

**Industrial Production Index. Base 2005
May 2009**

**The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects
decreases 20.5% in May, as compared with the same month in 2008**

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a –22.3% variation in May 2009, as compared with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI was estimated at –20.5%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the same month the previous year were –13.1% for Consumer goods (-36.2% for Durable consumer goods and –8.8% for Non-durable consumer goods), -28.4% for Capital goods, -28.9% for Intermediate goods and -11.0% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at –10.9% for Consumer goods (-33.1% for Durable consumer goods and –6.7% for Non-durable consumer goods), -26.7% for Capital goods, -27.1% for Intermediate goods and –10.5% for Energy.

**The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 21.6% in the
interannual rate during the first five months of 2009**

The average rate of the IPI stood at –22.8% during the first five months of 2009, as compared with the same period in 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at –21.6%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was –13.7% for Consumer goods (-33.4% for Durable consumer goods and –10.1% for Non-durable consumer goods), -29.4% for Capital goods, -30.5% for Intermediate goods and –9.4% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first five months stood at –12.0% for Consumer goods (-31.2% for Durable consumer goods and –8.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), -28.1% for Capital goods, –29.2 for Intermediate goods and –9.3% for Energy.

The activities that experienced less significant decreases during the January-May 2009 period were *Manufacture of food products*, with –2.7% and *Manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products*, with –4.8%.

Conversely, those activities with the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*, with –46.2%, and *Other mining and quarrying*, with –38.1%.
