


Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010 April 2014. Provisional data

The annual variation rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.1%, almost one point and a half over that registered in March

The monthly variation rate of industrial prices is 0.2%

Annual evolution of industrial prices


The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **-0.1%** in April, almost one point and a half over that registered in March.



By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that influenced the most the increase in the annual variation of the general IPRI were:

• *Energy*, whose rate stood at **3.4%**, more than four points over that of the previous month. This behaviour was due to the stability in the prices of the *Production*, *transportation and distribution of electrical energy*, as well as *Manufacture of refined petroleum products* as compared with the decreases registered in April 2013.

• Intermediate goods, which increased seven tenths its annual variation, up to -2.2%. It is worth noting in this behaviour the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals and Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms, which registered a decrease in the same month of the previous year.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In April, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was 0.2%.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that recorded a monthly positive effect on the general index were:


• *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **0.2%** and an effect of **0.059**. This behaviour was mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products* and *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains.*

Despite the increase in the monthly variation of this sector, worth noting the decrease in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy.*

• Intermediate goods, with a variation of **0.2%**. Worth noting in this variation the increase in the prices of Forging, pressing, stamping and roll-forming of metal; powder metallurgy, Manufacture of plastics products and Manufacture of prepared animal feeds. Its effect in the general IPRI was 0.052.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a rate of **0.2%** and an effect of **0.047**, mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products.*



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in all the Autonomous Communities, except for La Rioja, where it decreased two tenths, reaching 0.5%.

In the rest of the Autonomous Communities, worth noting the increase in the rates of Illes Balears (12.7%) and Canarias (9.6%), with increases of more than seven points, as well as Principado de Asturias (5.2%) which increased its rate in five points.
