May 2014. *Provisional data*

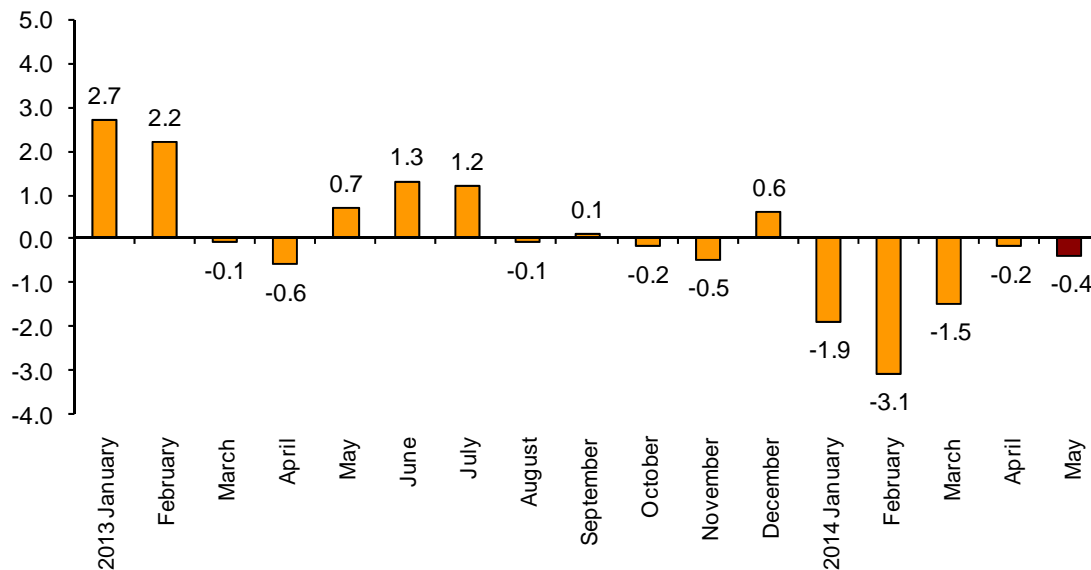
**The annual variation rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at  $-0.4\%$ , two tenths lower than that registered in April**

**The monthly variation rate of industrial prices is  $0.9\%$**

**Annual evolution of industrial prices**

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at  $-0.4\%$  in May, two tenths lower than that registered in April.

By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector that influenced the decrease in the annual variation of the general IPRI was:

- **Energy**, whose rate decreased by almost two points, reaching **0.8%**, due to the increase in the prices of the *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy*, which was lower than the decreases registered in May 2013.

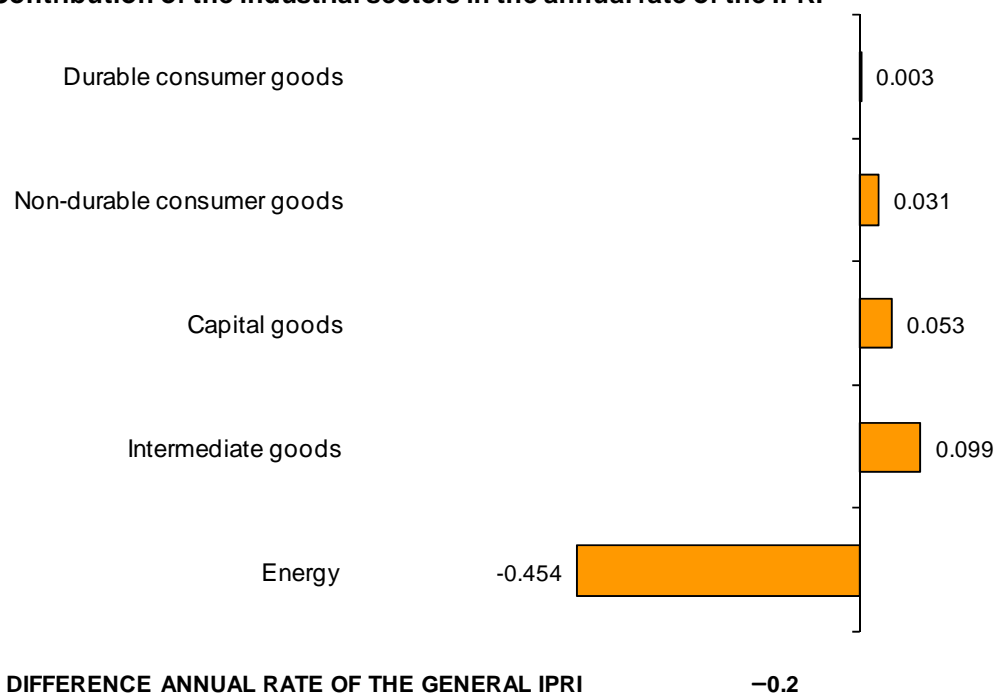
Within this sector, worth noting the increase of over four points in the annual rate registered by *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*, due to the increase in the prices of this sector as compared with the stability registered in 2013.

