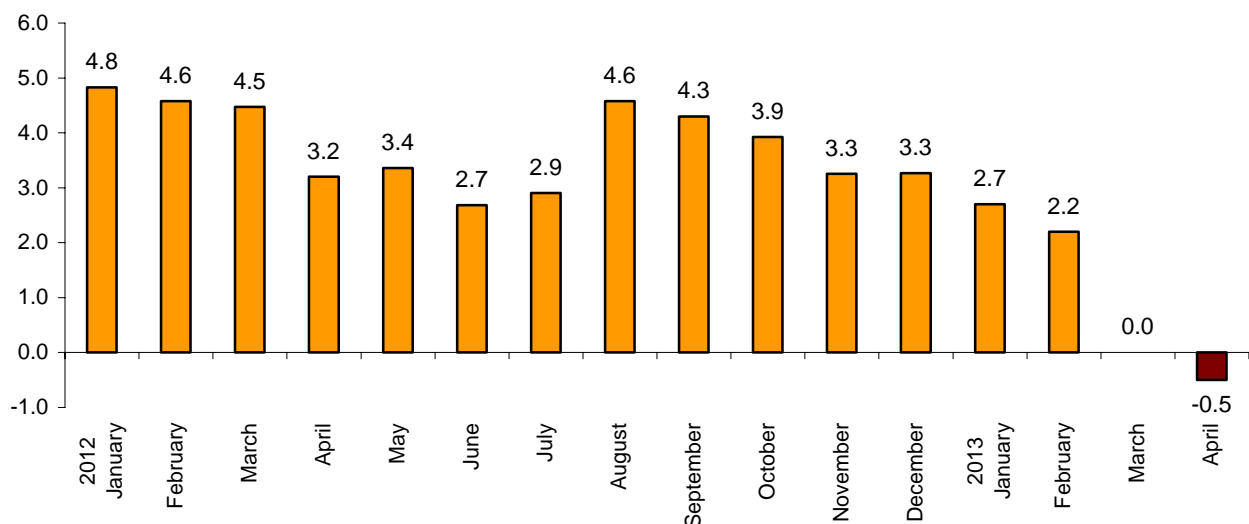

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at -0.5% in April, five tenths below that registered in March. This is the first negative annual rate of the IPRI since November 2009.

By economic destination of the goods, the sectors that most influenced the drop in the general rate of the IPRI were:

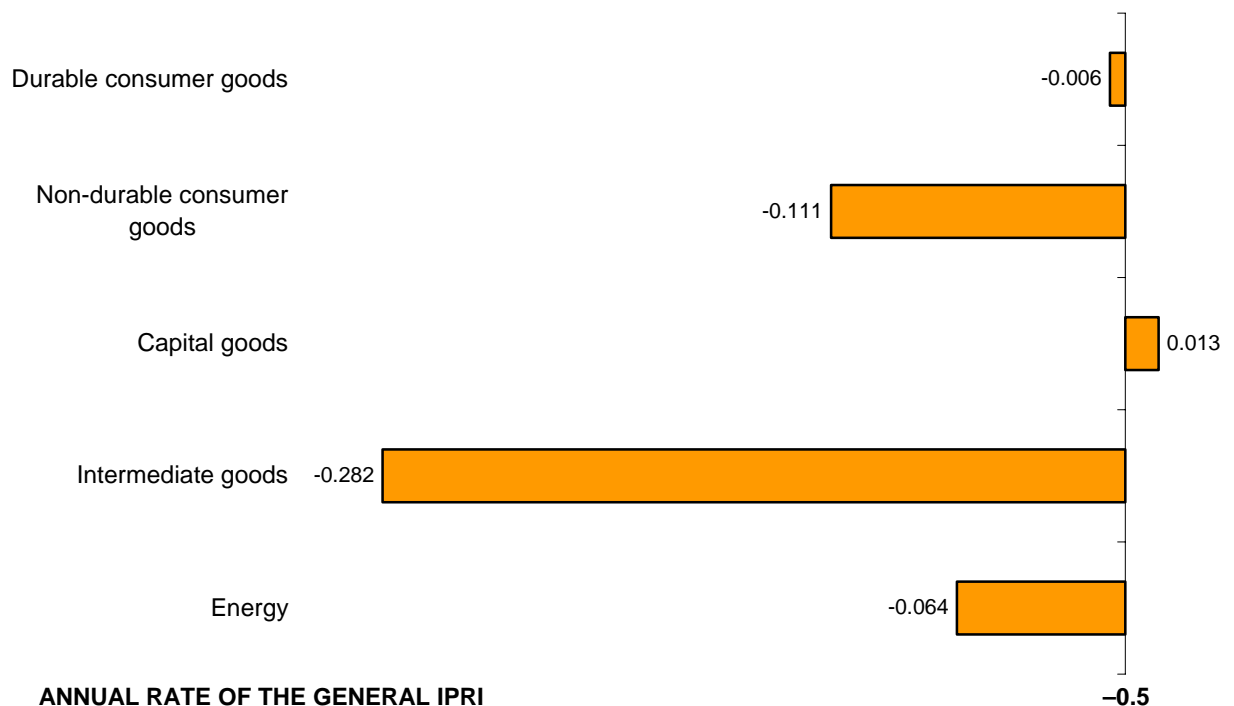
- **Intermediate goods**, whose rate stood at 0.2% , one point below that registered the previous month and the lowest value registered since February 2010. In this drop it is highlighted the influence of *Manufacture of basic chemicals fertilizers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Manufacture of animal feed products*.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation stood at **3.5%**, four tenths below that registered in March. This fall was mainly influenced of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and the *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.

