**Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005**  
September 2011. *Provisional data*

**Main results**

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of September is **7.1%**, the same as the rate registered in August.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.2%**.
- All **Autonomous Communities** register **positive interannual** rates in September.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Canarias**, with **11.2%**.

**Annual evolution of industrial prices**

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 7.1% in September, the same as the rate registered in August.

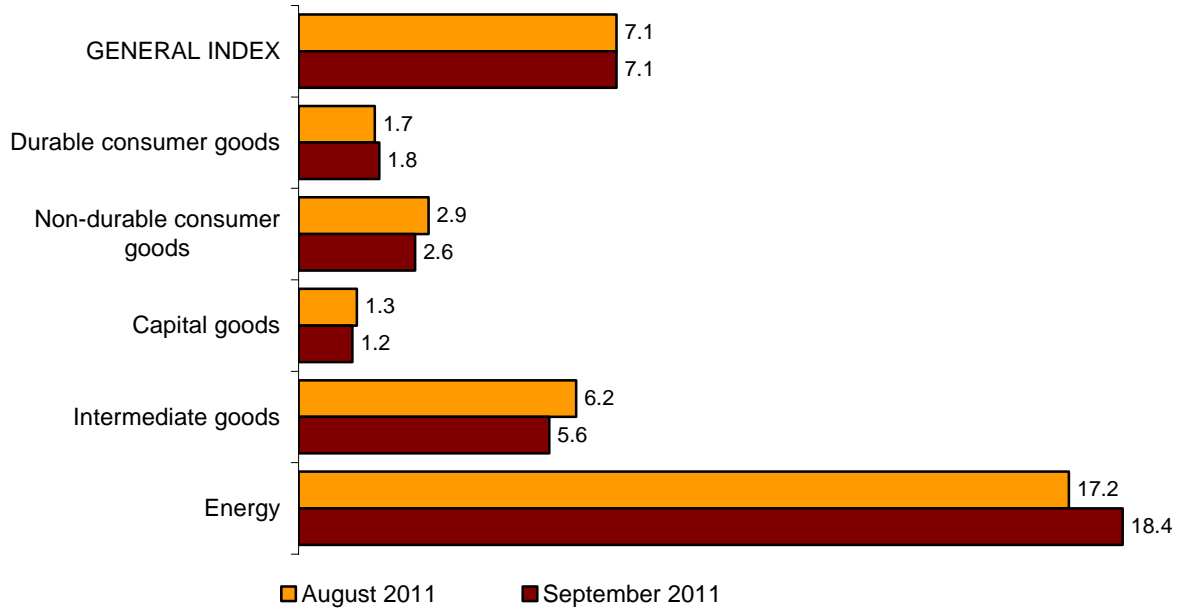
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the most negative effect on the general index were:

- **Intermediate goods**, whose interannual rate stood at **5.6%**, six tenths lower than that registered in August. This drop was mainly due to the decrease in price of the *Manufacture of animal feed products* and in the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products*, as compared with the increase registered the same month the previous year.
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose interannual rate stood at **2.6%**, three tenths lower than that registered in August. This behaviour reflected the drop in prices in the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and in the *Graphic arts and related services*, as compared with the increase experienced in September 2010.

Among the activities with a positive annual influence on the general index, worth noting:

- **Energy**, whose annual variation increased more than one tenth, up to **18.4%**, this was largely due to that the price of the *Petroleum refinement* experienced a greater increase in prices than in September last year.

## Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **0.2%**.