In turn, among the industrial sectors that registered an increase in their annual rate, worth noting:

• **Intermediate goods**, which increased three tenths its annual variation as compared with the previous month, up to **-1.9%**. It is worth noting in this behaviour the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals* and *Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*, which registered a decrease in the same month of the previous year.

• **Capital goods**, whose variation increased four tenths, reaching **0.2%**, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock* and *Manufacture of metal elements for construction*, which registered a decrease last year.

**Contribution of the industrial sectors in the annual rate of the IPRI**



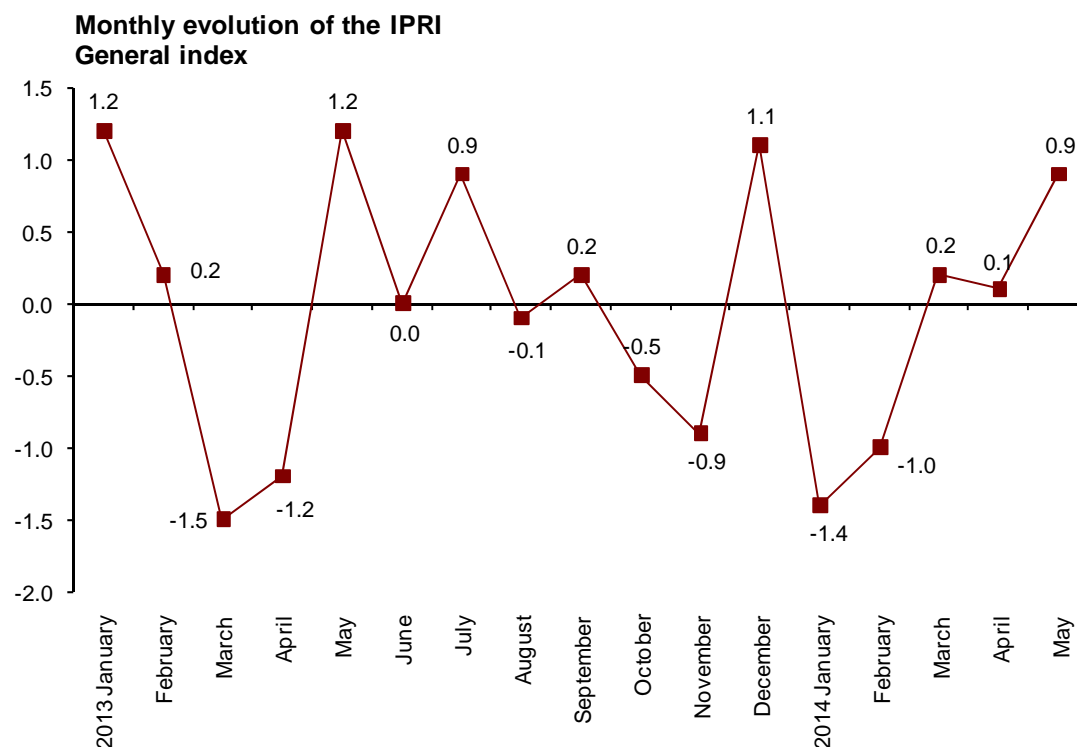
**Monthly evolution of industrial prices**

In May, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **0.9%**.

By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors recorded a monthly positive effect on the general index. Among them, worth noting:

• **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **3.3%** and an effect of **0.851**. This behaviour was mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy* and, to a lesser extent, of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a rate of **0.1%** and an effect of **0.020**, mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.



A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of May.

