Fourth quarter of 2017 and year 2017.

**The number of trips made by residents in Spain increases by 5.7%
in the fourth quarter of 2017 and exceeded 40 million**

Total expenditure increased by 5.3% reaching 8,595 million euros

**In 2017, the number of trips increased by 6.5% while expenditure
grew by 6.9%**

Residents in Spain made 40.0 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2017, 5.7% more than that registered in the same period of 2016.

The main destination of 90.8% of the trips was the national territory, with an increase of 5.6% as compared to the fourth quarter of 2016. On the other hand, trips abroad, which represented 9.2% of the total, increased by 6.7%.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

During the fourth quarter of 2017, *Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips, which were the main reason for 42.2% of trips, increased by 14.3%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 41.9% of the total, registered an annual decrease of 1.3%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* increased by 8.1%, while those made by *Other reasons*¹ fell by 1.5%.

¹ *Other reasons* include shopping tourism, travelling to the study centre, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter of 2017 was visiting relatives or friends (43.8%). On the other hand, most trips abroad were made for leisure purposes (58.8%).

In 46.0% of domestic trips, residents stayed with family or friends. That is 16.7 million trips, 0.6% more than in the fourth quarter of 2016.

For trips abroad the preferred option was hotel accommodation (53.5% of the trips). This type of accommodation registered an annual increase of 3.6%.

With regard to the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 81.8% of domestic trips, 8.1% more than in the fourth quarter of 2016.

Air transport was used in 65.6% of the trips abroad, with a decrease of 2.3%.

Main destinations

The main Autonomous Communities of destination in trips of residents in Spain in the fourth quarter were Andalucía (with 15.8% of the total), Cataluña (11.8%) and Castilla y León (with 9.8%).

If we relate the domestic trips of residents with the destination, the phenomenon of travel is more intense in Castilla y León (with 1,614 trips per 1,000 inhabitants²), in Aragón (with 1,412 trips per 1,000 inhabitants) and La Rioja (1,373 trips per 1,000 inhabitants).

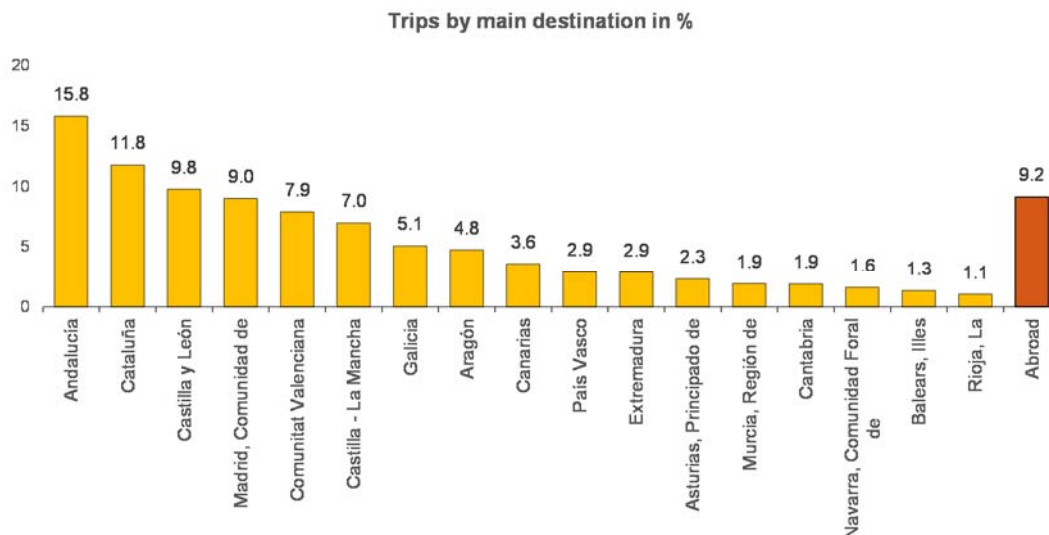
² For the calculation of this indicator, both trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over resident at the destination were used.

Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid meant 18.5% of the trips in the fourth quarter. It was followed by Cataluña and Andalucía, with 15.2% and 14.8% of the total, respectively.