• **Energy**, whose variation decreased five tenths and stood at **-5.4%**, the lowest since November 2009. This behaviour was due to the reduction in the prices of *Petroleum refinement*, whose rate stood at the lowest levels since October 2009 (-11.0%).

Within this sector, it is worth highlighting the increase in 1.1 and 3.8 points in the annual rate of *Production, transportation and distribution of electric power* (-5.8%) and *Gas production; piped distribution of gaseous fuels* (10.1%).

In April, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **-1.1%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced the drop in the general index were the following:

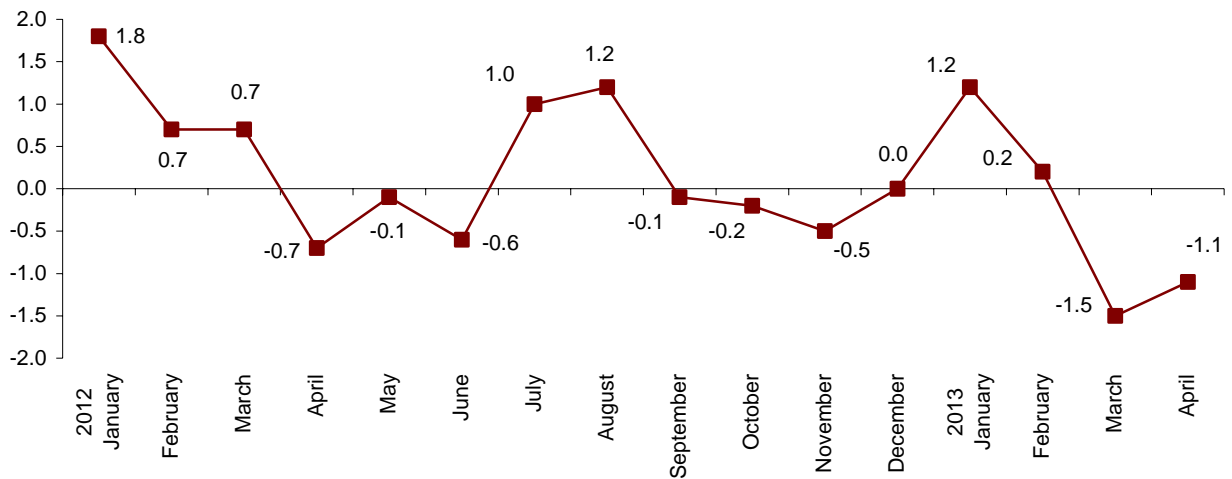
• **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **-3.7%**, that reflected the decrease in prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power* and *Petroleum refinement*. Its effect on the general IPRI was **-0.984**.

• **Intermediate goods** with a variation of **-0.5%** and an effect of **-0.144**. Within the industrial activities that decreased their prices during this month are highlighted the *Manufacture of basic chemicals fertilizers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferroalloy products*.

