Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights (STPR)
February 2015. *Provisional data*


In February, the number of property transfers registered is 146,065 properties, that is, 5.2% more than in the same month of 2014

The merchenting of registered dwellings increases by 15.5%, as compared to February of the previous year

The number of property transfers recorded in the land registries (from public deeds previously registered) was 146,065 in February, that is, 5.2% more than in the same month of 2014.

Regarding the merchenting of registered properties, the number of transfers was 64,862, with a 9.5% annual increase.

¹ "Other titles" includes land consolidation, horizontal divisions, joint ventures or mixtures of several titles transmission, transmissions without title of acquisition, non recourse debt, foreclosures and court awards.

Merchanting recorded in the land registries

82.1% of the registered merchanting in February corresponded to urban properties and 17.9% to rustic properties. Among the urban properties, 55.8% were merchanting of dwellings.

In February, the number of merchanting of rustic properties increased by 12.0% in the annual rate, and that of urban properties did so by 9.0%. Within the latter, merchanting of dwellings recorded an annual variation of 15.5%.



Evolution of the monthly rate

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation in the number of merchanting of dwellings between the months of January and February of the last five years. In 2015, the monthly rate was -11.1%, indicating a 4.6 point increase as compared to the previous year.

Registered merchanting on dwellings, by protection system and status

89.0% of transfers of dwellings by merchanting in February were free housing, and 11.0% were protected housing.


In annual terms, the number of transfers of free dwellings by merchanting increased by 13.6%, and that of protected dwellings did so by 33.5%.

27.3% of the dwellings transferred by merchanting in February were new, and 72.7% were used.

The number of transactions on new dwellings decreased by 28.6% as compared to February 2014. In turn, the number of used dwellings increased by 50.4%.

Results by Autonomous Community

In February 2015, the total number of property transfers recorded in the land registries per 100,000 inhabitants² reached its highest value in the Autonomous Community of La Rioja (713).

Andalucía (32.1%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (28.1%) and País Vasco (12.4%) registered the greatest annual variations.

In turn, the Autonomous Communities that registered the lowest annual rates were Castilla-La Mancha (-17.7%), Galicia (-13.2%) and Principado de Asturias (-3.5%).


Regarding the merchanting on registered dwellings, the Autonomous Community with the highest number of transfers per 100,000 inhabitants² was Comunitat Valenciana (105).

²This data was calculated from the provisional data of the Population Figures on 1 February 2014. Only the population aged 18 to 84 years old was considered.

The Autonomous Communities showing the greatest annual variation rates in the merchandising of dwellings in February were Aragón (49.2%), Comunidad de Madrid (28.4%) and Cataluña (23.2%).

In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-22.7%), Canarias (-5.5%) and Región de Murcia (-1.2%) registered negative annual rates.
