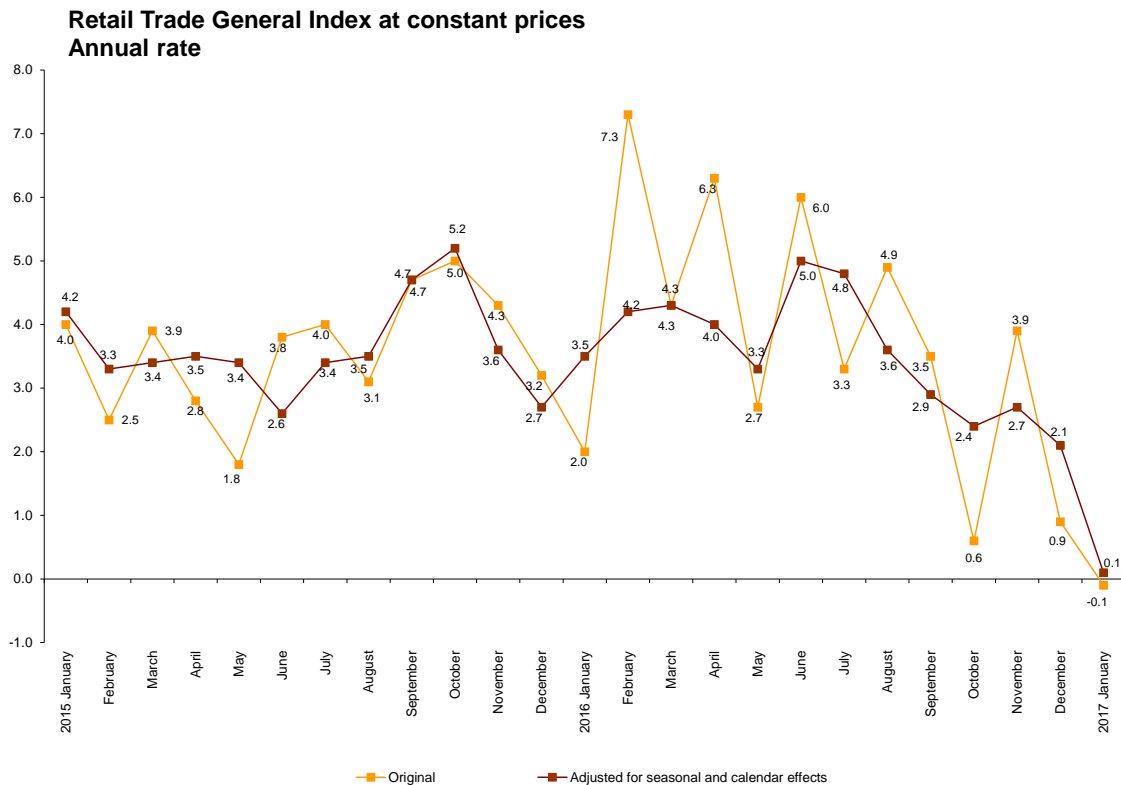
**Sales indices at constant prices by distribution class

### Annual evolution of sales in the retail trade

In January, the monthly variation of the General Retail Trade Index adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects stands at 0.1% in relation to the same month of the previous year. This rate is two points lower than that recorded in December.

The original series of the RTI at constant prices records a variation of -0.1% compared to January 2016, which is a point below the rate of the previous month.



The general index excluding service stations and adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects records an annual variation of -0.6% in January. If these sales are broken down by product type, *Food* increases by 0.9% and *Non-food products* decreases by 1.8%.