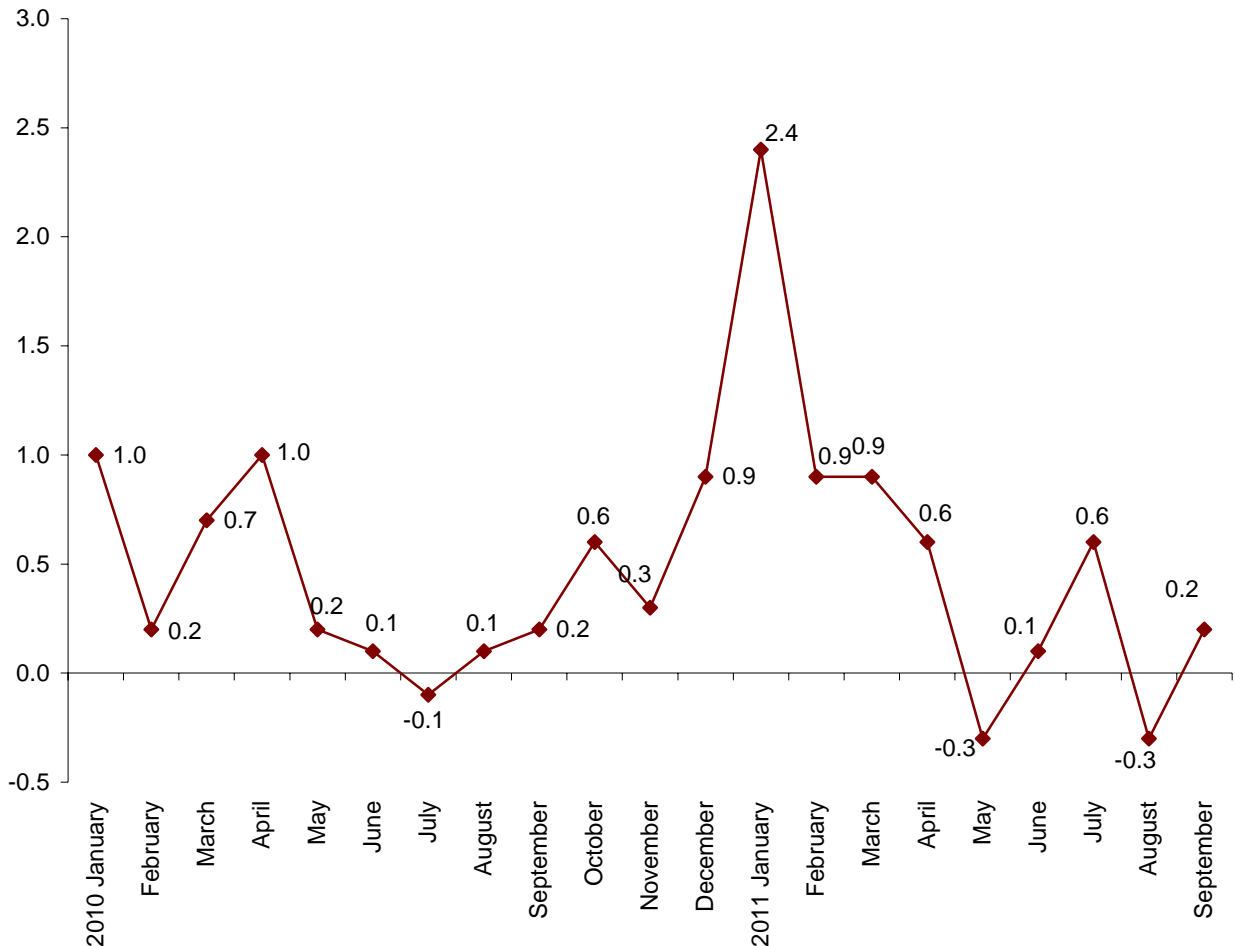
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with a positive monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Energy**, whose monthly rate of **0.8%** contributed **0.202** to the general index, largely due to the increase in prices of *Petroleum refinement*, partly compensated by the decreases in prices in the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy*.

In turn, the only industrial sector with a negative monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Intermediate goods**, which contributed **-0.027** to the general index and presented a monthly rate of **-0.1%**. This behaviour reflected the decreases in prices in the *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of September.

