## **Tourism survey for Spanish residents (ETR/FAMILITUR)**Fourth quarter of 2016 and year 2016

The number of trips made by Spanish residents remains around 38 million in the fourth quarter

Total expenditure increased 10.7% standing at 8,165 million euros

In 2016, trips increased by 3.7% while expenditures increased by 9.1%

Spanish residents made 37.9 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2016, 0.4% more than that registered in the same period of 2015.

The main destination of 90.9% of the trips was the national territory, representing just a small variation (-0.3%), as compared to the fourth quarter of 2015. On the other hand, international trips increased by 7.7%, representing 9.1% of the total.

#### Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

During the fourth quarter of 2016, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which are the main purpose of the 44.9% of the trips, decreased 1.5%. Trips for *Leisure*, *recreation and holidays*, which represented 39.0% of the total, registered an annual increase of 4.6%.

In turn, trips for *Businesses and other professional reasons* and for *Other reasons*<sup>1</sup> decreased 4.9% and 2.1%, respectively.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter of 2016 was visiting relatives or friends (46.8%). Most trips abroad were done for leisure reasons (54.8%).

In 48.3% of domestic trips, residents stayed in home of friends or family members, which represents a decrease of 1.0% as compared to the fourth quarter of 2015.

However, on trips abroad the preferred option was hotel accommodations (55.1% of the total). This type of accommodation registered an annual increase of 13.8%.

With regard to the main type of transport used, own vehicles were chosen in 79.9% of domestic trips, 2.9% less than that registered in the fourth quarter of 2015.

In 71.6% of the trips abroad air transport is used, with an increase of 17.3%.

#### **Main destinations**

The main destinations by Autonomous Community in trips of residents in Spain in the fourth quarter were Andalucía (with 15.9% of the total), Cataluña (11.5%) and Castilla y León (with 10.3%).

Linking domestic trips of residents with the destination, the travel phenomenon is more intense in Castilla y León (with 1,636 trips per one thousand inhabitants<sup>2</sup>), in Aragón (with 1,353 trips per one thousand inhabitants) and Cantabria (with 1,313 trips per one thousand inhabitants).



#### **Autonomous regions of origin**


The trips made by the residents in the Comunidad de Madrid meant 18.6% of the trips of the fourth quarter. It was followed by Andalucía y Cataluña, with 15.1% and 14.5% of the total, respectively.

Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travel the most are those from Comunidad Floral de Navarra (1,286 trips per one thousand inhabitants³), Comunidad de Madrid (1,145) and Aragón (1,076). In turn, Region de Murcia (637 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Andalucía (702) and Canarias (705) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

#### **Expenditure on trips**

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 8,165 million euros, 10.7% more than that registered in the same period of 2015.

The total expenditure on domestic trips increased by 7.7%, while expenditure on trips abroad increased by 16.5%.

The average daily expenditure was 53 euros for domestic trips and 102 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, almost half of the expenditure is shared between *Other expenditure* and *Expenditure on bars or restaurants* (24.7% of the total expenditure each). They were followed by *Expenditure on transport* (24.3%). The first increased 34.0% as compared to the fourth quarter of 2015, while the expenditure on bars or restaurants decreased 2.5% and expenditure on transport is reduced by 0.7%.


Within trips abroad, *Expenditure on transport* represented 31.2% of the total, with an annual increase of 23.2%.


According to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Comunidad de Madrid (77 euros), Illes Balears (69) and Canarias (65 euros).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Extremadura (36 euros), Castilla y León (38) and Castilla-La Mancha (40 euros).



The highest average daily expenditure by origin was made by residents in Illes Balears (92 euros), Región de Murcia (78) and Cataluña (71).

On the contrary, the lowest levels were registered in Extremadura (53 euros), Andalucía and Castilla y León (both with 55).



