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
#### Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010 October 2014. Provisional data

# The annual variation rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at –0.2%, one tenth higher than that registered in September

# The monthly variation rate of industrial prices is -0.5%

### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **-0.2%** in October, one tenth higher than that registered in September.



By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that influenced the most the increase in the annual variation of the general IPRI were:

• Intermediate goods, with a variation of -0.5%, two tenths above that registered in the previous month. Worth noting in this behaviour was the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and of Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals, which registered its greatest increase since September 2011.

Annual evolution of the IPRI General index

• **Non-durable consumer goods,** whose variation increased three tenths, standing at – **0.3%**. This was due to the fact that the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* was lower than that registered in the same month of 2013.

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
In turn, the only industrial sector that registered a decrease in the annual rate was:

• **Energy**, whose annual rate reached –**0.5%**, due to the fact that the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution* this month was lower than that registered in October 2013. The decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*.

#### Contribution of the industrial sectors in the annual rate of the IPRI

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#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In October, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was -0.5%.


By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors with a monthly negative effect on the general index, worth noting:

• *Energy*, whose monthly variation of -1.6% was due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*. Its effect to the general index was -0.425.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose rate of **-0.2%** and effect of **-0.046** was due to the decrease in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.

• *Intermediate goods*, whose rate of -0.1% had a contribution of -0.017, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of prepared animal feeds*.

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A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of October.


#### **Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates**

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In September, the annual rate of the IPRI decreased in 10 Autonomous Communities. Among them, worth noting were Illes Balears (3.4%), Canarias (1.3%) and Principado de Asturias (2.2%), which registered decreases of 3.3, 2.6 and 1.2 points, respectively.

In turn, among the Autonomous Communities that registered an increase, worth noting were La Rioja (0.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid (2.4%), both with increases of one point and three tenths.
