


The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Rate¹ stands at 0.9%, If seasonal and calendar effects are eliminated

The annual rate stands at 8.6% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 4.9% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Rate between the months of February and January, eliminating seasonal and calendar effects, is 0.9%. This rate is almost a point higher than the previous month.






¹ As reflected in the methodology of this rate of value, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation of it.

By economic destination of goods, four of the five sectors have positive monthly rates. *Durable consumer goods* (3.2%) and *Capital goods* (2.8%) recorded the highest rates. The only sector that descends is *Energy* (-7.6%).



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Rates

The General Industrial Turnover Rate corrected for seasonal and calendar effects shows a variation of 8.6% in February compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate is 1.4 points higher than the registered in January.

The original series of the ICN registered an annual variation of 4.9%. This rate is 8.2 points lower than the registered in January.

General Industrial Turnover Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, the rates adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects have positive annual rates in all sectors analysed. It is worth noting the increase in *Energy* (55.8%).

Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Rates by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, in February positive annual rates are observed in two of the three markets analysed. The increase of 5.6% in the internal market is outstanding.


Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate

The turnover increases in annual rate in 12 autonomous communities and decreases in the other five. The largest increase occurred in the Región de Murcia (22.2%) and the largest decline in Illes Balears (-10.6%).
