Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005
October 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of October is **6.5%**, six tenths below than the rate registered in September.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.0%**.
- All **Autonomous Communities** register **positive interannual** rates in October.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Canarias**, with **10.7%**.

Annual evolution of industrial prices

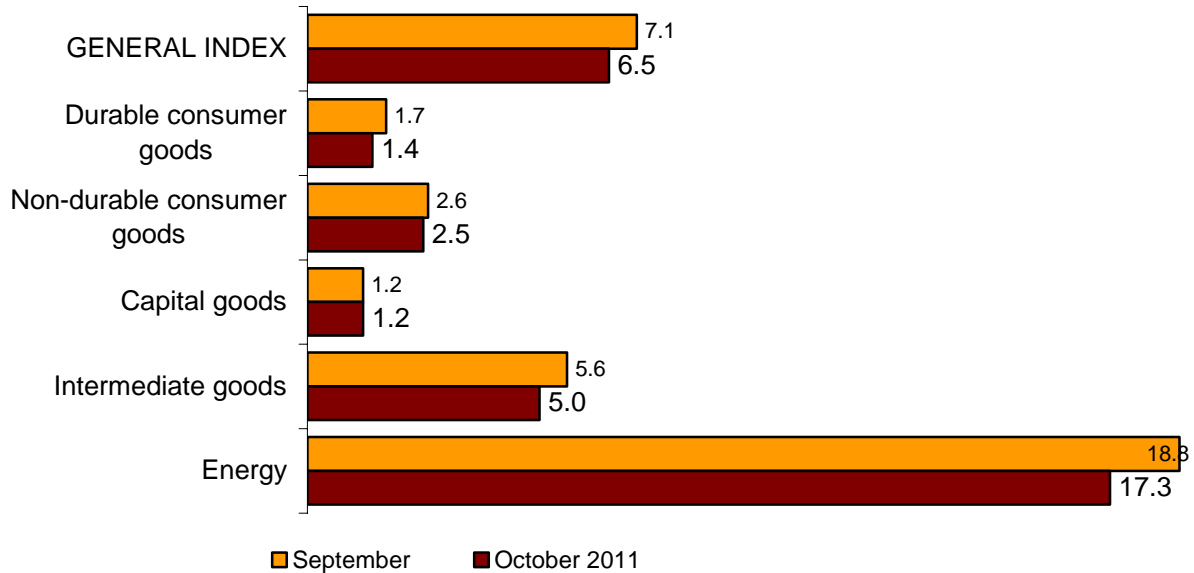
The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 6.5% in October, six tenths below than the rate registered in September.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the most negative effect on the general index were:

- **Energy**, whose annual variation decreased one and half tenth, up to **17.3%**, this was largely due to that the price of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy* experienced a greater increase in prices than in October last year.
- **Intermediate goods**, with an interannual rate of **5.0%**, six tenths lower than that registered in September and the lower registered since October 2010. This drop was due to the decrease in price of the *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals* and *Manufacture of animal feed products*, as compared with the increase registered October the previous year.

In fact, the rate of *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals* decreases seven points, standing at 5.0%, the lower registered since November 2009.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In October, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **0.0%**.

