

Industrial Price Indices. Base 2000
June 2008

The General Industrial Price Index increases 1.1% in June as compared with the previous month

In June, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 1.1% increase with respect to the month of May 2008. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke oven products and refinement of petroleum* (8.6%), *Metallurgy* (2.3%) and *Chemical industry* (0.7%). In contrast, among the activities that recorded a decrease as compared with the previous month, the activity with the greatest repercussion was the *Paper industry* (-0.2%).

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the previous month were 0.2% for consumer goods (0.2% for durable consumer goods and 0.2% for non-durable consumer goods), 0.1% for capital goods, 0.5% for intermediate goods and 4.2% for energy.

The interannual rate of the General Index increases 9.0%

The General Industrial Price Index registered an increase of 9.0% in June 2008 with respect to the same month from the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (49.9%) and *Food and beverage products industry* (10.3%).

By economic destination of the goods, the interannual variation rates as compared with the previous year were 5.4% for consumer goods (3.4% for durable consumer goods and 5.8% for non-durable consumer goods), 2.1% for capital goods, 6.3% for intermediate goods and 25.5% for energy.
