Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2010 May 2014. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at -0.7%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 2.5% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 0.4% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production


After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between April and May 2014 stood at -0.7%. This rate was 2.2 points lower than that registered in April.

The industrial sectors of Durable consumer goods (-3.3%), Capital Goods (-2.5%) and Intermediate goods (-0.6%) registered negative variation rates. In turn, Energy (1.3%) and Non-durable consumer goods (0.1%) recorded positive rates.



Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 2.5% in May, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.6 points below that registered in April.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of 0.4%. This rate was 2.5 points higher than that of April.

General Industrial Production Index Annual rate



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, all industrial sectors registered positive annual rates, except Durable consumer goods (-2.9%).

Non-durable consumer goods (3.5%) and Intermediate Goods (2.9%) recorded the greatest positive rates.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in eight Autonomous Communities and decreased in nine of them. The greatest increases were registered in Externadura (9.6%), Aragón (7.5%) and Castilla-La Mancha (4.9%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Galicia (-7.8%), Canarias (-4.2%) and in Región de Murcia (-3.9%).