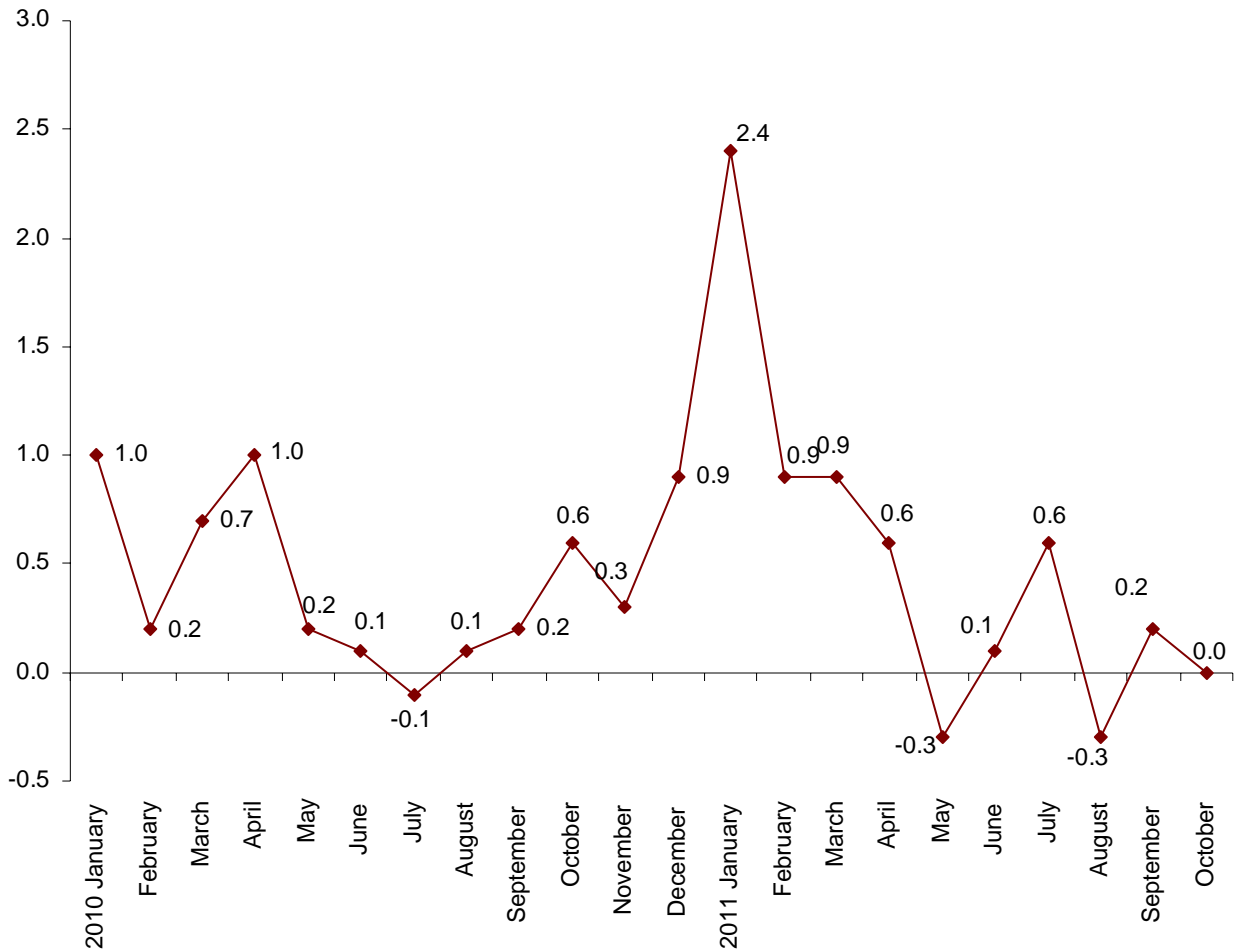
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with a positive monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Energy**, with a monthly rate of **0.5%**, that reflected the increases in the prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy* and the *Production of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through pipes*. Its effect on the general index was **0.135**.

In turn, the industrial sector with the greatest negative monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Intermediate goods**, whose monthly rate of **-0.4%** contributed **-0.133** to the general index, this behaviour reflected the increases in prices in the *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals* and *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.