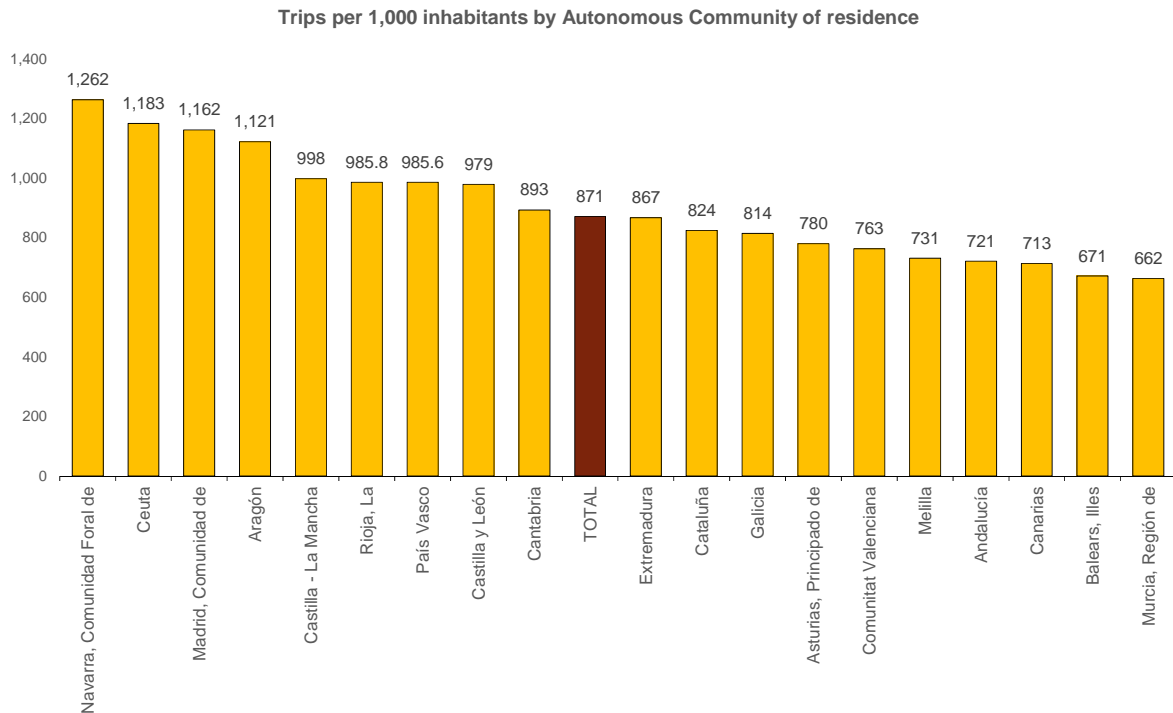

Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travel the most were residents in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1,262 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Comunidad de Madrid (1,162) and Aragón (1,121).

In turn, those who travel less are the residents in Region de Murcia (662 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Illes Balears (671) and Canarias (713).

³ It is considered the resident population of 15 years of age or older.



Expenditure on trips

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 8,595 million euros, 5.3% more than that registered in the same period of 2016.

Expenditure on domestic trips increased by 7.5%, while expenditure on trips abroad increased by 1.1%.

The average daily expenditure stood at 56 euros for domestic trips and 110 euros for trips abroad.

For domestic trips, almost half of the expenditure was shared between *Expenditure in bars and restaurants* (25.8% of total expenditure) and *Expenditure on transport* (24.3%). The former increased by 12.4% compared to the fourth quarter of 2016 and the latter by 7.3%.

For trips abroad, *Expenditure on transport* represented 31.4% of the total, with an annual increase of 1.8%.

