
The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 1.3%, almost seven tenths higher than that registered in May

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **1.3%** in June, seven tenths higher than that registered in May.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced the increase in the general rate of the IPRI were:

- **Energy**, whose rate stood at **2.0%**, more than two higher than that registered in May. This increase is due to the prices of *Petroleum refinement*, that decreased less this month, as compared with June 2012. In addition, prices of *Gas production, piped distribution of*


gaseous products increased this month, as compared with the stability registered the previous year.

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation increased two tenths and stood at **3.4%**. This behaviour was mainly due to the increase of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat* and *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.

In spite of the increase of the general IPRI, it is worth noting the decrease registered in the following industrial sector:

- **Capital goods**, whose annual variation stood at **-0.5%**, five tenths below that registered in May and the lowest since January 1976. This behaviour was mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of motor vehicles*, lower than that registered the same month of 2012, and the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of metal products for construction*.

In June, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **0.0%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with a negative monthly effect were:

- **Intermediate goods** with a variation of **-0.4%**, indicating a decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*, *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferroalloy products* and *Manufacture of basic chemical fertilizers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*. Its effect on the general IPRI was **-0.123**.


• **Capital goods**, whose rate of **-0.3%** had an effect of **-0.039**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock*.

In turn, the sectors that registered a negative effect on the IPRI were:

• **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **0.4%** and an effect of **0.115**, due to the increase in the prices of that reflected the increase in prices of *Gas production, piped distribution of gaseous products*.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation stood at **0.2%** and an effect of **0.046** due to the increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat*.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in the most part of the Autonomous Communities, particularly in Canarias (−1.0%) and Andalucía (4.3%), whose annual rates increased 2.7 and 2.3 points, respectively.

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Illes Balears (−0.1%), Castilla yLeón (1.5%) and Principado de Asturias (−3.9%), whose annual rates decreased 0.8, 0.4, and 0.1 points, respectively.