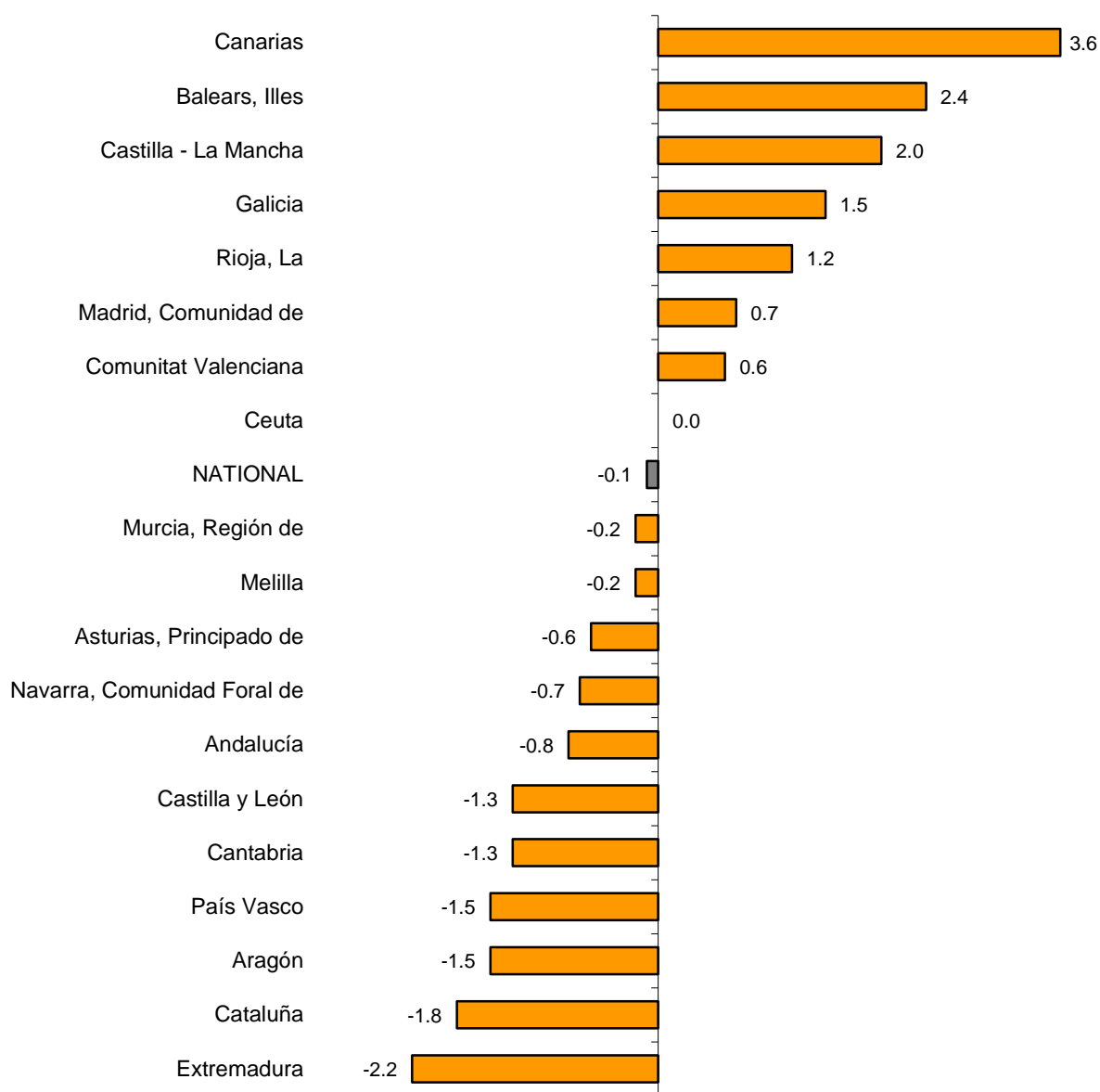

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate in sales. Original series**

Retail sales decreased in 10 autonomous communities compare to January 2016 and increased in the other seven. Extremadura (-2.2%), Cataluña (-1.8%) and Aragón and País Vasco (both -1.5%) have the greatest decreases.

In turn, Canarias (3.6%), Illes Balears (2.4%) and Castilla-La Mancha (2.0%) recorded the greatest increase.

## Evolution of employment

In January, the employment index in the retail trade sector has a variation of 1.8% compared to the same month in 2016. This rate was one tenth lower than that registered in December. Employment increased 1.7% in *Service stations*.

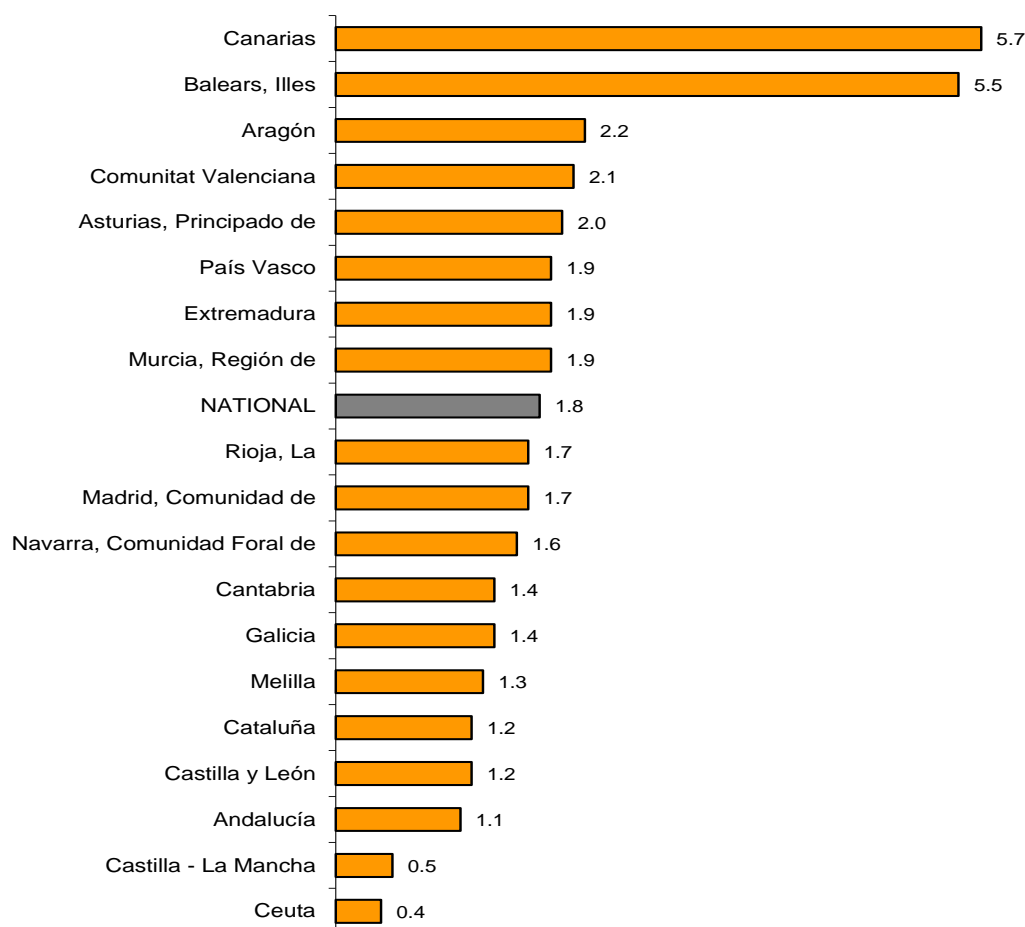
