December 2014 and Year 2014. *Provisional data*

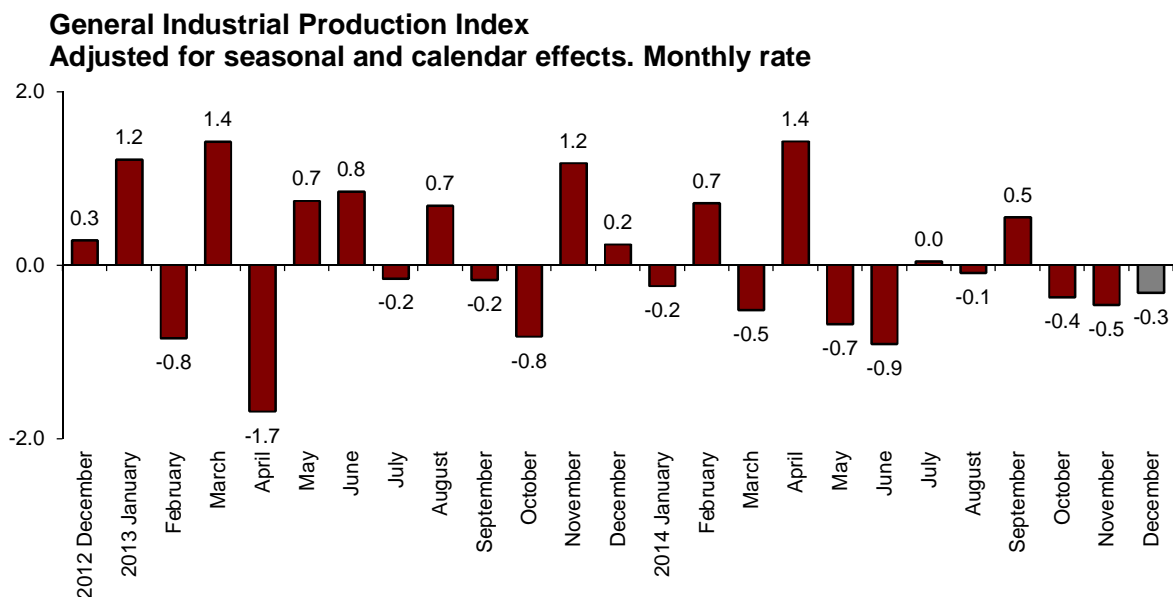
**The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at  $-0.3\%$ , after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects**

**The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at  $-0.9\%$  in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at  $2.1\%$  in the original series**

**In 2014 as a whole, Industrial Production rose by  $1.1\%$  in the corrected series and by  $1.4\%$  in the original series**

**Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production**

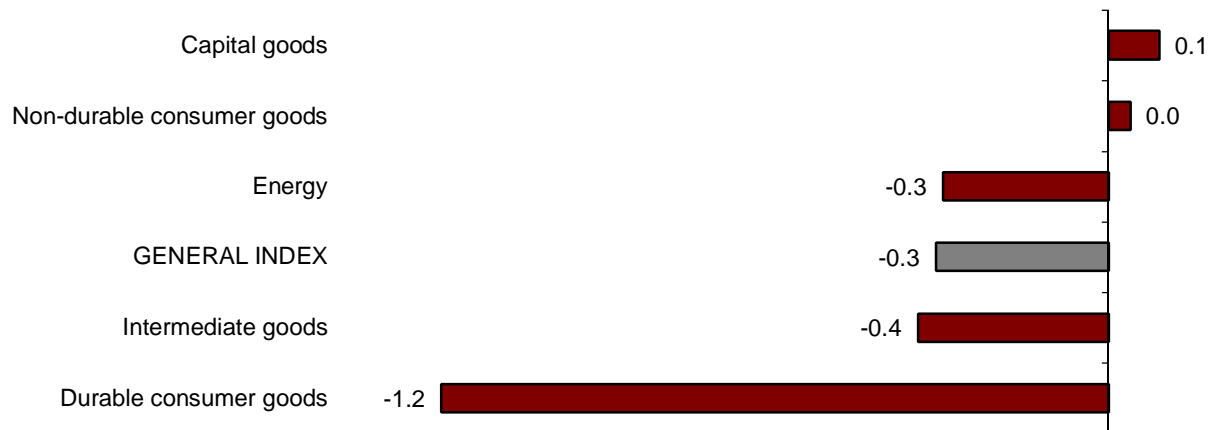
After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between December and November stood at  $-0.3\%$ . This rate was 0.2 points higher than that registered in November.