#### Monthly data

In October there were 13.8 million trips, in November 11.3 million and in December 12.8 million. The average duration of trips varies from 3.2 overnight stays for trips ended in November, to 3.5 overnight stays for trips ended in October.

December is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (45.8% against 49.1% in October). The month with the highest percentage of trips abroad is November (9.7%).

Visits to relatives or friends were the main reason for travelling during the last two months of the year, representing 52.3% of the trips in December. This month accounts for the lowest level of business trips for this quarter.

Non-market accommodations represented 68.3% of the total trips in December, against 63% in October and November.

#### **Excursions**

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 57.5 million excursions<sup>4</sup> in the fourth quarter of 2016, with an annual increase of 6,7%. 95.5% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 4.5% for professional reasons.

86.6% of the excursions were made in the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 7.3%.

12.1% of excursions had another community as destination and 1.2% abroad. In the former the number of excursions increased 2.5% while those with destinations abroad increased 5.2%.

### Results for the whole year 2016

Spanish residents made **182.0** million trips for the whole year 2016, **3.7%** more than in 2015. Overnight stays outside the home corresponding to those trips exceeded 780.3 million, with an increase of 4.1%. In turn, the **related total expenditure increased by 9.1%** reaching 41,388 million euros.

91.4% of trips had Spain as main destination and 8.6% abroad. Domestic trips account for 82.4% of overnight stays and 68.0% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 44 euros.

In turn, trips abroad account for 17.6% of overnight stays and 32.0% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 96 euros.

The main purpose of trips was leisure (47.2% of the total), followed by visits to relatives or friends (38.6%).

Leisure trips accounted for 56.5% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 59 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business (103 euros).

Residents preferred to choose non-market accommodation (63.9% of the trips). Those trips, which accounted for 63.3% of overnighy stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (28 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (125 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, the expenditure on bar or restaurants represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (26.1%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (23.3%) and expenditure on transport (21.6%).

In trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight on the total was expenditure on transport (29.5%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (19.0%) and expenditure on bar or restaurants (18.3%).

According to the average daily expenditure, the highest value was registered in the second quarter, both in domestic trips (55 euros) and abroad (126 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were during the third quarter and they were 36 euros in domestic trips and 84 euros abroad.

Andalucía was the destination of the 17.5% of the trips in 2016, followed by Cataluña (12.3%) and Comunitat Valenciana and Castilla y León (both with 9.4%).

The least visited places were La Rioja (0.8%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.4%) and Illes Balears (1.8%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Canarias (67 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (66) and Illes Balears (64).

In turn, the lowest average values were registered in Castilla–La Mancha (32 euros) and in Castilla y León and Extremadura (33 euros each).

During the whole year, residents of Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the largest percentage of trips (19.0% of the total), followed by the residents in Andalucía (15.8%) and Cataluña (15.7%).

The highest average daily expenditure corresponded to residents in Illes Balears (67 euros per day), Canarias (61) and Cantabria (60).

In contrast, the lowest average daily expenditures were in Paíd Vasco (both 48 euros), followed by Aragón and Región de Murcia (both with 49 euros).

### Methodological note

The Tourism survey for Spanish residents (ETR/FAMILITUR) is a continuous survey with the main objective to provide monthly, quarterly and annual estimations of the trips made by the resident population in Spain and the main characteristics such as destination, duration, reason, accommodation, transport means, costs and sociodemographic characteristics of the travellers, amongst others. The diffusion of results and their disaggregation degree, depending on the study variable group, will be made with monthly, quarterly or annual reference.

The information is obtained by personal interviews to people aged 15 or older, selected at random in a sample of resident houses, that collaborate three times in alternative months along six months, leave the sample for six months, and are interviewed three other times during the next semester. People selected provide information on the trips made in the two months prior to that of the interview. With an expected effective monthly sample of about 8,200 people, the information of a reference month is provided by about 16,400 people. Furthermore, the rotating panel scheme provides the efficient estimation of the annual change.
