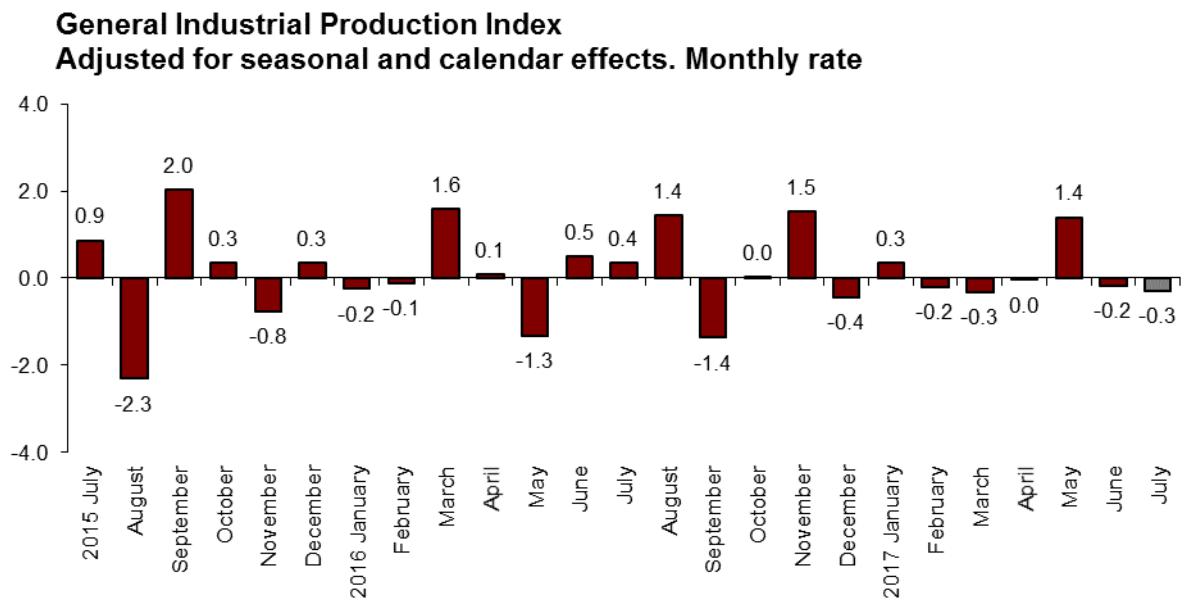
Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2010

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at -0.3%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.9% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 2.0% in the original series

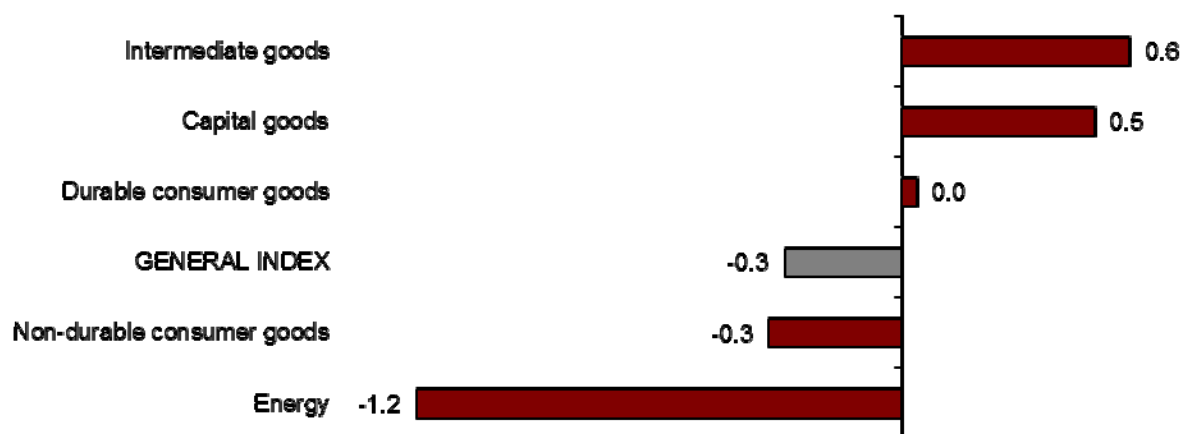
Monthly evolution of Industrial Production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between April and March stood at -0.3%. This rate is 0.1 points lower than that observed in June.



By sector, Intermediate goods (0.6%) and Capital goods (0.5%) have positive monthly rates. In turn, *Non-durable consumer goods* (-0.3%) and *Energy* (-1.2%) had negative monthly rates.

