Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005
August 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of August is **7.1%**, four tenths lower than that registered in July.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **-0.3%**.
- All **Autonomous Communities** register **positive interannual** rates in August.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Andalucía**, with **11.0%**.

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 7.1% in August, four tenths lower than that registered in July.

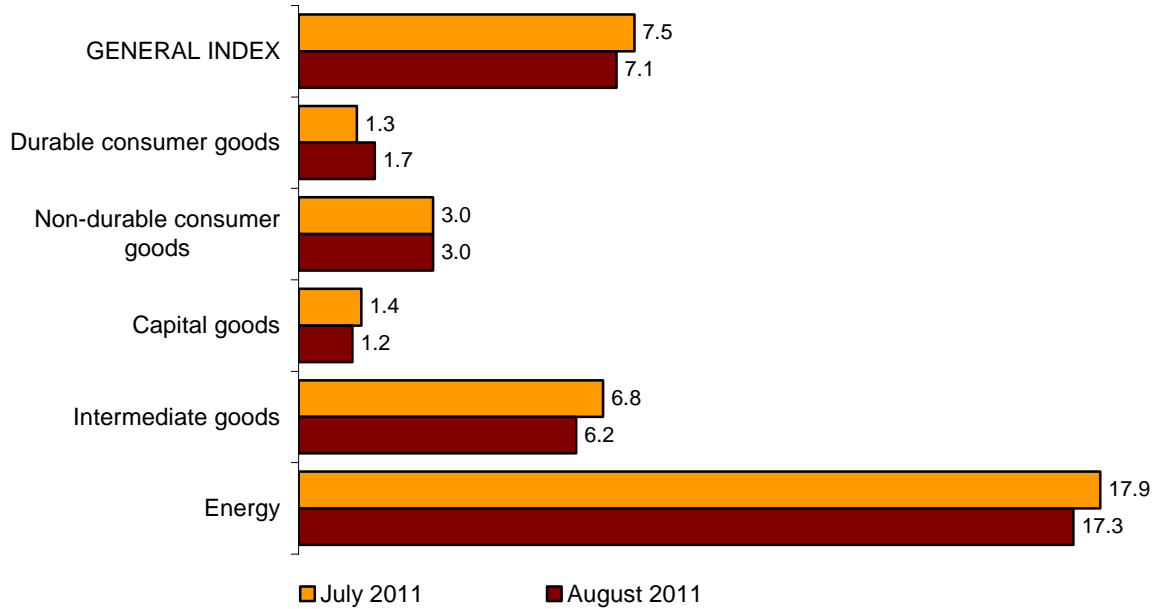
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the most negative effect on the general index were:

- **Intermediate goods**, whose interannual rate stood at **6.2%**, six tenths lower than that registered in July. This drop was mainly due to the decrease in price of the *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals*, *Manufacture of animal feed products* and in the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products*, as compared with the increase registered the same month the previous year.

In fact, the rate of *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals* decreases seven points, standing at 9.6%, the lower registered since November 2009.

- **Energy**, whose annual variation decreased six tenths, up to **17.3%**, due to that the price of the *Petroleum refinement* experienced a greater decrease in prices than in August 2010.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In August, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **-0.3%**.

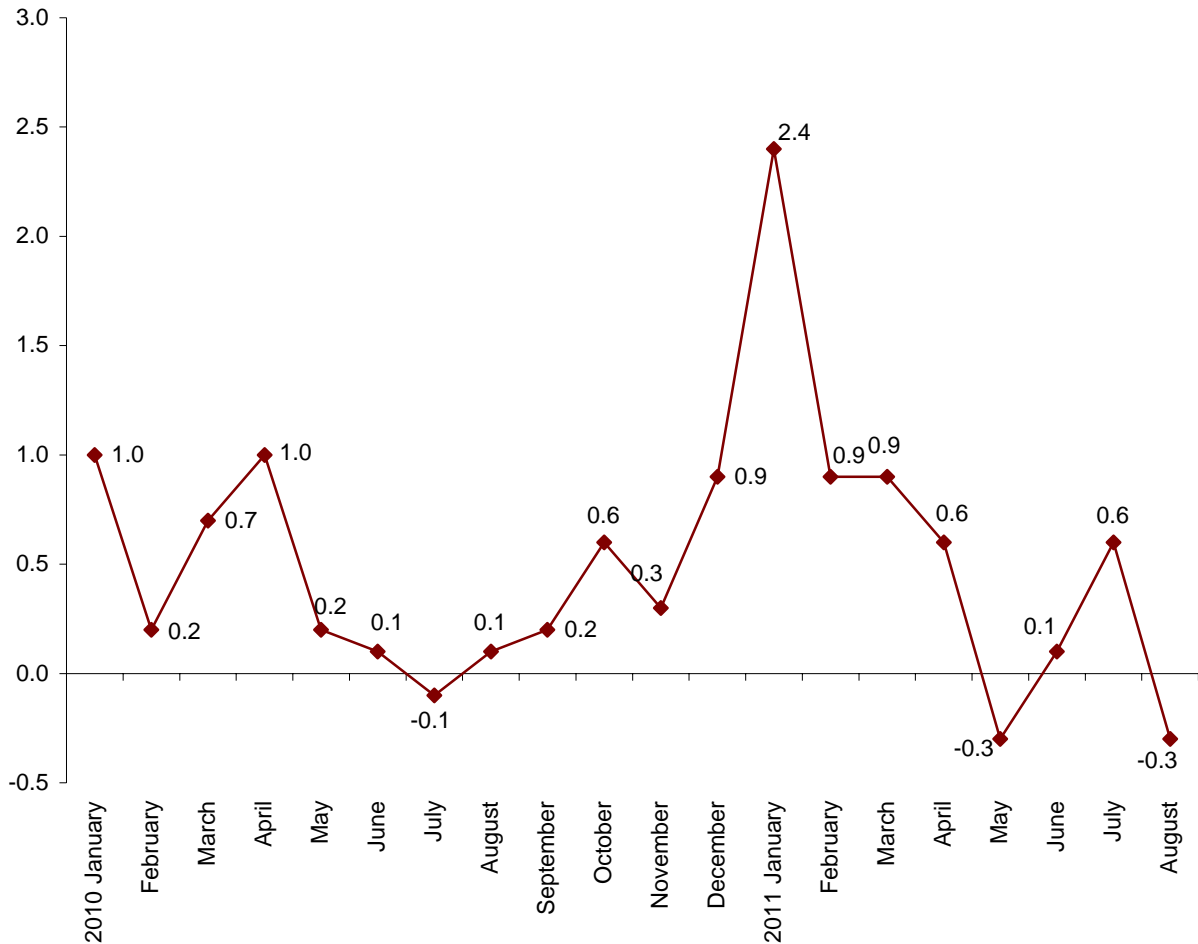
By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector with a negative monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Energy**, whose monthly rate of **-1.4%** contributed **-0.370** to the general index, largely due to the decrease in prices of *Petroleum refinement*.

