Industrial Price Index. Base 2010 November 2017. *Provisional data* 

# The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stood at 3.1%, three tenths higher than that registered in October

### The monthly rate of industrial prices is 0.5%

### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in the month of November was **3.1%**, three tenths higher than that registered in October.

By economic destination of goods, among the industrial sectors that presented a positive effect in this increase worth noting were:


• *Energy*, whose annual variation stood at **6.3%**, almost two and a half points above that of the previous month, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, as compared with the decrease registered in November 2016.

On the other hand, the industrial sectors with a negative influence were:

• *Intermediate goods*, whose variation rate decreased seven tenths, stood at 3.3%, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*, which increased the previous year.


• **Non-durable consumption goods**, with a variation of **1.5%**, three tenths below that registered in October. This behaviour was due to the fact that prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* have fallen this month, while they increased in 2016.





Contribution of the industrial sectors in the annual rate of the IPRI

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased three tenths, to **2.0%** standing more than one percentage point below that of the general IPRI.



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#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices


In November, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was 0.5%.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive contribution, worth noting were:

• *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **2.1%** and a contribution of **0.507**, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products* and *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*.

On the other hand, the only industrial sector with a negative monthly contribution was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation rate of -0.1% and a contribution of -0.041, mainly due to the drop in the prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of November.



### **Results by Autonomous Community. IPRI annual variation rates**

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 11 Autonomous Communities and decreased in six. The greatest increases were observed in Canarias, País Vasco and Comunitat Valenciana, whose rates increased 3.8, 1.8 and 1.0 points respectively.

In turn, the Autonomous Communities with the greatest annual decreases were Principado de Asturias, Illes Balears and Cantabria with decreases of 1.3, 0.6 and 0.6, respectively.
