
Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2010 November 2013. *Provisional data*

The annual rate of the General Industry Turnover Index stands at -0.5% in the seasonally adjusted series and at -3.4% in the original series

The monthly variation stands at 1.7%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

In November, the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) registered a -3.4% variation, as compared with the same month of 2012. This rate was one point lower than that of October.

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the rate was –0.5%, nearly four points and a half above that of October.

Annual evolution of the turnover by economic destination of the goods

All the industrial sectors analysed registered negative annual rates, except Capital goods (1.7%). Durable consumer goods registered the greatest decrease (-9.8%), followed by Energy (-7.1%).

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, Energy was the sector that decreased the most (-6.4%), followed by Durable consumer goods (-6.0%). Capital goods was the only sector that increased its invoicing (5.2%).



Annual evolution of the turnover, by market

By geographical destination of sales, Domestic market was the only one that registered a negative annual rate in November (–6.4%).

The remaining markets registered positive rates. The greatest increase was registered in the Foreign market non euro zone, where the invoicing increased 3.8%.

Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate




Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of turnover

The turnover decreased in all Autonomous Communities, as compared with November 2012, except in Principado de Asturias (9.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (3.5%).

Illes Balears (-18.9%), Comunidad de Madrid (-12.4%) and La Rioja (-8.8%) registered the greatest decreases.


General indices: National and by Autonomous Community Annual rate of Industry Turnover



Monthly evolution of the ITI, adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index between November and October was 1.7%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was more than two points and a half higher than that registered in October.


Turnover General Index Seasonally and calendar adjusted. Monthly rate
