
Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2010 September 2015. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index¹ stands at 1.9%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects²

The annual rate stands at 1.6% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at 1.5% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of September and August 2015 was 1.9%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 4.8 points higher than that of the previous month.



Turnover General Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate


¹ As explained in the methodology for this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), that is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation thereof.

² During the summer months, the seasonal adjustment may be influenced upwards or downwards, because of changes in the vacation pattern in comparison with its previous guidelines.

By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors presented positive monthly rates, worth noting Capital goods (4.7%), followed by Non-durable consumer goods (2.5%). Energy is the only sector that decreased (-7.1%).



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 1.6% in September, as compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate was 4.5 points higher than that registered in August 2015.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of 1.5%, which is 1.8 points higher than that registered in August 2015.



By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors analysed registered positive annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. It is worth noting the increase in Capital goods (13.0%).

Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, in September two out of three the markets analysed registered positive annual rates. Worth noting was the increase of the non-euro zone of the foreign market (7.8%).


Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover increased in 11 Autonomous Communities, as compared with September 2014 and it decreased in 6 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increase was registered in Castilla y León (12.7%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (–25.2%).
