#### Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005 May 2011. Provisional data

#### Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of May is **6.7%**, six tenths below the rate registered in April.
- The monthly variation of the overall index is -0.3%.
- All **Autonomous Communities** register **positive interannual** rates in May.
- The Communities that record the greatest interannual variation are **Andalucía** and **Canarias**, with **9.9%**.


#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 6.7% in May, representing a drop of six tenths, as compared with that registered in April.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced this decrease were:

- *Energy*, whose interannual rate stood at **15.3%**, almost two points below the rate registered in April, due to the decrease in prices of *Petroleum refinement*, as compared with the increase registered the same month last year.
- Intermediate goods, whose annual variation decreased six tenths, standing at 6.5%. This decrease was due to the fact that Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferroalloys and the Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals decreased in price, as compared with the increase registered in May 2010.

#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In May, the monthly variation of the IPRI was -0.3%.


By economic destination of the goods, the sector that most influenced this decrease was:

• **Energy**, whose monthly rate of **-1.4%** contributed **-0.355** to the general index. This rate was largely due to the decrease in prices of *Petroleum refinement*, the group that has experienced the greatest monthly drop since September 2009.

The remaining industrial sectors had a positive influence on the general index. Worth noting among these was:

• Intermediate goods, with a monthly rate of 0.2% and a contribution of 0.054. Of note in this variation were the increases in price of the *Manufacture of plastic products*, the *Manufacture of prepared animal feed, Manufacture of paper and paper products* and of the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms.*



#### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

Most Autonomous Communities experienced a decrease in their annual rate in May. The greatest decreases corresponded to the Autonomous Communities of Cantabria (2.1 points), Región de Murcia (1.8 points) and Canarias (1.4 points), whose rates stood at 7.6%, 7.3% and 9.9%, respectively.

In turn, the Communities with the greatest increases in their annual rate were Illes Balears (which went from 8.5% in April to 8.9% in May) and Comunidad de Madrid (from 4.6% to 4.8%).