By Industrial sectors, Capital goods (0.1%) registered a positive monthly variation rate, while Non-durable consumer goods (0.0%) did not vary.

In turn, Durable consumer goods (-1.2%) and Intermediate goods (-0.4%) registered the greatest negative variation rates.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that registered the highest and lowest monthly rates in the month of December.

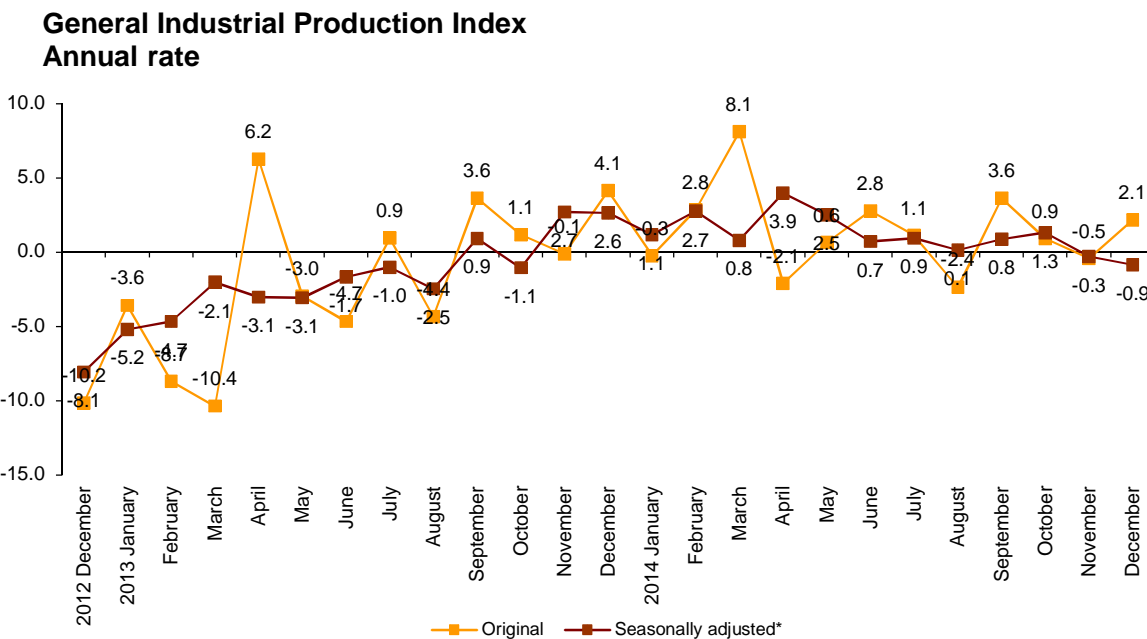

**Annual evolution of the Industrial Production**

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of  $-0.9\%$  in December, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 0.6 points lower than that registered in November.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of  $2.1\%$ . This rate was 2.6 points higher than that of November.



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, Intermediate goods ( $2.5\%$ ) and Durable consumer goods ( $2.2\%$ ) registered positive annual rates. In turn, Energy ( $-4.8\%$ ), Capital goods ( $-1.8\%$ ) and Non-durable consumer goods ( $-0.5\%$ ) registered negative annual rates.

In 2014 as a whole, Industrial Production rose by  $1.1\%$  in the adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects, and by  $1.4\%$  in the original series.

