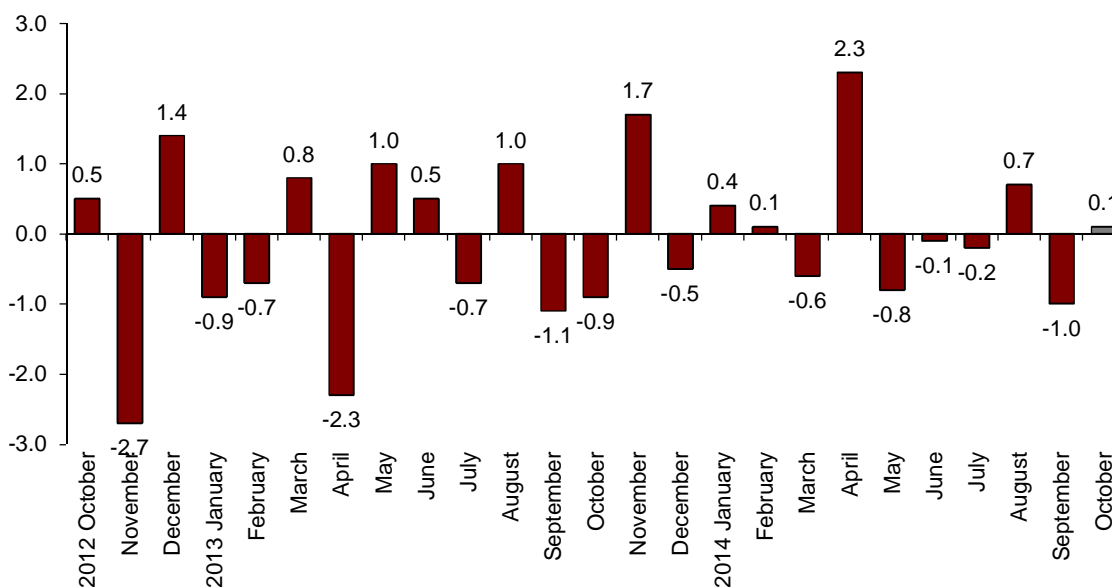
**The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index stands at 0.1%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects**

**The annual rate stands at 2.0% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at 1.0% in the original series**

**Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover**

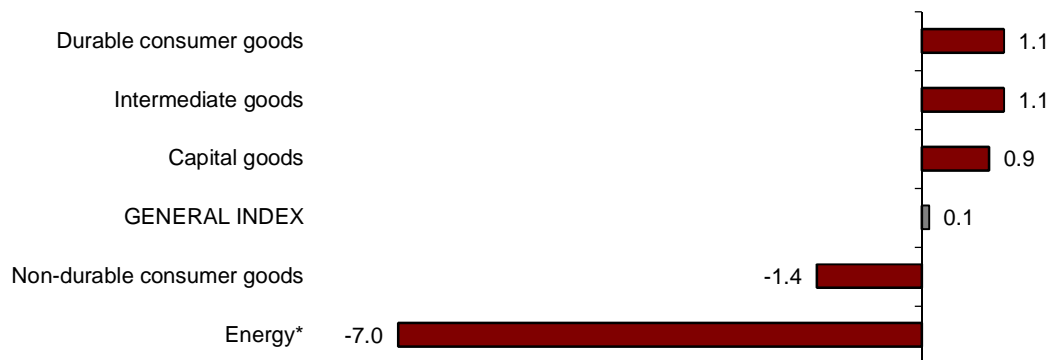
The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of October and September 2014 was 0.1%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 1.1 points higher than that of the previous month.

By economic destination of the goods, Durable consumer goods (1.1%), Intermediate goods (1.1%) and Capital goods (0.9%) recorded positive monthly rates. In turn, Energy (−7.0%) and Non-durable consumer goods (−1.4%) registered negative rates.

