Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005 December 2012. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at -8.5% in December, as compared with 0.9% in November

The average rate of the IPI registers a decrease of 5.9% in 2012

Annual performance of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced an annual variation of –8.5% in December, one and a half points below that registered in November.

All the industrial sectors presented negative annual rates, except *Energy*. Those with a greater negative effect were:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation of -12.1% and an effect of -3.654 on the general index. Production decreased in most of the activities in this sector. Among them, highlighting *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and *Manufacture of beverages*.
- Intermediate goods, with a rate of -10.5% and an effect of -3.251, due to the general decrease in the production of activities in this sector. The activities that most influenced in this drop were the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and *Manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and plaiting materials* and *Manufacture of electric motors, generators, transformers and electricity distribution and control apparatus.*
- •Capital goods, registered a rate of -6.0% and an effect of -1.140 in the general index, due to the negative performance of most of the activities in this sector. Among them, worth noting the Manufacture of parts and accessories for motor vehicles and Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock.

In turn, *Energy* is the only sector that presented a positive effect in the general index, with an annual rate of 0.1% and an effect of 0.018, due to the increase in *Petroleum refinement*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the IPI in the month of December.





Monthly rate performance¹

The variation rate of IPI in December as compared with November 2012 was -13.1%, the lowest registered in the last five years.






¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, it has been added in this section the performance of the monthly IPI rate in December for the last years. The monthly rates of this type of series may have a seasonal behavior; therefore it is recommended to evaluate it in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of **-5.9%** in 2012, as compared with the same period of 2011.

By economic destination of the goods, this rate was negative in Durable consumer goods (–11.2%), Capital goods (–10.7%), Intermediate goods (–7.2%) and Non-Durable consumer goods (–3.9%). Conversely, it was positive in Energy (0.9%).


Annual and average rates of IPI General Index and by economic destination



Performance of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the IPI in the month of December was **-6.9%**, one tenth higher than that registered in November.

Annual performance of the IPI General Index, adjusted and unadjusted




Results by Autonomous Community. Variation rates.

In December, all Autonomous Communities registered negative annual rates in industrial production except Galicia (1.3%).

Extremadura (-34.8%), Andalucía (-19.4%) and Comunidad de Madrid (-15.8%) registered the greatest decreases.
