
The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.4%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 4.5% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 7.5% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between June and May 2015 stood at 0.4%. This rate was 0.2 points lower than that registered in May.


General Industrial Production Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate



By industrial sectors, Durable consumer goods and Capital goods (both 1.7%) registered the greatest positive monthly variation rates.

In turn, Non-durable consumer goods (-0.5%) and Intermediate goods (-0.4%) were the sectors that registered a negative monthly rate.



Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 4.5% in June, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.3 points higher than that registered in May.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of 7.5%. This rate was more than six points higher than that of May.

General Industrial Production Index Annual rate



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, all sectors registered positive annual rates.

Capital goods (10.9%), Intermediate goods (4.1%) and Energy (3.4%) registered the greatest annual rates.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in 14 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were registered in Castilla-La Mancha (15.2%), Galicia (12.9%) and Comunidad de Madrid (11.3%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Extremadura (-1.8%) and Canarias (-1.0%).