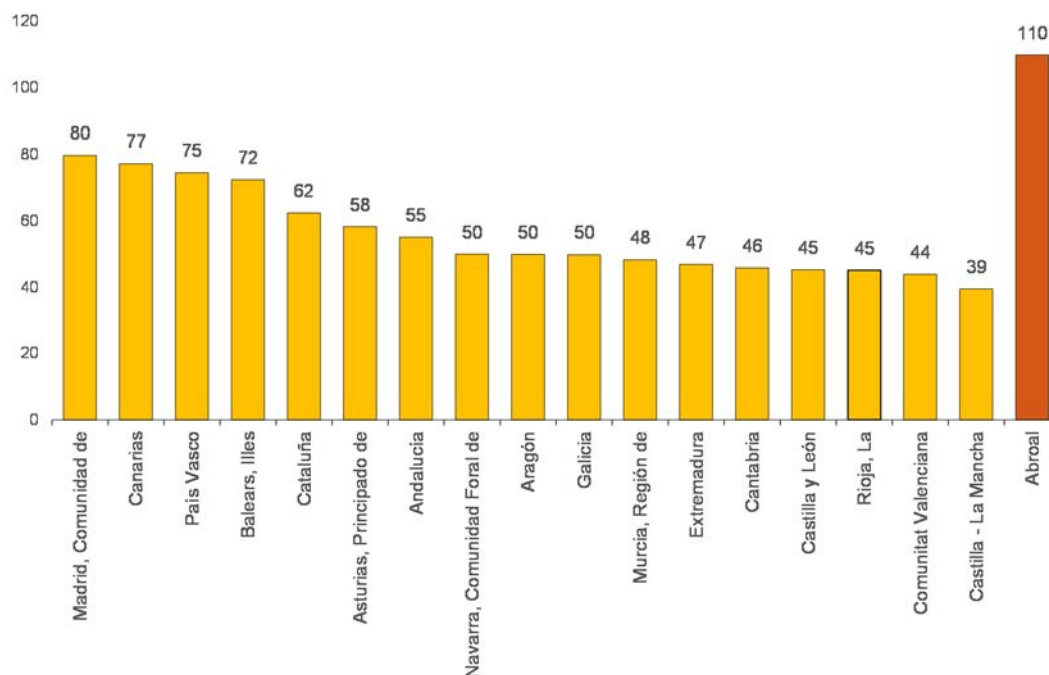

With regard to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Comunidad de Madrid (80 euros), Canarias (77 euros) and País Vasco (75 euros).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Castilla-La Mancha (39 euros), Comunitat Valenciana (44) and in La Rioja and Castilla y León (45 euros in both cases).

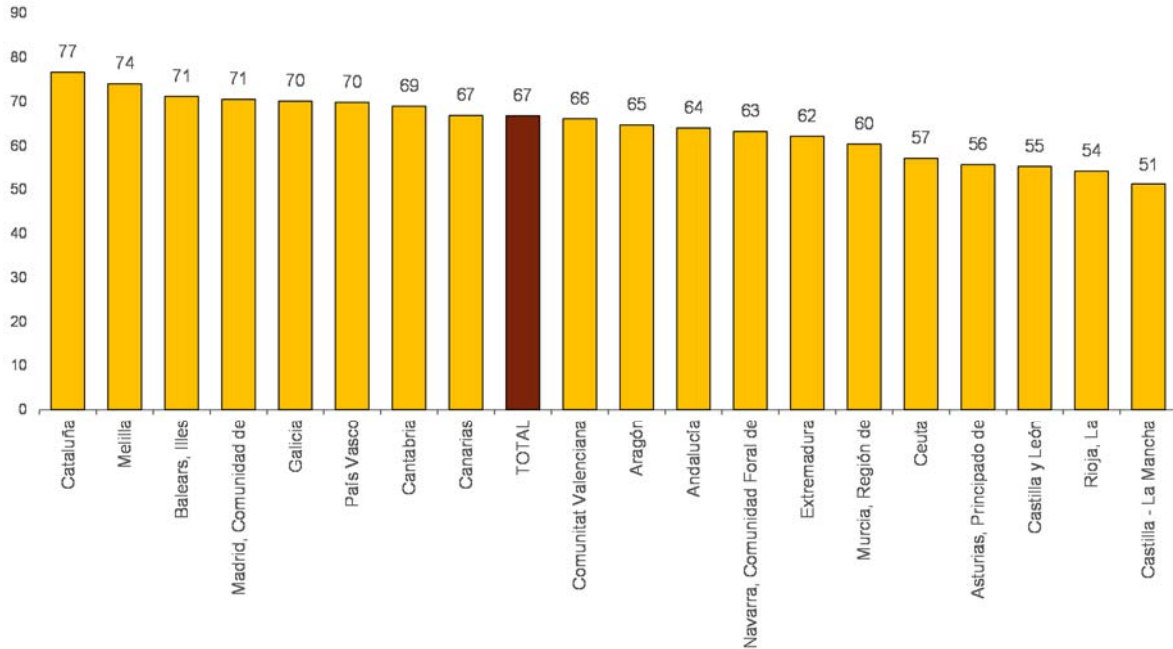
Daily average expenditure per person by main destination



By origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Cataluña (77 euros), Illes Balears (71) and Comunidad de Madrid (71).

