# Industrial Price Index. Base 2015 July 2018. Provisional data

# The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at 4.6%, half a point above that registered in June

#### The monthly rate of industrial prices is 0.4%

#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in July was **4.6%**, half a point above that registered in June.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the greatest positive influence in this increase were:

• Energy, with a variation rate of 14.1%, two percentage points above that of the previous month, due to the increase in the prices of Electric power generation, transmission and distribution and, to a lesser extent, of Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains, which decreased in July 2017.

It is noteworthy, although in the opposite direction, the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture* of refined petroleum products compared to the stability recorded last year.


• Capital goods, with a variation rate of 0.9%, one tenth of a point higher than in June, due to the increase in the prices of Manufacture of structural metal products, which decreased in 2017.

On the other hand, among the industrial sectors with a negative contribution to the annual rate of the general index, worth noting were:

• Intermediate goods, whose variation rate decreased two tenths of a point, to 3.2%. It is worth noting in this evolution the decrease in the prices of Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals and, to a lesser extent, of Manufacture of prepared animal feeds, which increased in July of the previous year.


It is also important to highlight, although in the opposite direction, the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*, compared to the decrease recorded last year.

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased one tenth, to **1.2%**, standing almost three and a half points below that of the general IPRI.

#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

The monthly variation of the general IPRI was 0.4% in July.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with the greatest positive contribution to the general index was:

• *Energy*, which registered a variation rate of **1.2%** and a contribution of **0.397**, due to the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution* and, to a lesser degree, of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

It is also worth noting, although in the opposite direction, the fall in the prices of *Manufacture* of refined petroleum products.

In turn, amongst the sectors that presented a negative contribution to the general index, the most relevant was:

• *Intermediate goods*, with a monthly variation rate of -0.1%, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*. The contribution of this sector to the general index was -0.031.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities contributing most to the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of July.



#### **Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates**

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 12 Autonomous Communities and decreased in four. The greatest increases were recorded in Illes Balears, Comunidad de Madrid and Canarias, whose variation rates increased 2.1, 2.0 and 1.9 points respectively.

In turn, Región de Murcia and Cantabria were the only Autonomous Communities with the highest declines in the annual rate, with decreases of five and four tenths, respectively
