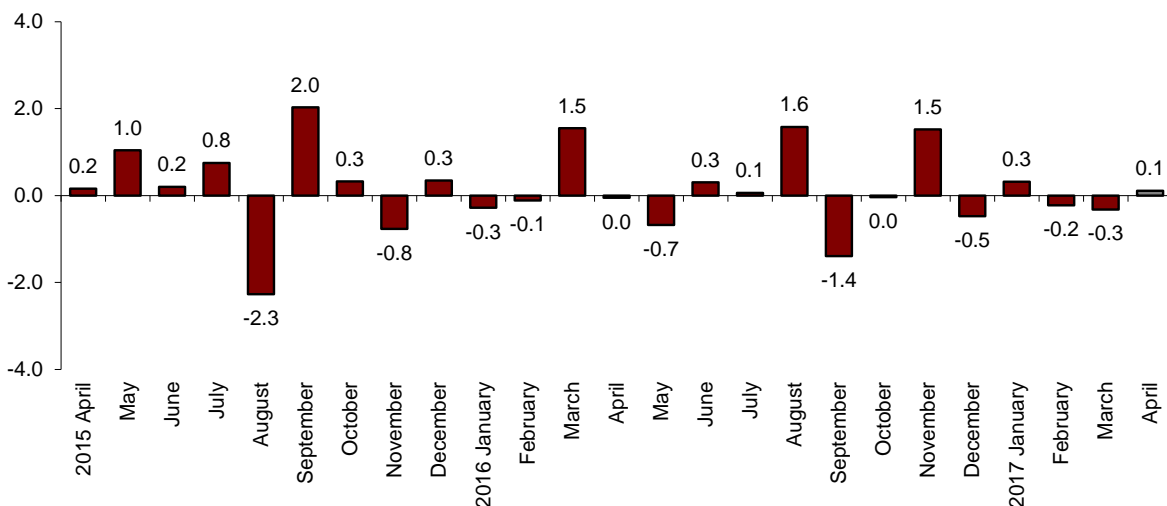
The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index is 0.1% when adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects.

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.7% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at -10.2% in the original series

Monthly evolution of Industrial Production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between April and March stood at 0.1%. This rate is 0.4 points higher than that observed in March.

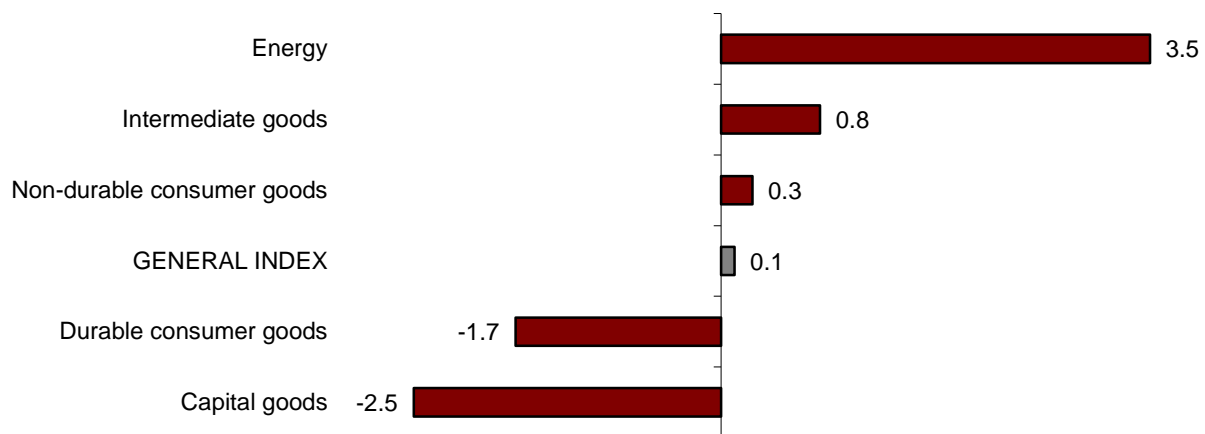
General Industrial Production Index

By sectors, *Energy* (3.5%), *Intermediate goods* (0.8%), and *Non-durable consumer goods* (0.3%) registered positive monthly rates.

In turn, *Capital goods* (-2.5%), and *Durable consumer goods* (-1.7%) registered negative monthly rates.

