Mercantile Companies Statistics (MC)

September 2013. Provisional data

6,293 mercantile companies are created in September, 5.2% more than in the same month of the previous year, and 1,372 are dissolved, 11.8% more

The Autonomous Communities with the greatest business dynamism¹ are La Rioja (44.4%), Región de Murcia (28.9%) and País Vasco (18.7%)

6,293 mercantile companies were created in September, 5.2% more than in the same month of 2012. The capital subscribed for their constitution exceeded 590 million euros, representing an increase of 115.1%. The average capital subscribed (93,795 euros) increased 104.5% in its annual rate.

On the other hand, 2,219 mercantile companies increased their capital in September, 0.5% less than in the same month of 2012. The capital subscribed in the increases registered a 81.1% decrease and exceeded 2,223 million euros. The average capital subscribed in these transactions (1,002,190 euros) decreased 81.0% in the annual rate.

The number of mercantile companies dissolved in September was 1,372, 11.8% more, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Of these, 65.4% did so voluntarily, 10.6% due to mergers and the remaining 24.0% for other reasons.




In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation of the number of mercantile companies created and dissolved between August and September in the last five years. This year, the monthly variation of the number of companies created was 10.8% and that of the companies dissolved was 5.7%.




Results by main economic activity

24.2% of the mercantile companies created in September corresponded to *Trade* and 20.5% to *Construction*. Regarding the companies dissolved, *Construction* concentrated 21.8% and *Trade*, 19.4%.


% mercantile companies created by main economic






The economic activity with greatest net balance of all the mercantile companies created was *Trade*, with 1,259 companies. *Agriculture and fishing* registered the lowest net balance, with 114 companies created.





The economic activity with the greatest capital subscribed of mercantile companies created was *Real state, financial and insurance activities*, with 473.46 million euros. *Information and communications* registered the lowest capital, with 1.96 million euros.

Results by Autonomous Cities and Communities

In September, the Autonomous Communities with the greatest number of mercantile companies created were Comunidad de Madrid (1,337) and Andalucía (1,105). Conversely, La Rioja (39) and Cantabria (42) were the Autonomous Communities that created less mercantile companies.

Regarding the dissolved mercantile companies, the Autonomous Communities that registered the highest number of dissolutions were Comunidad de Madrid (310) and Andalucía (232). In turn, those registering the lowest number of dissolutions were La Rioja (11) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (12).


Mercantile companies created and dissolved by Autonomous Cities and Communities

In terms of annual variation of mercantile companies created, La Rioja (44.4%), Región de Murcia (28.9%) and País Vasco (18.7%) registered the greatest increases. Conversely, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-17.1%), Extremadura (-14.9%) and Canarias (-14.7%) registered the lowest annual rates.

Regarding the mercantile companies dissolved in September, Región de Murcia registered the greatest annual rate (166.7%), followed by Castilla-La Mancha (67.9%). Conversely, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (–40.0%) and Canarias (–29.0%) showed the lowest annual rates.