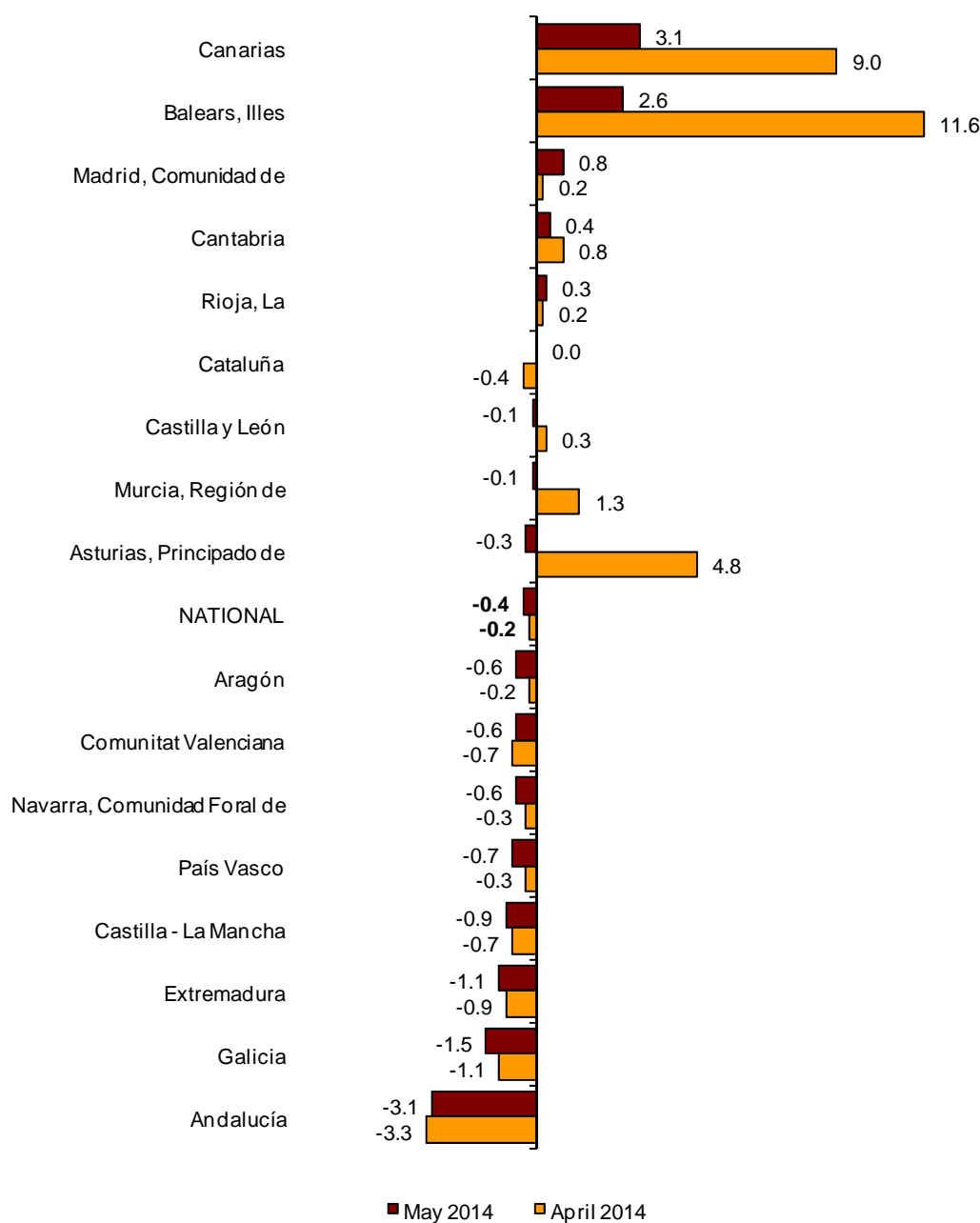

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates**

The annual rate of the IPRI decreased in 12 Autonomous Communities. Among them, worth noting Illes Balears (2.6%), Canarias (3.1%) and Principado de Asturias (-0.3%), which registered decreases of 9.0, 5.9 and 5.1 points, respectively.

In turn, among the Autonomous Communities registering an increase in their annual rate, worth noting the six and four tenths increases in Comunidad de Madrid (0.8%) and Cataluña (0.0%) respectively.