In turn, the only sector that registered a positive effect on the IPRI was:

- **Capital goods**, whose rate of **0.1%** had an effect of **0.015**, due to the increase in the prices of *Repair of fabricated metal products machinery and equipments* and *Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock*.

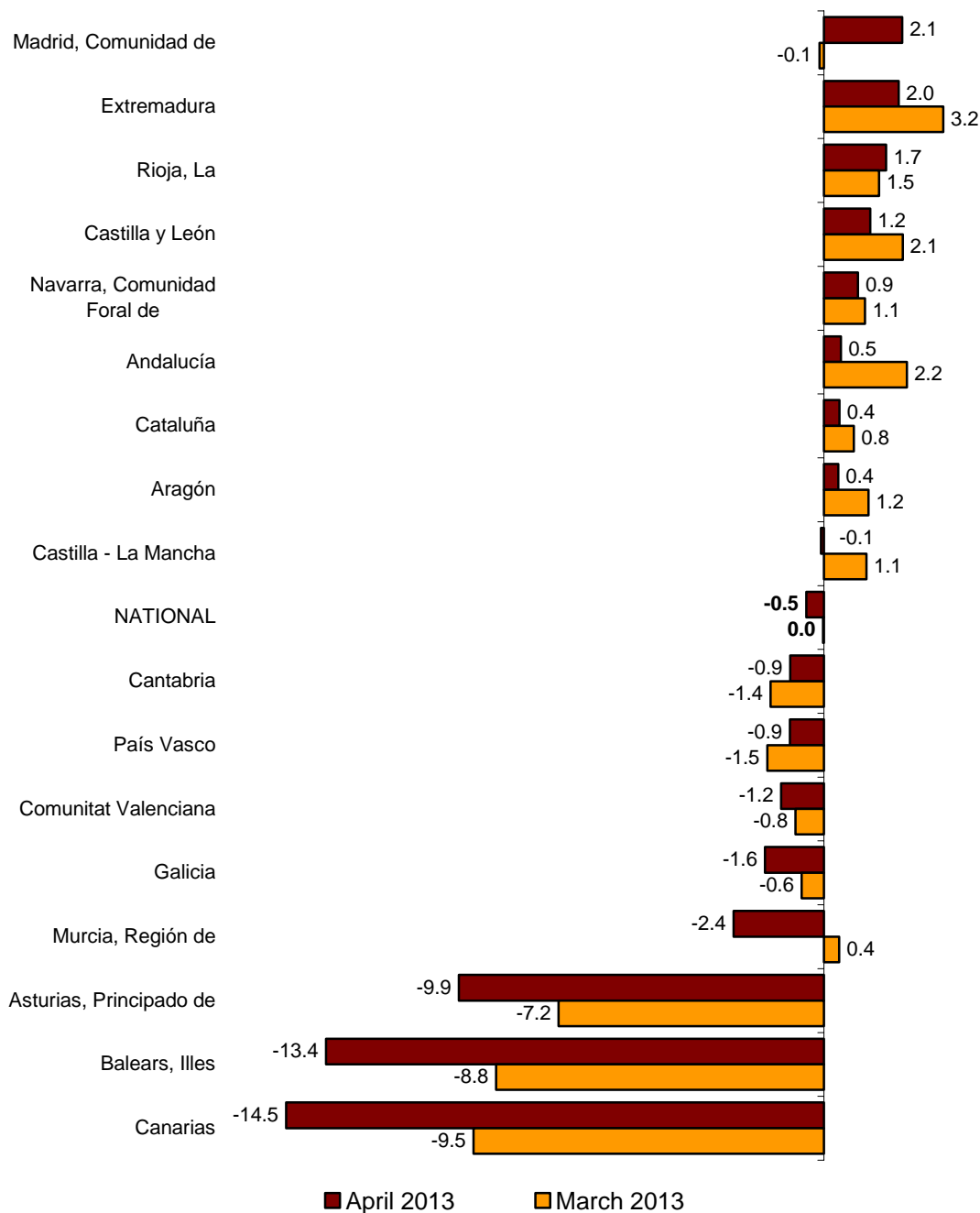

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI decreased in nearly all the Autonomous Communities. Among them, are highlighted Canarias (-14.5%) and Illes Balears (-13.4%), with decreases of 5.0 and 4.6 points, respectively.

The greatest increase was registered in Comunidad de Madrid, whose annual rate increased 2.2 points and stood at 2.1%.