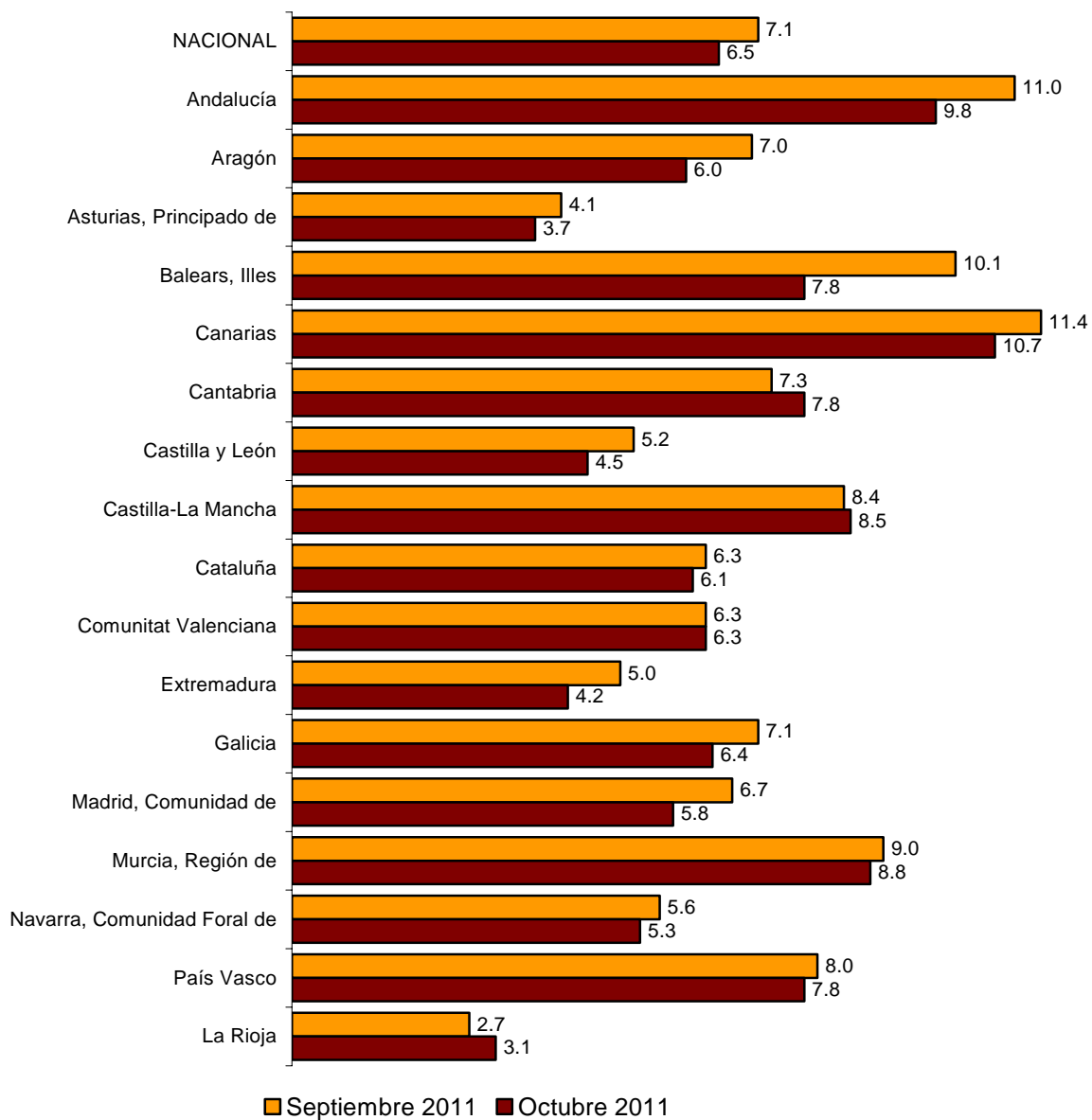

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

In the most Autonomous Communities the annual rate decreased in October. The greatest decreases corresponded to Illes Balears (2.3 points), Andalucía (1.2 points) and Aragón (1.0 point), whose rates stood at 7.8%, 9.8% and 6.0%, respectively.

In turn, Cantabria (0.5 points) and La Rioja (0.4 points), registered the greatest increases in their annual rate, standing at 7.8% and 3.1%, respectively.
