Industrial Price Index. Base 2010 September 2017. *Provisional data*

The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at 3.4%, one tenth above that registered in August

The monthly rate of industrial prices is 0.5%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in the month of September was **3.4%**, one tenth higher than that registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that had a positive effect on this increase, worth noting were:

• *Intermediate goods*, with a variation rate of **3.5%**, six tenths above that registered in August. Worth noting in this behaviour was the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic iron and steel and of ferro-alloys*, which was higher than in 2016.


It is also influenced by the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers* and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and, to a lesser extent, of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*, as compared with the decreases registered in the previous year.

On the other hand, the only industrial sector with a negative influence was:

• *Energy*, that registered an annual variation of **6.0%**, one tenth below that of the previous month, due to the fact that the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution* increased this month less than in 2016.


It should also be noted, although in the opposite direction, the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, which was higher than that registered the previous year.

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* increased three tenths, up to **2.4%**, standing one point below that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation rate of the general IPRI was **0.5%**.


By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that presented a greater positive effect, worth noting were:

- *Energy*, with a monthly variation rate of **1,6%** that contributed **0.371**, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products* and to a lesser extent, of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*.
- Intermediate goods, with a variation rate of 0.4%. Worth noting in this behaviour was the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic iron and steel and ferro-alloys and of Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms. Its contribution to the general IPRI was 0.129.

On the other hand, the only industrial sector with a negative influence was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, which registered a variation of **0.0%** and a contribution of **0.012**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products* and of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.

It is also noteworthy, although in a positive direction, the increase in the prices of *Graphic arts* and related services.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of September.



Results by Autonomous Communities. IPRI annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in eight Autonomous Communities, decreased in seven and remained the same in the other two. The greatest increases were recorded in Extremadura, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana, whose annual rates increased 1.7, 0.8 and 0.7 points, respectively.

On the other hand, Principado de Asturias and Illes Balears were the Autonomous Communities where the annual rate decreased the most, with decreases of -1.7 and -1.0 points, respectively.
