Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)

Second quarter of 2017

The number of trips made by Spanish residents increases by 17.8% in the second quarter¹ reaching 50.4 million

Total expenditure increased 20.6% standing at 10.262 million euros

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations for travellers.

Spanish residents made 50.4 million trips in the second quarter of 2017, 17.8% more than that registered in the same period of 2016.

91.9% of the trips had the national territory as main destination, with an annual increase of 17.6%. In turn, trips abroad increased by 20.4%, representing 8.1% of the total.

Given that in 2017 Holy Week was celebrated in April, while in 2016 it was held in March, it is convenient to analyse both months together. Therefore, during the **first six months of 2017**, trips made by residents increased by 7.9% as compared with the same period of the previous year. This increase was evident for both trips with Spain as the main destination and trips abroad

If we focus on **trips during the Easter holidays**, in 2017 more than 7.5 million were made, with an increase of 13.8% compared to 2016.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation, and main transport

During the second quarter of 2017, *Leisure, recreation and holiday trips,* which were the main purpose of the 53.2% of the trips, increased 34.4%. *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represent 33.1% of the total, registered annual increase of 6.4%.

Conversely, trips for *Business and other professional reasons* and for *other reasons*², decreased 4.0% and 2.6%, respectively.

The main reason for trips during the second quarter was leisure, whether for domestic (52.7%) or foreign (58.6%) destinations

During the **first six months of 2017** increases were registered for trips for leisure (18.5%), trips for business (3.4%) and those made for other reasons (1.3%). Conversely, visits to relatives or friends decreased by 1.3%.

In 41.9% of domestic trips, residents stayed with family or friends. Almost 19.4 million trips used this type of accommodation, with an annual increase of 15.1%.

However, on trips abroad the preferred option was hotel accommodation (50.6% of the total). This type of accommodation registered an increase of 11.6% as compared with the second quarter of the previous year.

During the first quarter, domestic trips made by residents who stayed with family or friends increased by 5.1%. In turn, trips abroad in hotel accommodation increased by 7.8%.

With regard to the main type of transport used, own vehicles were chosen in 82.9% of domestic trips, 19.8% more than that registered in the same quarter of 2016. In 61.4% of the trips abroad, air transport is used, with an increase of 7.5%.

During the **first six months of 2017** domestic trips by own vehicles increased by 7.7% and trips abroad by air transport increased by 0.4%.

Main destinations

The main destinations by Autonomous Community in trips of residents in Spain in the second quarter were Andalucía (with 17.1% of the total), Cataluña (14.7%) and Comunitat Valenciana (9.6%).

Associating domestic trips of residents with the population of destination, the phenomenon of trips was more intense in Cantabria (with 2,075 trips per every thousand inhabitants³), Castilla y León (with 1,821) and Castilla–La Mancha (1,681).



Autonomous Communities of origin

The trips made by the residents in the Comunidad de Madrid represented 18.9% of the trips of the second quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (16.9%) and Andalucía (14.8%).



Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travel the most are those from Comunidad de Madrid (1,458 trips per one thousand inhabitants⁴), País Vasco (1,332) and Castilla y León (1,294).

In turn, Canarias (668 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Región de Murcia (778) and Comunitat Valenciana (853) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

Expenditure on trips

The total travel expenditure in the second quarter reached 10.262 million euros, which represented an increase of 20.6% as compared with the same period of 2016.

The total expenditure for domestic trips increased by 22.9% and trips abroad by 15.8%.

The average daily expenditure was 54 euros for domestic trips and 126 euros for trips abroad.

During the first quarter of 2017, the total resident travel expenditure increased by 5.6%. Growth for domestic trips was 6.3% and 4.0% for trips abroad.

For domestic trips, expenditure on restaurants and cafés, which represented the highest percentage of total expenditure (26.2%), increased by 30.9% as compared with the second quarter of 2016.

Within trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 28.4% of the total, with an annual increase of 2.1%.


During the **first six months of the year** *expenditure on restaurants and cafés* for domestic trips increased by 9.1% as compared with the same period in 2016. In turn, *expenditure on transport* for trips abroad decreased by 3.6%.


According to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Illes Balears(85 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (82) and Canarias (75).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Castilla-La Mancha (37 euros), Castilla y León (42) and Extremadura (43 euros).



The highest average daily expenditure by origin was made by residents in Illes Balears (96 euros), Cantabria (75) and Galicia (73).

In turn, the lowest were in Comunitat Valenciana and Extremadura (59 euros) and Castilla–La Mancha (60).



Monthly data

In April there were 18.6 million trips, in May 15.6 million and in June 16.1 million. Trips in April had an average duration of 3.4 overnight stays, exceeding the duration of trips in May and June, which were 2.9 and 3.0 nights, respectively.

April was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (46.2% against 51.1% in June). This is due both to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Communities, which represented 45.6% of monthly trips in April, and abroad (8.2%).

Leisure was the main reason for trips during the quarter, representing 56.2% of the total in June Trips. Trips for professional purpose were higher in May, with 10.6% of the total.

April was the month with the greatest importance for non-market accommodation (64.1%), while, in June, market accommodation registered the greatest weight in the quarter (39.9%), with 25.2% for hotel accommodation and 14.7% from the remaining market accommodation.

Same-day visits

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 70.2 million same-day visits⁵ in the second quarter of 2017, with an annual increase of 18.2%. 94.8% of same-day visits were made for personal reasons and 5.2% for professional reasons.

88.6% of the excursions were made in the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 22.0%.

10.3% of same-day visits had another community as destination and 1.1% abroad. In the former, the number of excursions decreased 7.0% while those with destinations abroad increased 21.7%.

⁵ An excursion is considered to be any visit, without an overnight stay, made out of the usual environment of the individual. These exclude those which are part of the routine of the individual, as well as those made from second homes, from a cruise or any accommodation other than the usual.

Methodological note

The Tourism survey for Spanish residents (ETR/FAMILITUR) is a continuous survey with the main objective of providing monthly, quarterly and annual estimations of the trips made by the resident population in Spain and the main characteristics such as destination, duration, reason, accommodation, transport means, costs and sociodemographic characteristics of the travellers, among others. The diffusion of results and their disaggregation degree, depending on the study variable group, will be made with monthly, quarterly or annual reference.

The information is obtained by personal interviews to people aged 15 or older, selected at random in a sample of resident's houses, that collaborate three times in alternative months during six months, leave the sample for six months, and are interviewed three other times during the next semester. The people selected, provide information on the trips made in the two months before that of the interview. With an expected effective monthly sample of about 8,200 people, the information of a reference month is provided by about 16,400 people. Furthermore, the rotating panel scheme provides the efficient estimation of the annual change.