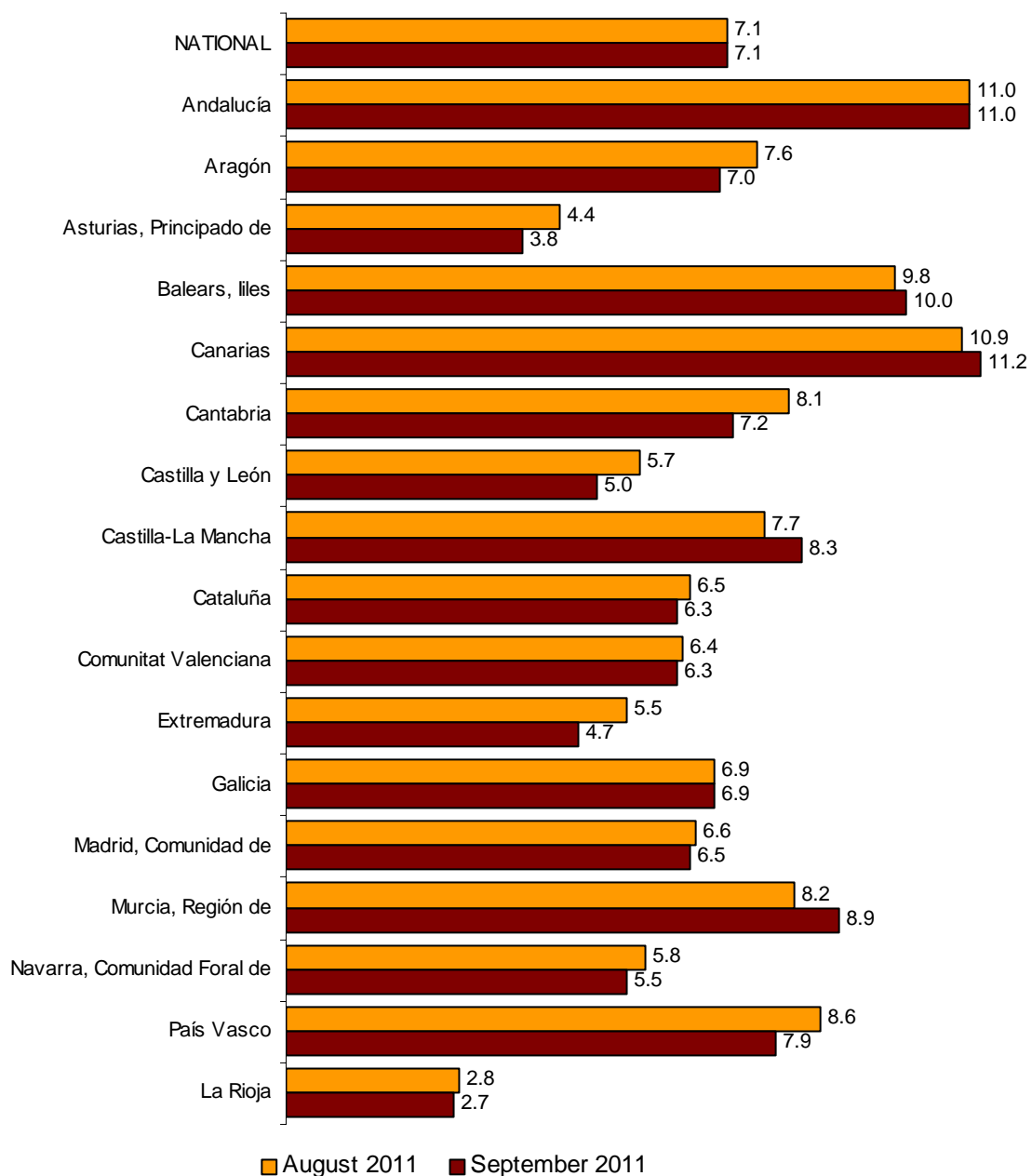

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates**

Most Autonomous Communities experienced a decrease in their annual rate in September. The greatest decreases corresponded to Cantabria (0.9 points), Extremadura (0.8 points) and País Vasco and Castilla y León (0.7 points) whose rates stood at 7.2%, 4.7%, 7.9% and 5.0%, respectively.

In turn, Región de Murcia (0.7 points) and Castilla-La Mancha (0.6 points), registered the greatest increases in their annual rate, standing at 8.9% and 8.3%, respectively.
