**Flash estimate of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and
of the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)**
April 2015

**The annual change of the flash estimate of the CPI stands at -0.6%
in April, one tenth higher than that registered in March**

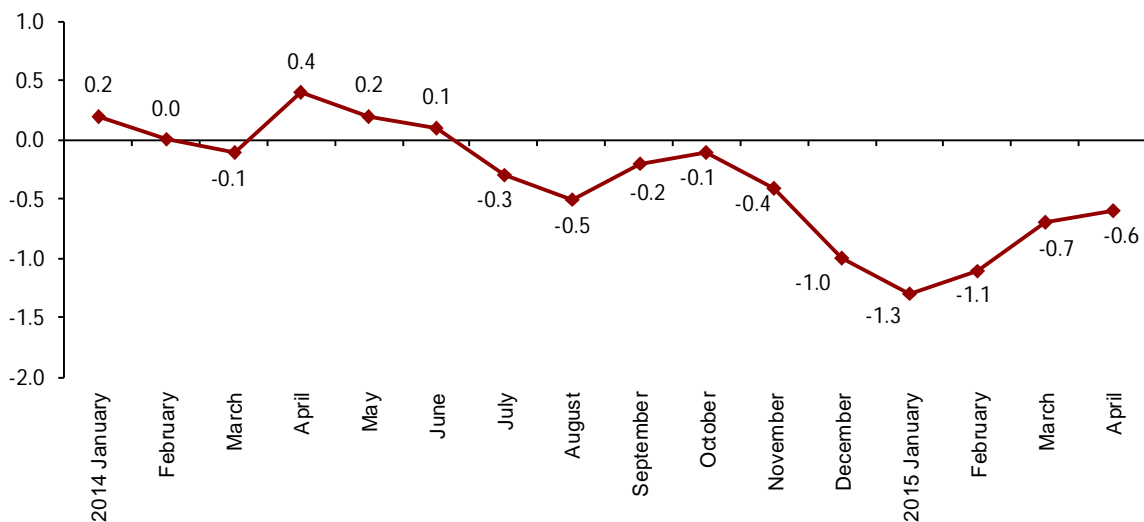
The annual change of the HICP flash estimate is -0.7%

According to the flash estimate published by the INE, the annual inflation of the CPI in April 2015 is -0.6% .

This indicator provides a preview of the CPI that, if confirmed, would imply an increase of one tenth in its annual rate, given that in March this change was -0.7% .

This increase is mainly explained by the increase in the prices of *electricity*.

General Index**



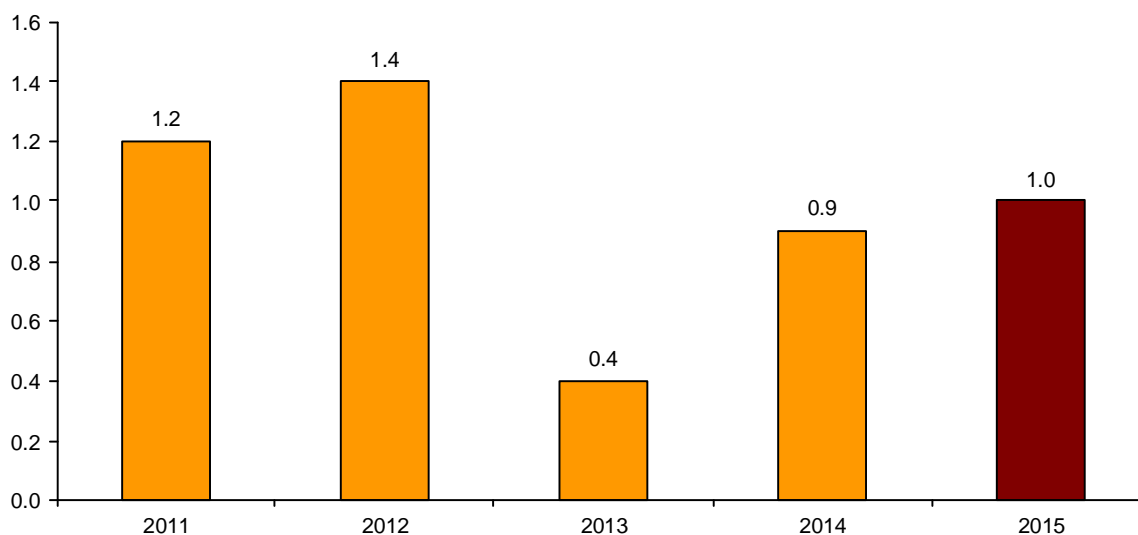

In turn, the annual change of the HICP flash estimate in April stands at -0.7% . If confirmed, the annual change of the HICP would have increased one tenth as compared to the previous month.

Evolution of the monthly change

According to the flash estimate of the CPI, consumer prices registers a 1.0% variation in April, as compared to the month of March.

Evolution of the monthly rate of the CPI in the month of April



In turn, the monthly change of the HICP flash estimate in April stands at 0.7%.
