
## Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2010 August 2014. Provisional data

## The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index stands at 0.8%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

# The annual rate stands at 1.2% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at –1.4% in the original series

## Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of August and July 2014 was 0.8%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was almost one point higher than that of the previous month.




#### Turnover General Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate



By economic destination of the goods, Durable consumer goods (7.8%), Capital goods (3.1%) and Energy (1.8%) registered positive monthly rates. In turn, Non-durable consumer goods (-0.3%) and Intermediate goods (-0.2%) registered negative monthly rates.



## Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 1.2% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was four tenths lower than that registered in July 2014.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of -1.4%, that is, three points and three tenths lower than that registered in July 2014.



### General Industrial Turnover Index Annual rates

By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors analysed registered positive annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Among them, worth noting was the increase of Capital goods (6.8%).

### Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, two out of three markets analysed registered negative annual rates. Worth noting was the decrease in the non euro zone foreign market (-10.1%).


## Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate



## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover decreased in 11 Autonomous Communities and increased in six, as compared with August 2013. The greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (–27.9%) and the greatest increase in Región de Murcia (20.4%).
