Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005 April 2013. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 7.3% in April, as compared with -10.0% in March

The adjusted for calendar effect annual rate of the IPI stands at -1.8%, as compared with -0.8% in March

Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered an annual rate of 7.3% in April, over 17 points higher than that registered in March.

All the industrial sectors registered positive annual variations. Those with a greater effect were:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with an annual variation of 12.0% and an effect of 3.382 due to the increase in the production in nearly all the activities in this sector. Among them, it is worth highlighting *Manufacture of other food products, Manufacture of pharmaceutical specialities* and *Manufacture of beverages.*
- •Capital goods, with a variation of 11.6% and an effect of 2.141 in the general index. Nearly all the activities in this sector increased their production. The activities that most influenced this increase were *Manufacture of motor vehicles*, *Manufacture of components*, *pieces and accessories for motor vehicles* and *Manufacture of other general purpose machinery*. Among the activities that decreased their production highlighting, *Naval construction* and *Manufacture of metal products for construction*.
- Intermediate goods, with a rate of 3.9% and an effect of 1.356, due to the increase in the production of most of the activities in this sector. The activities wit a greater influence were the Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferroalloy products, Treatment and coating of metals; mechanical engineering by third parties and Manufacture of articles of paper and cardboard. Among the activities that registered a decrease in the production, highlighting Manufacture of other chemical products and Extraction of stone sand and clay.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of IPI in the month of April 2013.

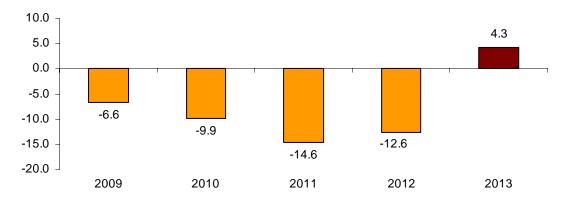

Monthly rate evolution¹

The variation rate of IPI in April as compared with March 2013 was 4.3%. This is the highest rate registered in the last five years.

¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, it has been added in this section the performance of the monthly IPI rate in April in the last years. The monthly rates of this type of series may have a seasonal behavior; therefore it is advisable to evaluate it in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

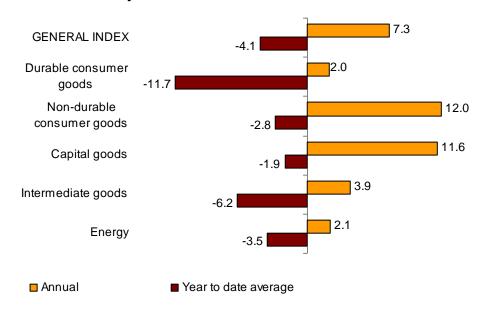


Year to date average rates

The average of the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of **-4.1%**, in the period comprehending January to April 2013 as compared with the same period of the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods this rate was negative in all sectors.

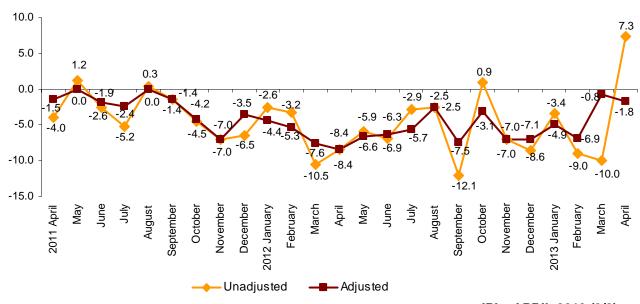
Annual and average rates of the IPI General index and by economic destination



Evolution of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the annual variation of the IPI in the month of April was **–1.8%**, one point below that registered in March.

Annual evolution of IPI General index adjusted and unadjusted

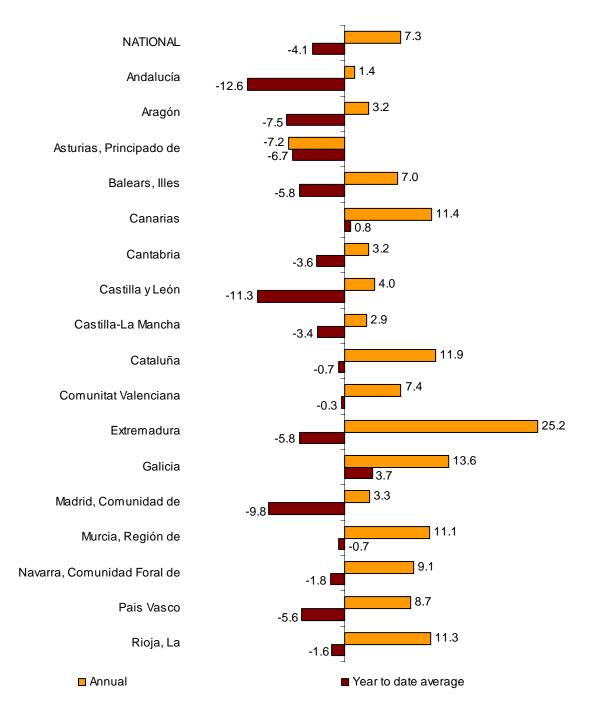


Results by Autonomous Community. Variation rates.

In April, the Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest increases in the annual rate of IPI were Extremadura (25.2%), Galicia (13.6%) and Cataluña (11.9%).

In turn, Principado de Asturias (-7.2%) was the only Autonomous Community that registered a negative annual rate.
