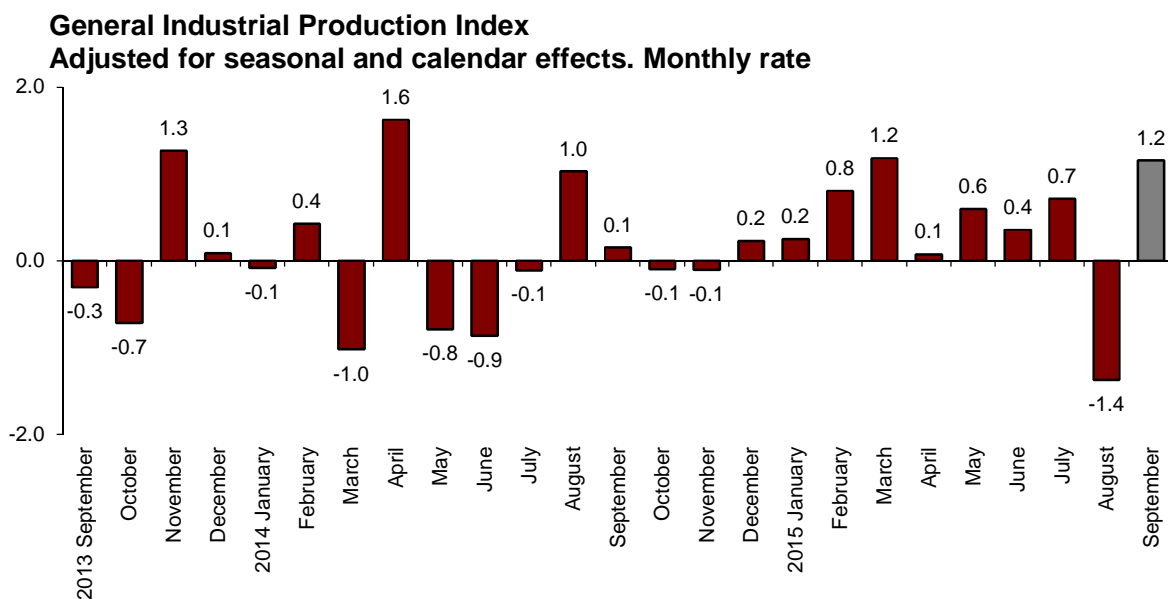
**Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2010**  
September 2015. *Provisional data*

**The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.2%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects<sup>1</sup>**

**The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 3.8% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 4.0% in the original series**

**Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production**

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between September and August 2015 stood at 1.2%. This rate was 2.6 points higher than that registered in August.

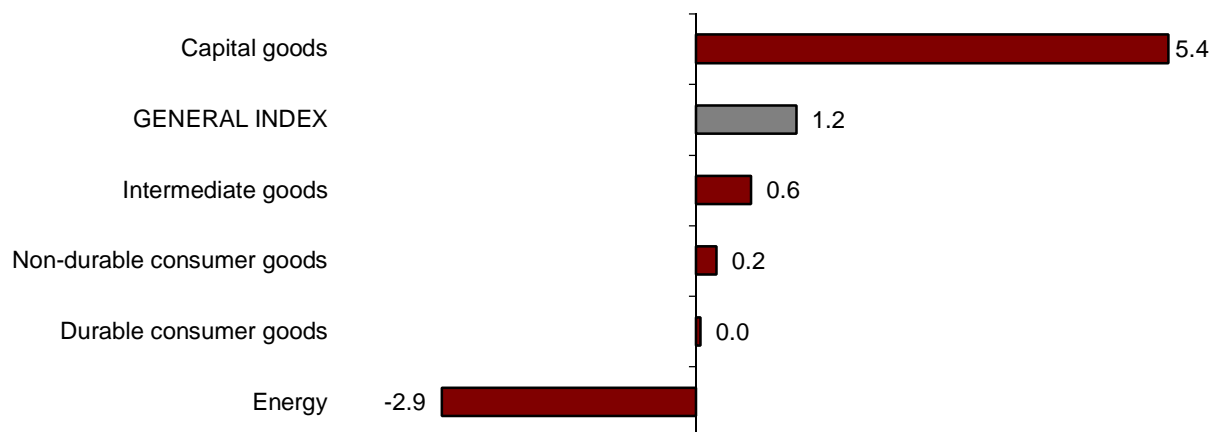


<sup>1</sup> In the summer months, the seasonal adjustment may be influenced both upwardly and downwardly, because of changes in the holiday pattern with respect to its previous standards.

By industrial sectors, Capital goods (5.4%) and Intermediate goods (0.6%) registered the greatest positive monthly variation rates.

In turn, Energy (-2.9%) was the only sector that registered a negative monthly rate.

**Industrial Production Indices: General and by economic destination of the goods. Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate**