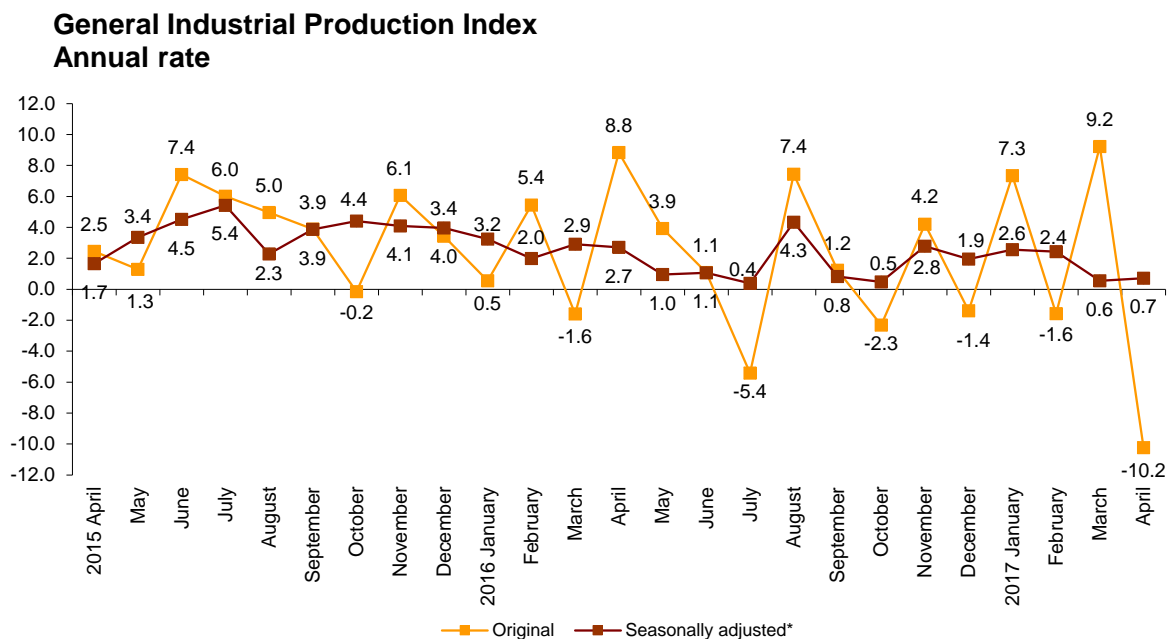

Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of 0.7% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate is 0.1 points higher than that observed in March.

The original series of the IPI registered an annual variation of -10.2%. This rate is 19.4 point lower than that of March.



In the data adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, *Durable consumer goods* (9.0%) and *Intermediate goods* (5.3%) are the sectors that showed the greatest annual increases.

In turn, *Capital goods* (-4.2%) and *Energy* (-1.9%) decreased as compared with the same month of 2016.

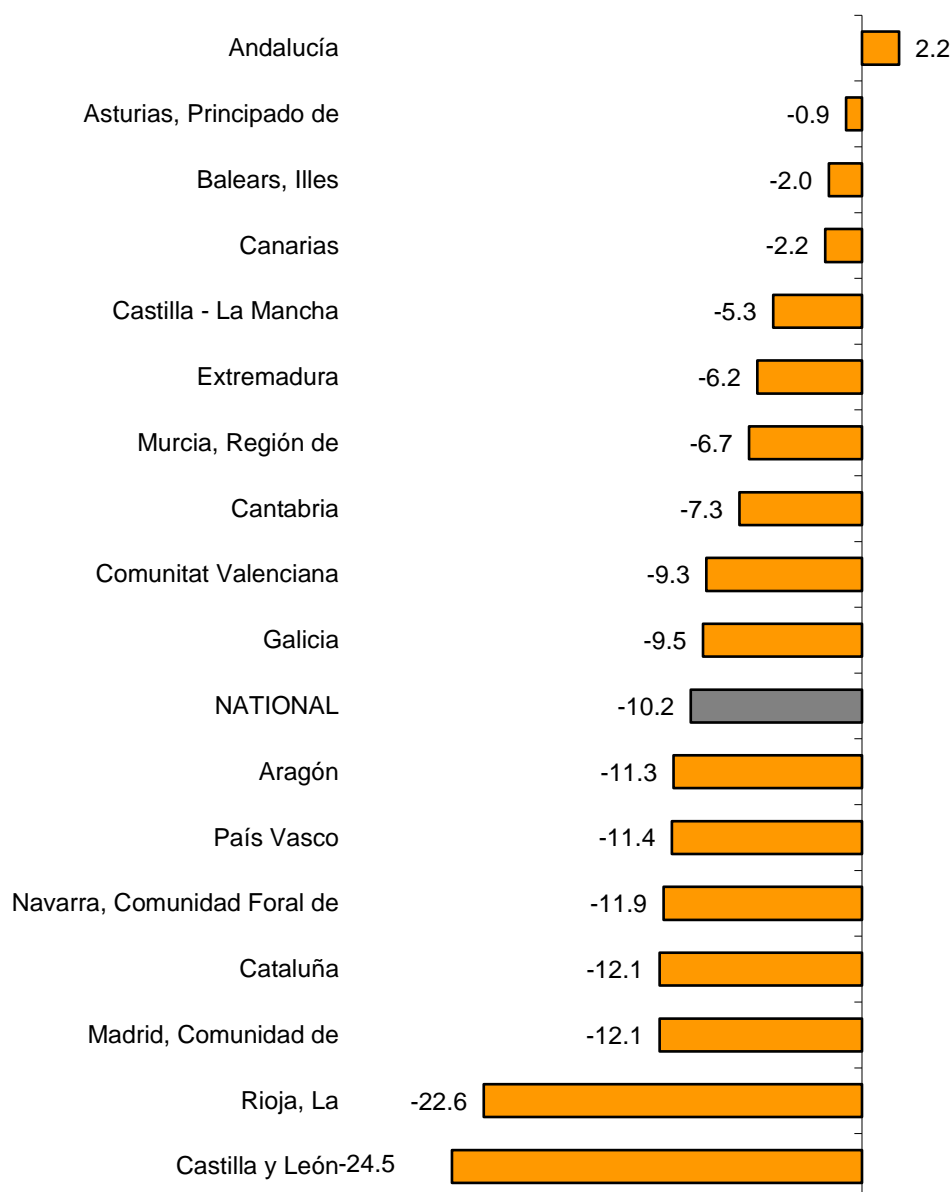

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production is negative in all Autonomous Communities, except in Andalucía (2.2%).

The Autonomous Communities registering the highest decreases were Castilla y León (-24.5%), La Rioja (-22.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña (both with -12.1%).
