
Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010 December 2013. Provisional data

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.6%, more than one point over that registered in November

The monthly variation rate of the Industrial Price Index is 1.1%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **0.6%** in December, more than one point over that registered in November.



By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that influenced the most the increase in the general rate of the IPRI were:

• *Energy*, whose rate stood at **4.9%**, more than four points and a half over that of the previous month. This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of the *Production*, transportation and distribution of electrical energy, higher than that of 2012. At a lesser extent this behaviour is also a consequence of the increase in the prices of *Refined* petroleum products this month, as compared with the decrease of December 2012.

In turn, among the industrial sectors whose annual rate registers a decrease, it is worth noting:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation stood at **0.0%**, five tenths below that of November and the lowest rate since March 2010. This behaviour was due to the decrease in prices of the Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats, that registered the lowest annual rate since August 2009.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In December, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was 1.1%.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that recorded the greatest monthly positive effect on the general index were:

• *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **4.4%** and an effect of **1.193.** This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of the *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power* and *Refined petroleum products*.


Despite the increase in the monthly rate of this sector, worth noting the drop in the prices of *Manufacture of gas, distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

In turn, among the industrial sectors with a negative monthly effect on the IPRI, worth noting:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation of -0.3% and an effect of -0.082%, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of the Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats.

• *Intermediate goods*, with a variation of **-0.1%**, and an effect of **-0.002**. This behaviour is due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic iron and steel and of ferro-alloys*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of December.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in most Autonomous Communities, highlighting Illes Balears (15.8%) and Canarias (9.5%), with increases of 14.9 and 12.3 points, respectively.

In turn, the only Autonomous Communities that decreased their annual rate were La Rioja (1.7%) and Comunidad de Madrid (1.1%), with decreases of 1.0 and 0.5 points, respectively.
