
The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.8%, almost one-and-a-half points higher than that registered in April

The monthly variation rate of the Industrial Price Index is 1.3%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **0.8%** in May, almost one-and-a-half points higher than that registered in April.

By economic destination of the goods, the only sector that influenced the increase in the general rate of the IPRI was:


- **Energy**, whose rate stood at **0.3%**, almost six points higher than that registered in April. In this increase it is highlighted the influence of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power*, higher this month than in the previous month. Prices of *Petroleum refinement* remained stable this month, as compared to the decrease registered in May 2012.

In spite of the increase of the general IPRI, it is worth noting the decrease registered in the following industrial sectors:

- **Intermediate goods**, whose annual variation stood at **-0.5%**, five tenths below that registered in April and the lowest since January 2010. This evolution was mainly due to the drop in the prices of *Manufacture of feed products for animals*, *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*, and *Manufacture of wiring and wiring devices*.

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation decreased two tenths and stood at **3.2%**. This behaviour was mainly due to the decrease in the prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.

In May, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **1.3%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector with a positive effect was:


- **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **5.5%**, that reflected the increase in prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power*. Its effect on the general IPRI was **1,424**.

In turn, the sectors that registered a negative effect on the IPRI were:

- **Intermediate goods** with a variation of **-0.3%** and an effect of **-0.103**. Within the industrial activities that decreased their prices during this month are highlighted the *Manufacture of basic precious and other non ferrous metals*, *Manufacture of basic chemicals fertilizers and*

nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and the Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferroalloy products.

• **Capital goods**, whose rate of **-0.3%** had an effect of **-0.050**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock* and *Manufacture of metal products for construction*.



A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of May.


Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in all Autonomous Communities except Comunidad de Madrid (1.1%) and Extremadura (1.3%) with decreases of 1.0 and 0.3 points, respectively.

The greatest increases were registered in Illes Balears (0.7%) and Canarias (-3.7%), whose annual rates increased 14.1 and 10.8 points, respectively.
