


# Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010 June 2014. Provisional data

The annual variation rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.4%, eight tenths higher than that registered in May

# The monthly variation rate of industrial prices is 0.9%

### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **0.4%** in June, eight tenths higher than that registered in May.



By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that influenced the most the increase in the annual variation of the general IPRI were:

- *Energy*, whose rate increased by almost three points, reaching **3.5%**, due to the increase in the prices of the *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy,* as compared with the stability registered in 2013. Within this sector, it was also worth noting the increase in prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, which registered a decrease last year.
- Intermediate goods, with a variation of -1.3%, six tenths over that registered in the previous month. This behaviour showed the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic

precious and other non-ferrous metals and Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in forms, as compared with the decreases registered in June 2013.

In turn, the only industrial sectors that registered a decrease in its annual rate was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods,** whose variation decreased two tenths, standing at **–0.8%**. This was due to the increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*, which was lower than that registered last year.

DIFFERENCE ANNUAL RATE OF THE GENERAL IPRI


In June, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **0.9%**.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors with a monthly positive effect on the general index, worth noting:

- *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **3.2%** and an effect of **0.824.** This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy* and, to a lesser extent, of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains* and *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*.
- Intermediate goods, with a rate of 0.2% and an effect of 0.060, mainly due to the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals and Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in forms.



## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 15 Autonomous Communities. Among them, worth noting Illes Balears (7.8%), Principado de Asturias (4.8%) and Canarias (7.2%), which registered increases of 5.2, 5.1 and 4.1 points, respectively.

In turn, Cantabria (0.0%) and Extremadura (-1.1%) registered decreases of 0.3 and 0.1 points in their annual rates, respectively.
