Unpaid Bills of Exchange Statistics (UBE)

August 2015. Provisional data

The value of unpaid bills of exchange decreases 14.9% in August, as compared with the same month of 2014

1.6% of the total expired bills of exchange are unpaid

In August, the value of the expired bills of exchange reached 12,637 million euros, 6.9% more than in the same month of 2014.


With regards to returned unpaid bills of exchange, the value reached 204 million euros, representing a 14.9% annual decrease.

The percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with expired bills of exchange reached 1.6%, which is four tenths lower than that recorded in the same month of the previous year.

Percentage of unpaid bills of exchange against expired bills of exchange



In August, the total value of expired bills of exchange reached 7,209,538, that is, 7.8% more than in the same month of 2014.

The average value of expired bills of exchange reached 1,753 euros, representing a 0.8% decrease in the annual rate. In turn, the average value of unpaid bills of exchange stood at 1,237 euros, that is, 0.1% below that registered in August 2014.





Monthly rate evolution

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this chart shows the variation in the value of the unpaid and expired bills of exchange between August and July in the last five years.

In August 2015, the monthly variation of the expired bills of exchange decreased 8.86%, and the monthly variation of the unpaid bills of exchange decreased 15.1%.





Credit expired by type of bill

Of the total value of expired bills in August, 64.6% corresponded to portfolio bills of exchange and 35.4% to debt collection management from clients.

Of the total value of unpaid bills of exchange, 64.9% corresponded to portfolio bills of exchange and 35.1% to bills of exchange in debt collection management.

In August, 1.6% of the total expired portfolio bills of exchange and of the total expired bills of exchange in debt collection management were unpaid.



Results by Autonomous Community

The greatest annual decreases of the value of unpaid bills of exchange were registered in Illes Balears (-33.9%), Cataluña (-23.7%) and Aragón (-22.6%) in August. In turn, La Rioja (43,4%) and Cantabria (13,1%) were the only Autonomous Community that registered a positive rate.

Annual variation value of unpaid bills of exchange by Autonomous Community. August 2015



La Rioja (2.9%) was the Autonomous Community that showed the highest percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with the expired bills of exchange. In turn, Illes Balears (1.1%) registered the lowest percentage.

In august, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid accumulated around half of the total of unpaid bills of exchange (48.7%).