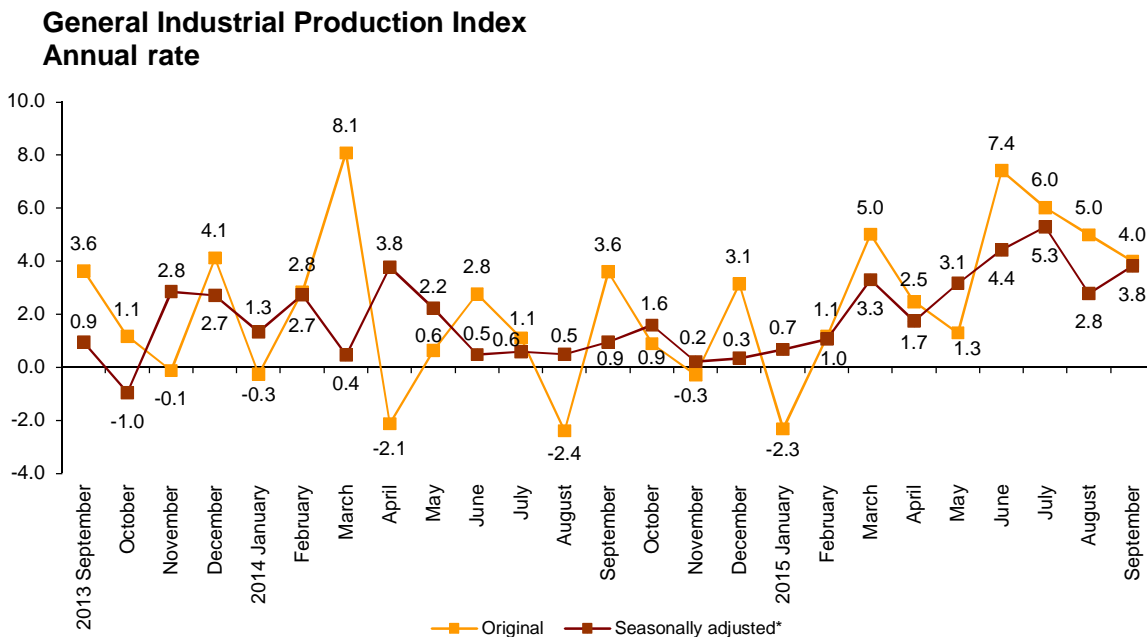
A more detailed analysis showed the activities that registered the highest and lowest monthly rates in the month of September.

**Annual evolution of the Industrial Production**

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of 3.8% in September, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was one point higher than that registered in August.

The original series of the IPI recorded an annual variation of 4.0%. This rate was 1 point lower than that of August.



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, all sectors registered positive annual rates, except Energy (-4.6%).

Capital goods (11.7%), Durable consumer goods (9.3%) and Intermediate goods (5.0%) registered the greatest annual rates.

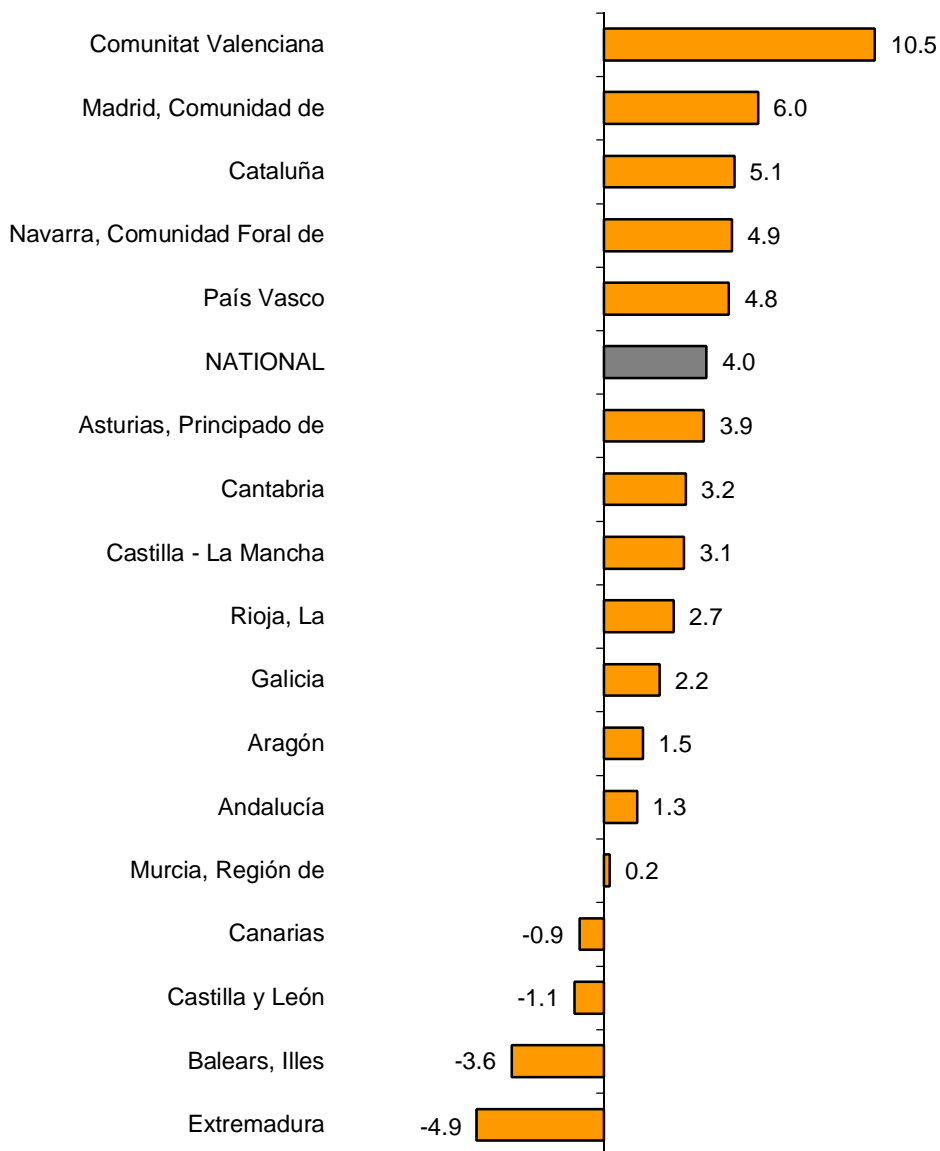

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series**

The annual rate of the Industrial Production increased in thirteen Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were registered in Comunitat Valenciana (10.5%), Comunidad de Madrid (6.0%), and Cataluña (5.1%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Extremadura (-4.9%), Illes Balears (-3.6%), and Castilla y León (-1.1%).