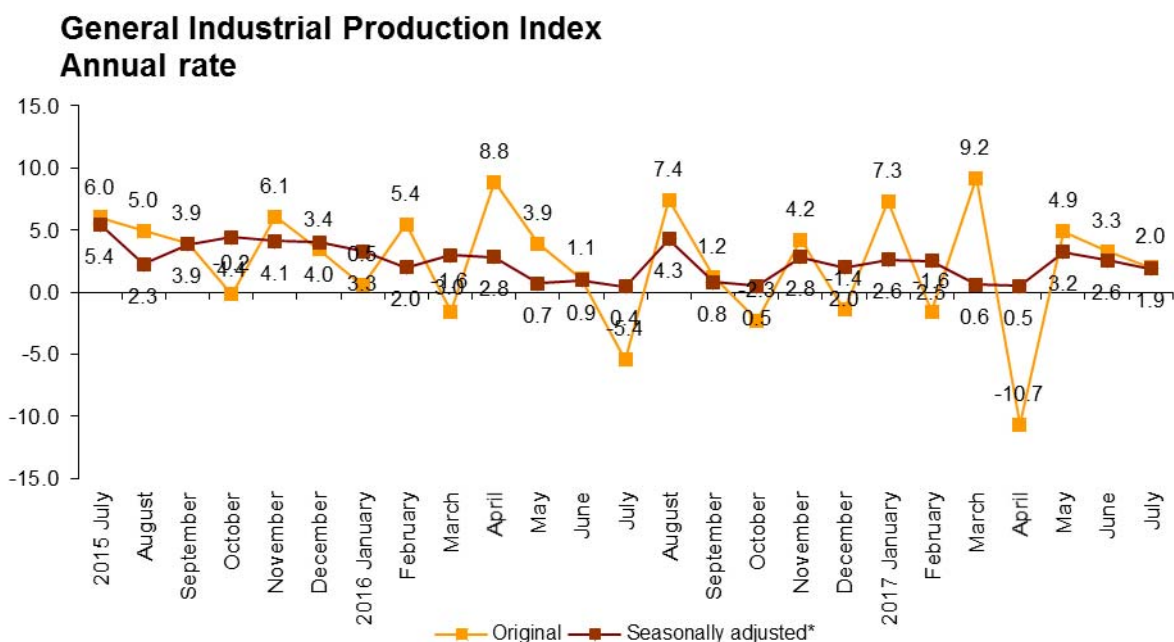

Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of 1.9% in July, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate is 0.7 points lower than that observed in June.

The original series of the IPI registered an annual variation of 2.0%. This rate is 1.3 point lower than that of March.



In the data adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, Durable consumer goods (5.4%) and Intermediate goods (4.9%) are the sectors that experimented the greatest decrease with respect to the same month of 2016:

In turn, *Non-durable consumer goods* (-0.3%) is the only sector that registered a negative annual rate.

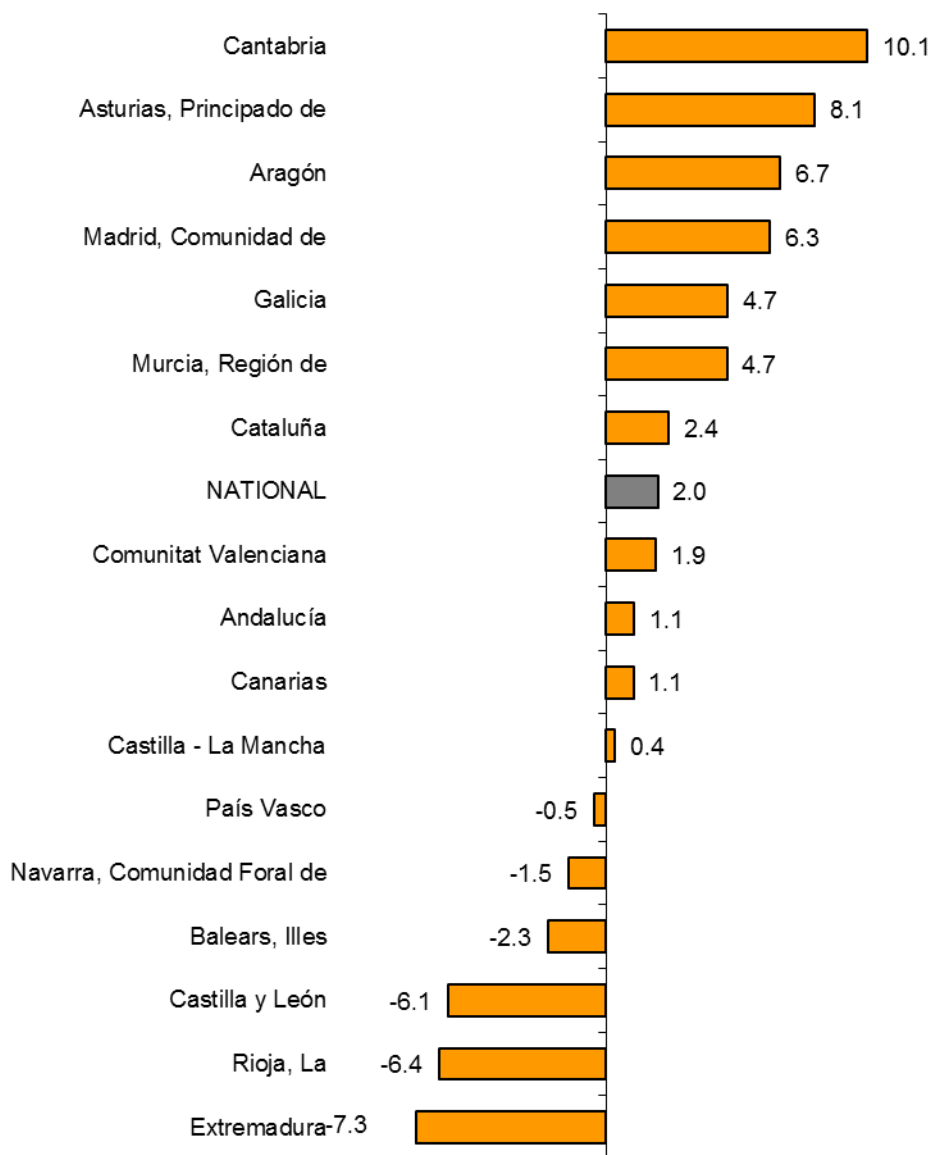

Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rate of the Industrial Production were positive in 11 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases are observed in Cantabria (10.1%), Principado de Asturias (8.1%) and Aragón (6.7%).

Conversely, those showing the most negative annual variation rates were Extremadura (-7.3%), La Rioja (-6.4%) and Castilla y León (-6.1%).