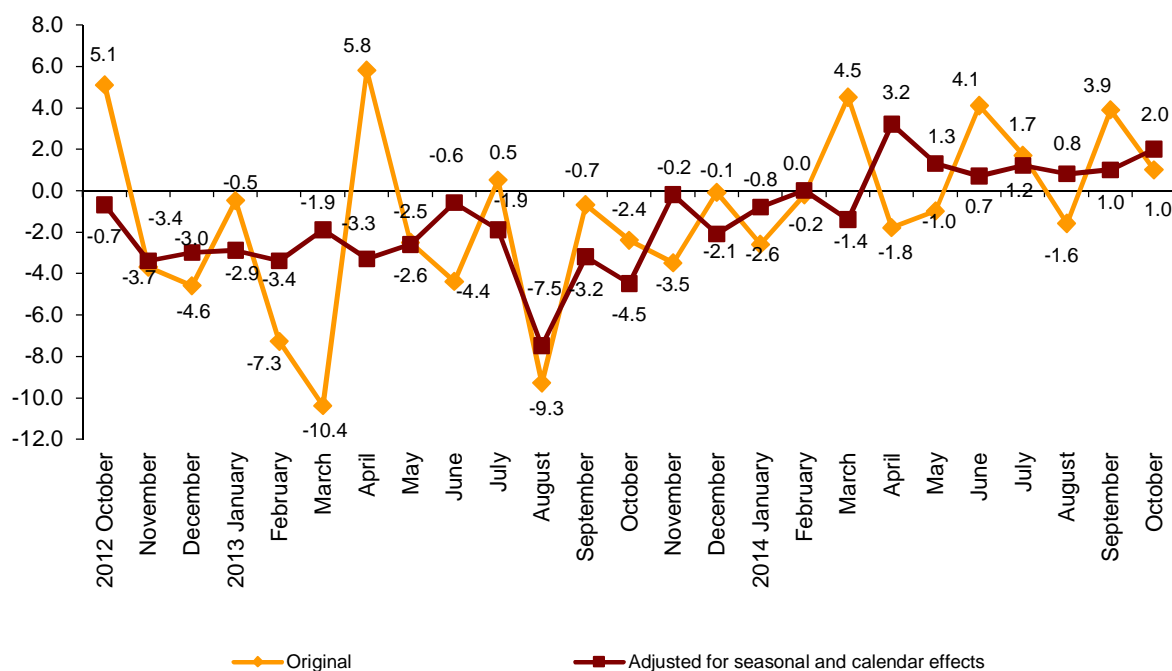

## Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 2.0% in October, as compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate was one point higher than that registered in September 2014.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of 1.0%, that is, almost three points lower than that registered in September 2014.

### General Industrial Turnover Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors analysed registered negative annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Among them, worth noting was the increase of Capital goods (6.9%).

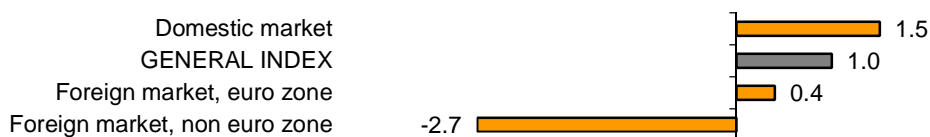

**Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series**

By geographical destination of sales, in October the domestic market (1.5%) and the foreign market euro zone (0.4%) registered increases as compared to the same month of the previous year. Conversely, the foreign market non euro zone recorded an annual rate of -2.7%.

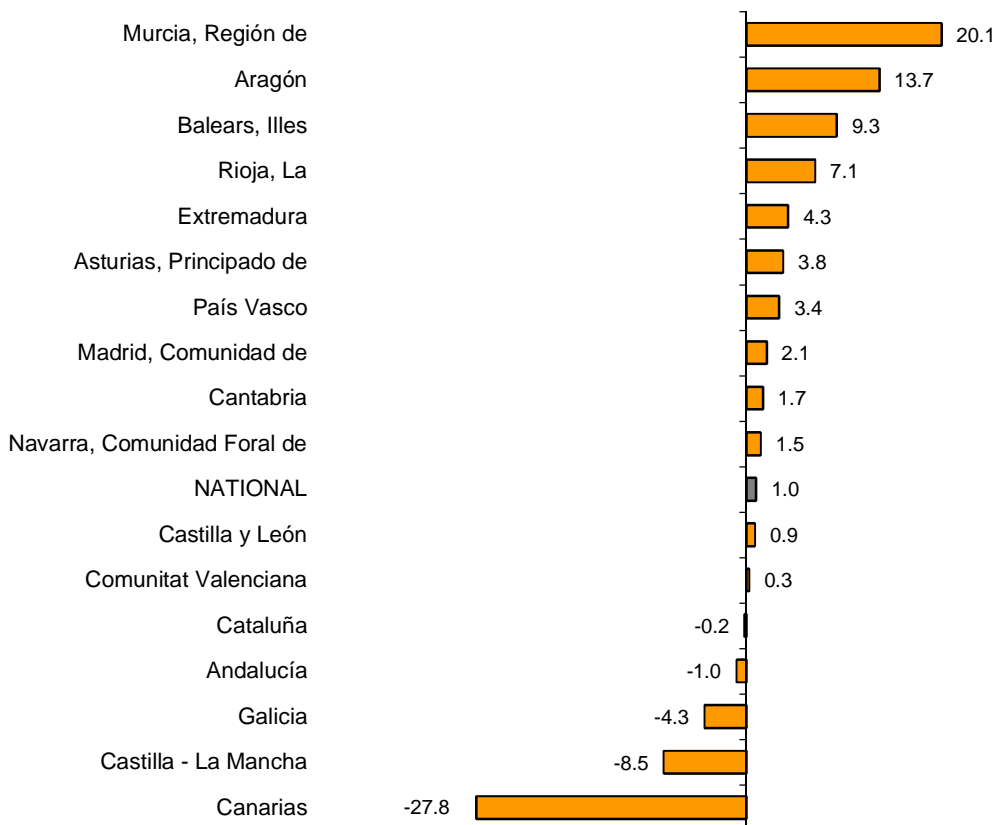
**Industrial turnover indices: General and by market

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series**

In October, turnover increased in 12 Autonomous Communities and decreased in five. The greatest increase was registered in Región de Murcia (20.1%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (-27.8%).
