


The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index¹ stands at −0.8%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at −1.1% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at −0.9% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of April and March 2015 was -0.8%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was almost two points lower than that of the previous month.






¹ As explained in the methodology for this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), that is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation thereof.

By economic destination of the goods, four of the five sectors registered negative annual rates. Worth noting were Capital goods (-1.7%) and Non-durable consumer goods (-1.5%).

The only sector that increased was Durable consumer goods (0.1%).



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of −1.1% in April, as compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate was 4.3 points lower than that registered in March 2015.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of −0.9%, that is, 6.7 points lower than that registered in March 2015.



By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors analysed registered positive annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. It is worth noting the increase in Intermediate goods (4.1%).



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, in April the domestic market (-4.2%) and the non-euro zone of the foreign market (-1.8%) recorded negative rates. In turn, the euro zone of the foreign market registered ad increase of 7.3%.


Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover increased in 10 Autonomous Community and decreased in the remaining seven. The greatest increase was registered in Aragón (11.4%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (–32.6%).
