Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005 September 2012. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at – 11.7% in September, as compared with –2.5% in August

The annual rate of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect, stands at –7.0% in September, as compared with –2.5% in August

Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced an annual variation of -11.7% in September, more than nine tenths below than registered in August.

Every industrial sector showed negative annual rates. Those that most influenced this annual decrease in industrial production were:

• Intermediate goods, with an annual variation of -11.9% and an effect of -3.996 on the general index, due to the decrease in the most activities comprising this sector, being the most important, by its influence, the observed in *Manufacture of other chemical* products and *Treatment and coating of metals; mechanical engineering by third parties.*

• **Capital goods**, with an annual rate of -17.5% and an effect of -3.549 on the general index. Almost the totality of the activities of this sector registered a decrease in production. Among them, worth noting, by its effect, the *Manufacture of metal elements for construction* and *Manufacture of motor vehicles*.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with an annual variation of -10.8% and an effect of -3.108 on the general index, motivated by the drops in production in the majority of the activities comprising this sector. Among them worth noting the *Manufacture of other food products*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the IPI in the month of September.

Monthly rate evolution¹

The variation rate for September as compared with August 2012 was 20.0%, the lowest registered in the last five years.

¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this section has been added with performance of the monthly IPI rate in August for recent years. The intermonthly rates of this type of series may have some degree of seasonal behaviour, therefore it is recommended that it be evaluated in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of **-6.2%** in the first nine months of 2012, as compared with the same period the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, this rate was negative in Durable consumer goods (-12.0%), Capital goods (-11.7%), Intermediate goods (-7.5%) and Non-Durable consumer goods (-3.6%). Conversely, was positive in Energy (0.6%).

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the IPI in the month of **September** was **-7.0%**, four and a half points lowerthan that registered in August.

Results by Autonomous Community. Variation rates.

In August, thirteen Autonomous Communities, except Galicia (2.2%), registered negative annual rates in industrial production. Those that presented the greatest decreases were Aragón (-19.1%) Comunidad de Madrid (-15.3%) and Andalucía (-14.9%).