In turn, worth noting a positive monthly influence of:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, which presented a monthly rate of **0.3%**. This behaviour reflected the increases in prices in the *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*. Its effect on the general index was **0.060**.

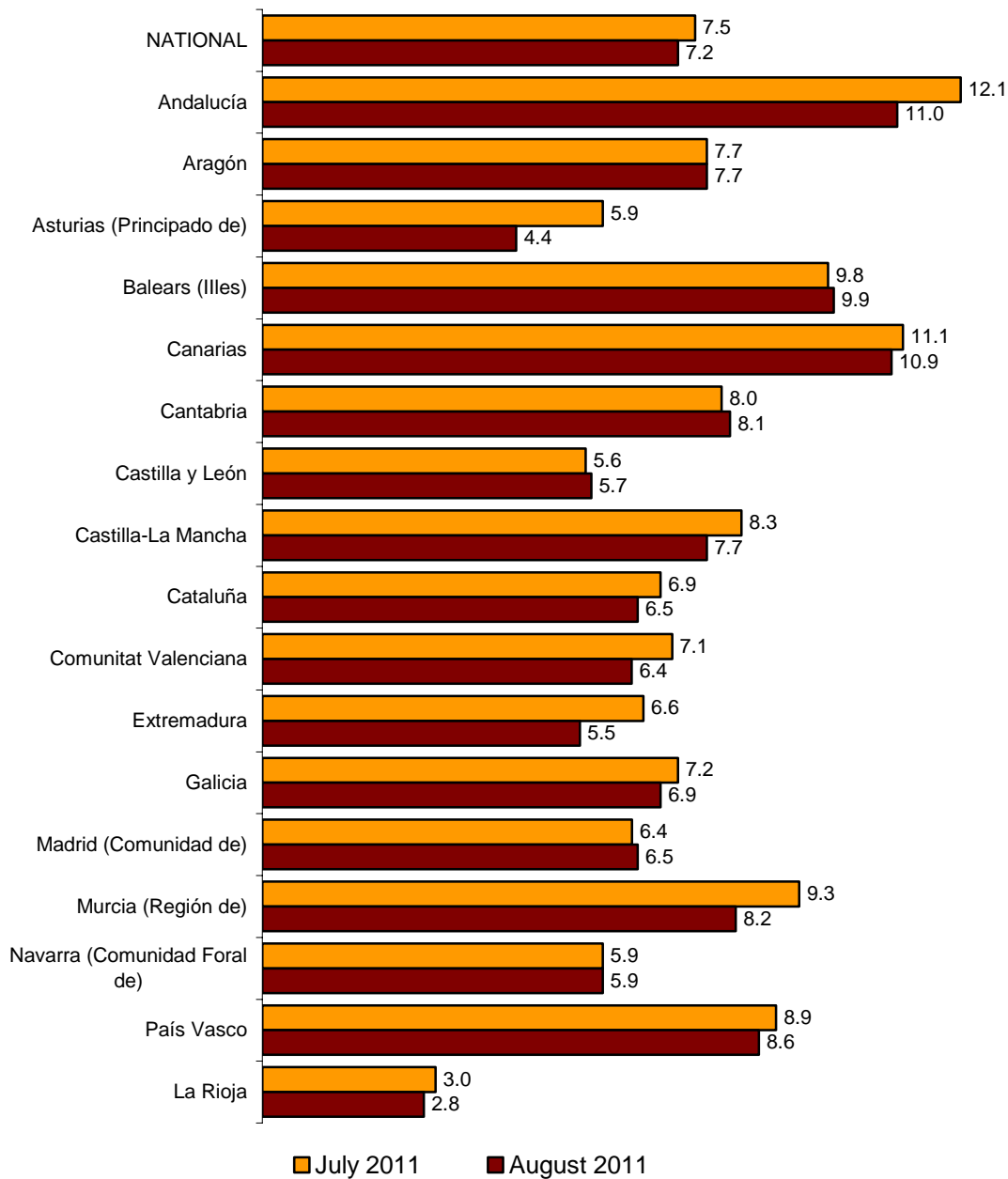

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

Most Autonomous Communities experienced a decrease in their annual rate in August. The greatest decreases corresponded to the Autonomous Communities of Principado de Asturias (with a drop of 1.5 points), and Andalucía, Extremadura y Región de Murcia (with a reduction of 1.1 points each one).
