Unpaid Bills of Exchange Statistics (UBE) February 2014. Provisional data

The value of unpaid bills of exchange decreases 32.3% in February, as compared with the same month of 2013

2.3% of the total expired bills of exchange are unpaid


In February, the number of expired bills of exchange reached 12,533 million euros, 8.4% below that registered in the same month of 2013.

With regards to returned unpaid bills of exchange, the value reached 292 million euros, representing a 32.3% decrease.

Credit materialised in bills of exchange. February 2013

The percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with expired bills of exchange reached 2.3%, eight tenths below that registered in the same month of the previous year.



Percentage of unpaid bills of exchange against expired bills of exchange

In February, the total value of expired bills of exchange reached 6,661,886, that is, 0.9% less than in the same month of 2013.

The average value of expired bills of exchange reached 1,881 euros, representing a 7.6% decrease in the annual rate. In turn, the average value of unpaid bills of exchange stood at 1,349 euros, that is, 13.9% less.


Number and value of bills of exchange. February 2013

Monthly rate evolution

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this chart shows the variation of the unpaid and expired bills of exchange between February and January of the last five years.

In February 2014, the monthly variation of the expired bills of exchange decreases 11.3%, and the monthly variation of the unpaid bills of exchange decreases 15.1%.



Evolution of the monthly variation (february-january) value of expired and unpaid bills of exchange

Credit expired by type of bill

In February, 64.1% of the value of expired bills of exchange corresponded to unpaid portfolio bills of exchange and 35.9% to debt collection management from clients.

Of the total value of unpaid bills of exchange, 64.6% corresponded to portfolio bills of exchange and 35.4% to bills of exchange in debt collection management.


In February, 2.4% of the total expired bills of exchange of portfolio were unpaid. Likewise, 2.3% of the total expired bills of exchange in debt collection management were unpaid.

Geographical distribution of unpaid bills of exchange

In February, the greatest annual decreases of the value of unpaid bills of exchange were registered in Illes Balears (-50.2%). In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-22.4%) registered the slightest decrease.



Annual variation value of unpaid bills of exchange by Autonomous Community. February 2014

Extremadura (3.2%) was the Autonomous Community that presented the highest percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with the expired bills of exchange. In turn, Castilla-La Mancha (1.8%) registered the lowest percentage.

In February, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid accumulated over half of the total of unpaid bills of exchange (49.3%).