In turn, the lowest values were in Castilla-La Mancha (51 euros), La Rioja (54) and Castilla y León (55).

Monthly data

In October there were 14.9 million trips, in November 11.5 million and in December 13.7 million. The average duration of trips varies from 2.9 overnight stays for trips ended in November to 3.5 overnight stays for trips ended in December.

December is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (44.7% compared to 50.8% in November). But it is the month with the highest percentage of trips abroad (11.1%).

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips were the main reason for the trip in October (46.8% of the total for that month) and November (41.3%). In December, *Visits to relatives or friends* accounted for 48.1% of trips. This month recorded the lowest level of business trips for this quarter.

Non-market accommodation represented 65.5% of the total trips in December, compared to 62.1% in October and 61.6% in November.

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 69.7 million excursions⁴ in the fourth quarter of 2017, with an annual increase of 21.2%. Of these, 95.7% were for personal reasons and 4.3% for professional reasons.

88.2% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 23.3%.

10.7% of excursions had another Autonomous Community as destination and 1.2% went abroad. In the former the number of excursions increased 6.5% while those with destination abroad increased 15.7%.

⁴ An excursion is considered to be any visit without overnight stay outside the usual environment of the person. These exclude those which are part of the routine of the individual, as well as those made from second homes, from a cruise or any accommodation other than the usual.

Results for the whole year 2017

Residents in Spain made **193.7 million trips** in 2017 as a whole, 6.5% more than in 2016. Overnight stays corresponding to those trips exceeded 801.9 million, with an increase of 2.8%. On the other hand, the **related total expenditure increased by 6.9%** reaching 44,233 million euros.

91.1% of trips had Spain as main destination and 8.9% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 82.4% of overnight stays and 67.7% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 45 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 17.6% of overnight stays and 32.3% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 101 euros.

The main reason for the trip was leisure (50.6% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (36.2%).

Leisure trips accounted for 58.8% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 59 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (110 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 63.2% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for 62.0% of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (29 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (129 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, expenditure on bar and restaurants represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (26.8%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (23.4%) and expenditure on transport (21.6%).

As for trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight on the total was expenditure on transport (28.0%), followed by expenditure on tourist packages (19.3%) and in accommodation (19.0%).

By quarter, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded in the fourth quarter for domestic trips (56 euros) and in the second quarter for trips abroad (126 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered during the third quarter (37 euros for domestic trips and 87 euros for those made abroad).

Andalucía was the destination of 16.8% of all trips made in 2017, followed by Cataluña (13.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (9.6%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (0.9% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.5%) and Illes Balears (1.7%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Comunidad de Madrid (72 euros), Illes Balears (68) and Canarias (67).

In turn, the lowest average values were recorded in Castilla-La Mancha (31 euros), Castilla y León (35) and Región de Murcia (36).

Residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2017 (19.0% of the total), followed by residents in Cataluña (16.4%) and Andalucía (15.2%).

The highest average daily expenditures corresponded to residents in Illes Balears (67 euros per day), Cantabria (64) and Galicia (61).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered in the Región de Murcia (48 euros), Castilla-La Mancha (49) and Aragón (50).

Methodological note

The Tourism survey for Spanish residents (ETR/FAMILITUR) is a continuous survey with the main objective to provide monthly, quarterly and annual estimations of trips made by the resident population in Spain and their main characteristics such as destination, duration, reason, accommodation, transport means, expenditure and socio-demographic characteristics of the travellers, among others. The dissemination of results and their level of disaggregation, depending on the study variable group, will be made with monthly, quarterly or annual reference.

The information is obtained by personal interviews to people aged 15 or older, selected at random in a sample of resident households, that collaborate three times in alternative months along six months, leave the sample for six months, and are interviewed three other times during the next semester. People selected provide information on the trips made in the two months prior to that of the interview. With an expected effective monthly sample of about 8,200 people, the information of a reference month is provided by about 16,400 people. Furthermore, the rotating panel scheme provides the efficient estimation of the annual change.