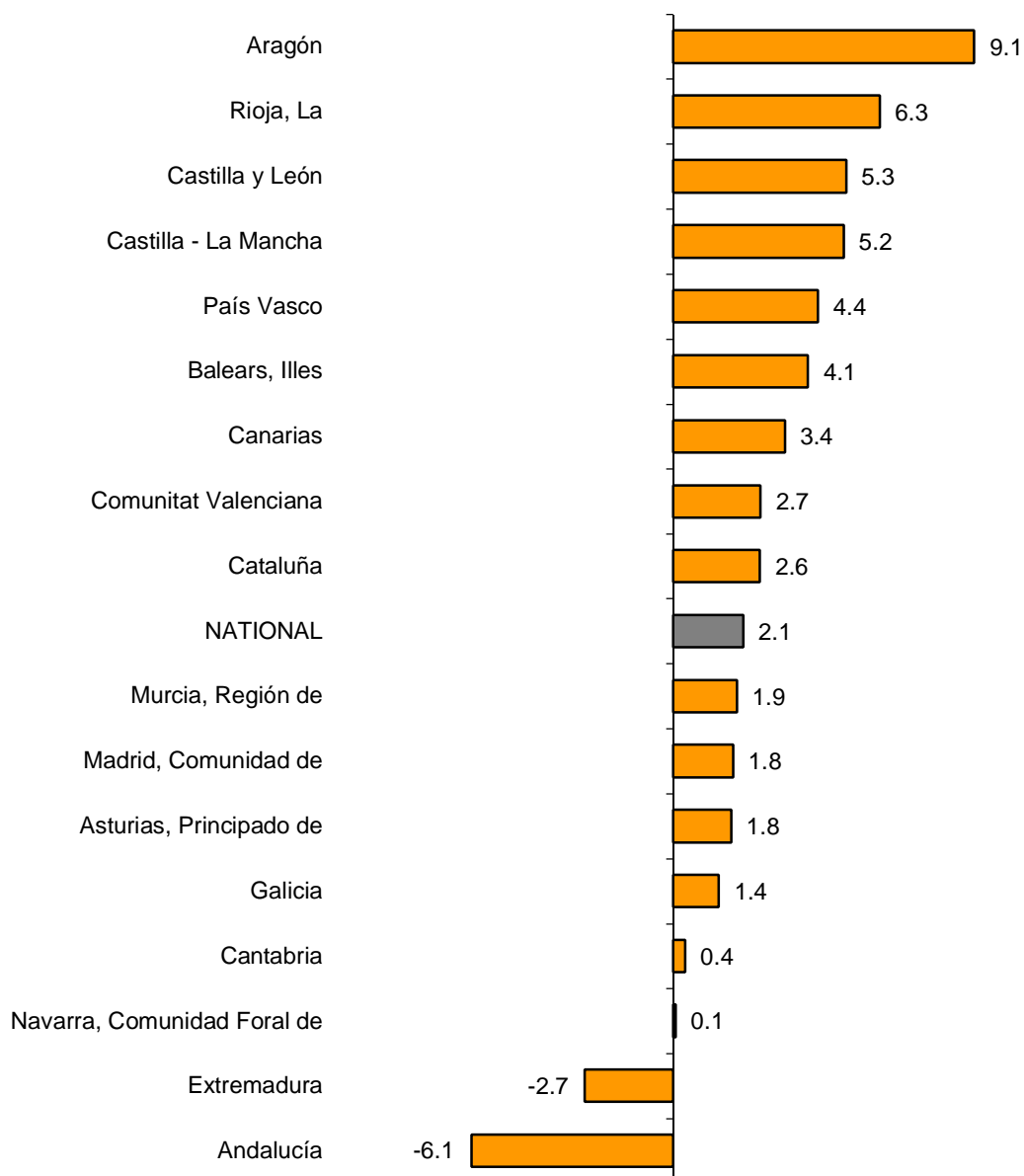

## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production and the average of 2014. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in 15 Autonomous Communities, as compared with the same month of the previous year. The greatest increases were registered in Aragón (9.1%), La Rioja (6.3%), and Castilla y León (5.3%).

In 2014 as a whole, Industrial Production increased in 10 Autonomous Communities. Castilla y León (6.7%), La Rioja (5.5%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (5.3%) registered the highest rates.
