Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005 May 2013. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at –1.3% in May, as compared with 7.6% in April

The adjusted for calendar effect annual rate of the IPI stands at –1.3%, as compared with –1.5% in April

Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered an annual rate of -1.3% in May, almost nine points below that registered in April.

The industrial sectors of Intermediate goods, Durable and Non-durable consumer goods and Energy registered positive annual variations. Those with a greater effect were:

• Intermediate goods, with a rate of -3.6% and an effect of -1.241, due to the decrease in the production of most of the activities in this sector. The activities wit a greater influence were the *Manufacture of other chemical products, Manufacture of elements made of concrete, cement and plaster* and *Extraction of stone, sand and clay.* Among the activities that registered an increase in the production, highlighting *Manufacture of basic iron and steel and of ferro-alloys* and *Treatment and coating of metals: machining.*

•Durable consumer goods, with an annual variation of -14.4% and an effect of -0.430 due to the decrease in the production of all activities in this sector. Among them, worth highlighting, *Manufacture of furniture*.

In turn, the activity sector, **Capital goods**, was the only sector that registered a positive annual rate, with a variation of 3.0% and an effect of 0.579 in the general index. Over half of the activities in this sector increased their production, highlighting by their effect *Manufacture of motor vehicles*. Among the activities that registered a decrease in their production, worth highlighting, *Buildings of ships and boats*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of IPI in the month of May 2013.

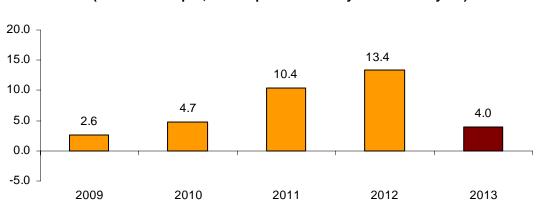

Monthly rate evolution¹

The variation rate of IPI in May as compared with April 2013 was 4.0%.

¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, it has been added in this section the performance of the monthly IPI rate in May in the last years. The monthly rates of this type of series may have a seasonal behavior; therefore it is advisable to evaluate it in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

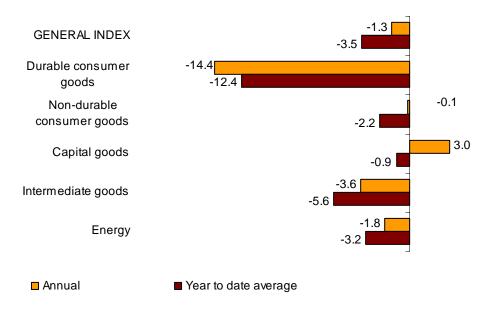


Year to date average rates

The average of the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of -3.5%, in the period comprehending January to May 2013 as compared with the same period of the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods this rate was negative in all sectors.

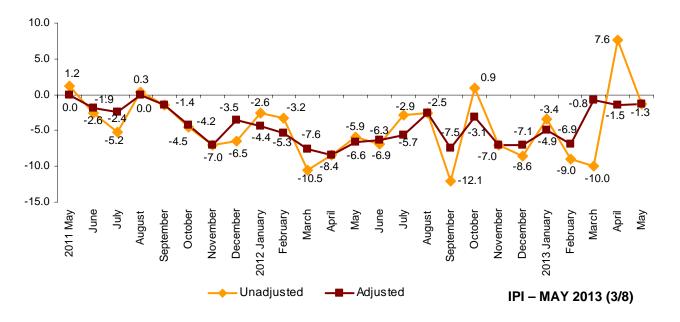
Annual and average rates of the IPI General index and by economic destination

After adjusting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the annual variation of the IPI in the month of May was **-1.3%**, two tenths higher than that registered in April.

Annual evolution of the IPI General index adjusted and unadjusted

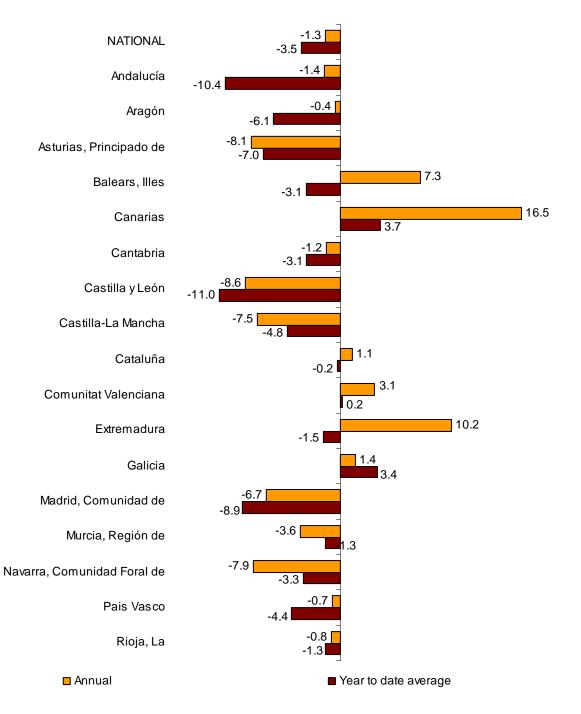


Results by Autonomous Community. Variation rates.

In May, 11 Autonomous Communities registered a negative annual variation in the industrial production. The greatest decreases were registered in Castilla y León (–8.6%), Principado de Asturias (–8.1%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (–7.9%).

In turn, the Autonomous Communities with the greatest increases in their annual rate were Canarias (16.5%), Extremadura (10.2%) and Illes Balears (7.3%).
